1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the assembly, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Modern Shade Rosewood Wood Gazebo 13' x 15'. This permanent hardtop pavilion features a cedar wood frame and a double galvanized steel roof, designed for outdoor use in gardens, backyards, patios, and decks. Please read this manual thoroughly before beginning assembly or use to ensure safe and correct installation and operation.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Adherence to the following safety guidelines is crucial for preventing injury and damage to the gazebo.

- **Assembly:** Always assemble with at least two adults. Wear appropriate safety gear, including gloves and eye protection. Ensure all parts are correctly aligned and secured before proceeding to the next step.
- **Anchoring:** The gazebo must be securely anchored to a solid surface such as concrete or decking using the provided expansion bolts. Failure to properly anchor the structure can result in instability and potential collapse during high winds.
- **Wind Resistance:** This gazebo is engineered to withstand winds up to 100 mph. However, in extreme weather conditions, it is advisable to remove any hanging items or accessories to reduce wind load.
- **Snow Load:** The roof is designed to handle a snow capacity of 20 lbs per square foot. In areas with heavy snowfall, regular removal of accumulated snow from the roof is recommended to prevent structural stress.
- **Electrical:** If installing lighting or other electrical devices, ensure they are rated for outdoor use and installed by a

qualified electrician according to local codes. Use the integrated ceiling hook for hanging lights, ensuring the weight limit is not exceeded.

- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect all connections, bolts, and structural components for tightness and signs of wear or damage. Address any issues promptly.

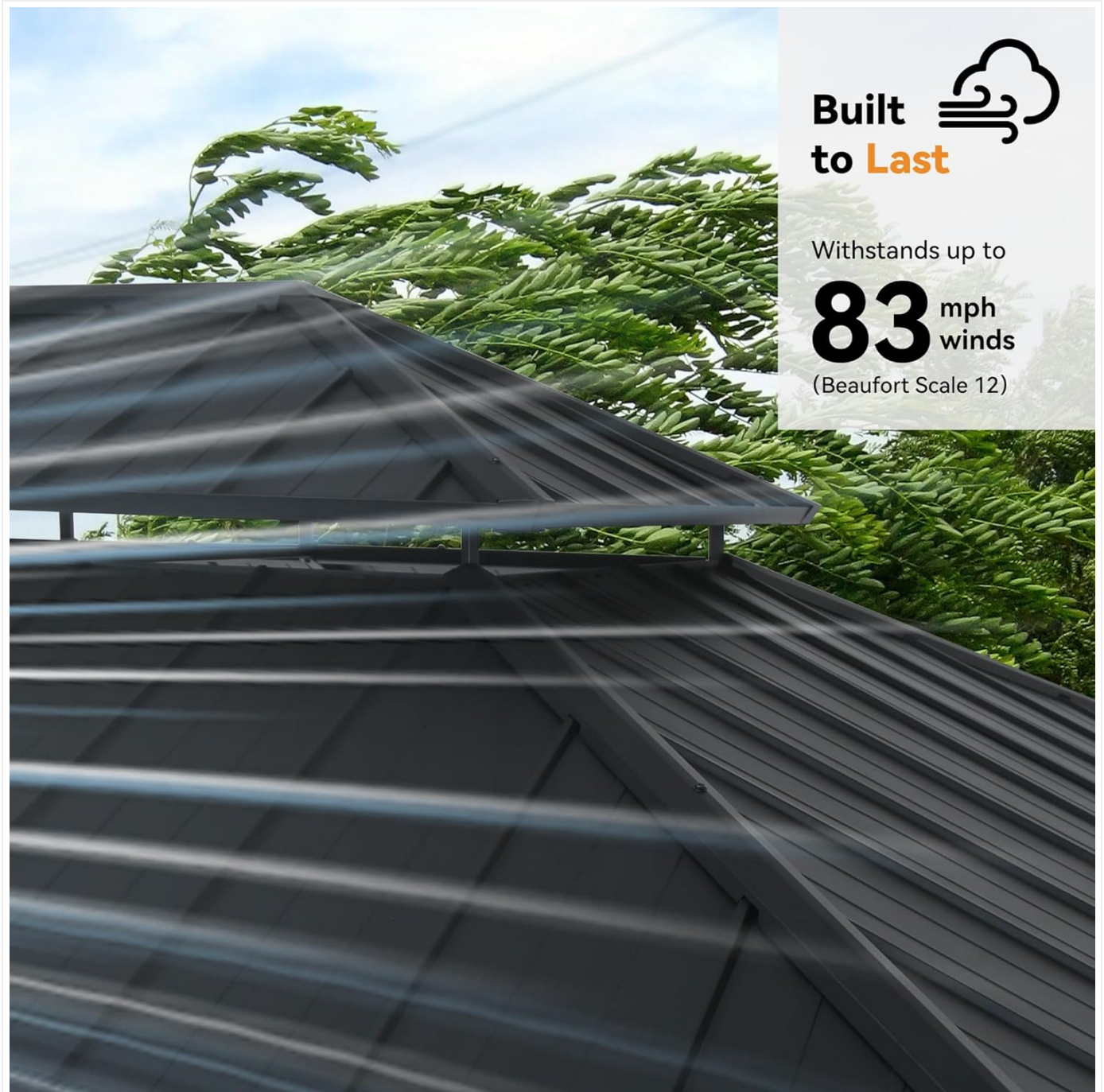


Image 2.1: Illustration of the gazebo's roof structure designed for wind resistance.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Your Modern Shade Rosewood Wood Gazebo is delivered in six separate boxes. Before beginning assembly, verify that all components listed in the packing list (included in one of the boxes) are present and undamaged. All parts are clearly labeled for easy identification.

Typical components include:

- Cedar wood posts and beams
- Galvanized steel roof panels (double-tier)
- Rust-free black stainless steel hardware (bolts, screws, washers)
- Galvanized steel brackets
- Expansion bolts for anchoring
- Integrated ceiling hook
- Mosquito net rods (if applicable to your model)

- Assembly tools (basic)
- Detailed instruction manual



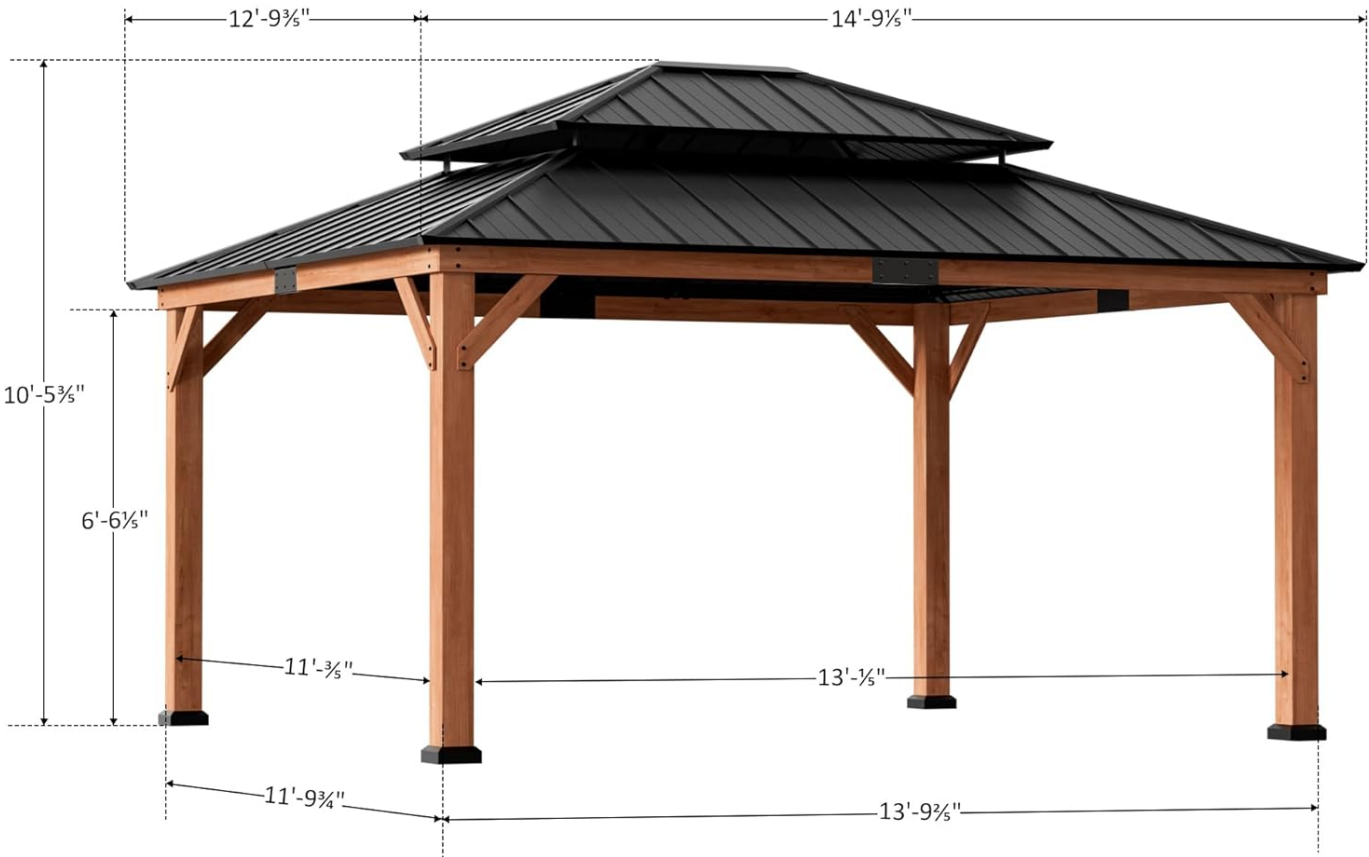
Image 3.1: Gazebo components are securely packaged for transport.

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the Modern Shade Rosewood Wood Gazebo requires careful attention to detail and the assistance of at least one other person. Allow 4-6 hours for completion.

1. **Site Preparation:** Choose a level, stable surface for installation. Ensure adequate clearance around the gazebo for assembly and future use.
2. **Unpack and Organize:** Carefully unpack all boxes and lay out the components. Refer to the parts list to identify each piece. Group similar parts together.
3. **Post Assembly:** Assemble the cedar wood posts according to the detailed instructions. Ensure all connections are tight using the provided hardware. The posts are extra-strong, measuring 4.6 inches in width.
4. **Frame Construction:** Connect the posts with the horizontal beams, forming the base structure. Use galvanized steel brackets for enhanced durability.
5. **Roof Frame Assembly:** Construct the double-tier roof frame. This step often requires two people to lift and secure the larger components.
6. **Roof Panel Installation:** Attach the galvanized steel roof panels to the frame. Ensure proper overlap and sealing to maintain waterproof integrity. The dual roof design facilitates ventilation.
7. **Anchoring:** Once the main structure is complete, securely anchor the gazebo to your chosen surface (concrete or decking) using the expansion bolts. This step is critical for stability, especially in windy conditions.
8. **Final Touches:** Install the integrated ceiling hook and mosquito net rods (if desired). Double-check all bolts and connections for tightness.

Safe and Secure

The sturdy design includes expansion screws that anchor into concrete or decking, so your gazebo doesn't get blown away in the next storm.

5. OPERATING YOUR GAZEBO

Your Modern Shade Rosewood Wood Gazebo is designed to enhance your outdoor living space.

- **Outdoor Gatherings:** The generous 13' x 15' interior provides ample space to comfortably accommodate 7-13 people, making it ideal for dining, lounging, or entertaining.
- **Lighting and Decorations:** Utilize the integrated ceiling hook to hang outdoor lighting fixtures, ceiling fans, or decorative elements. Ensure any hung items do not exceed the hook's weight capacity.
- **Insect Protection:** The gazebo is equipped with mosquito net rods, allowing for easy installation and removal of mosquito nets or privacy curtains (not included). This feature helps create a more comfortable environment.
- **Ventilation:** The double-tier galvanized steel roof promotes superior ventilation, allowing hot air and smoke to rise and escape, keeping the interior cooler in summer and smoke-free if used with a grill.
- **UV Protection:** The galvanized steel roof blocks up to 90% of UV rays, providing significant sun protection.

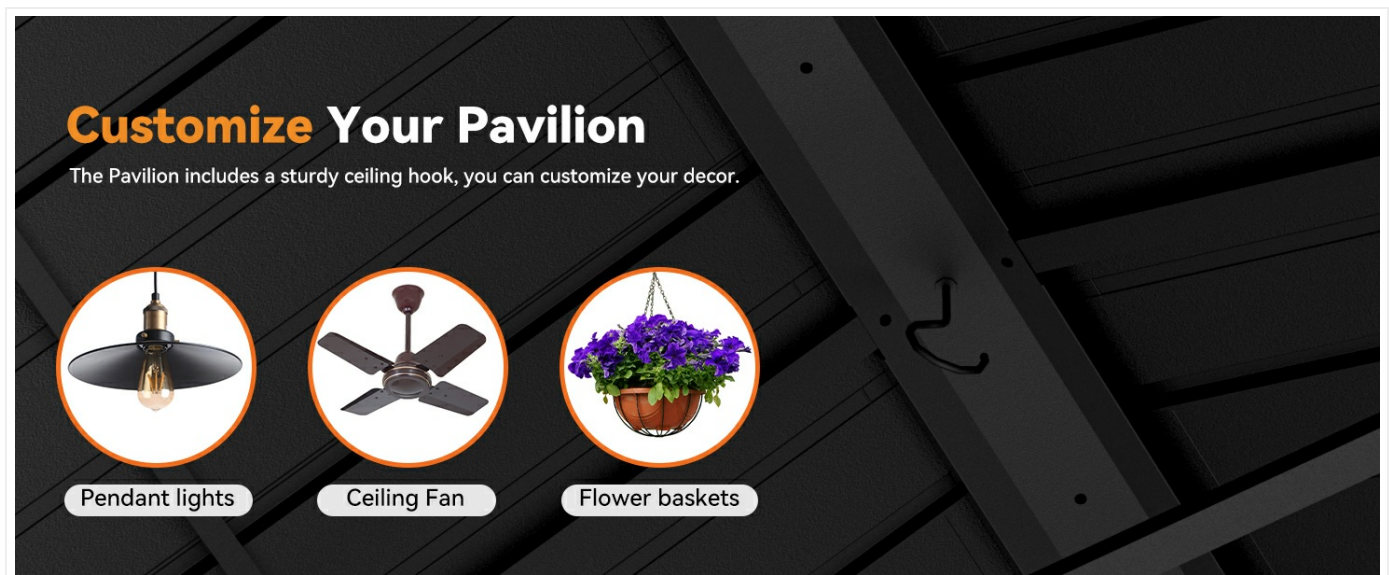


Image 5.1: Options for customizing your pavilion with the integrated ceiling hook.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will ensure the longevity and appearance of your gazebo.

- **Wood Frame Care:** The cedar wood frame is naturally resistant to pests and decay. To maintain its appearance, clean the wood periodically with a mild soap and water solution. For prolonged life and to preserve the wood's natural color, consider applying a wood sealant or stain annually.
- **Roof Cleaning:** The galvanized steel roof is rust-resistant. Clean the roof panels with a soft brush and water to remove leaves, debris, and dirt. Avoid abrasive cleaners or tools that could scratch the surface.
- **Hardware Inspection:** Annually, inspect all bolts, screws, and connections for tightness. Tighten any loose hardware to maintain structural integrity.
- **Snow Removal:** During winter, regularly remove heavy snow accumulation from the roof to prevent excessive load and potential damage.
- **General Cleaning:** Keep the entire structure clean from dirt, dust, and organic matter to prevent buildup and potential deterioration.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Gazebo feels unstable or sways.	Improper anchoring; loose hardware; uneven ground.	Ensure all expansion bolts are securely fastened to the ground. Check and tighten all structural bolts and screws. Verify the installation surface is level.
Water leakage from the roof.	Improperly installed roof panels; damaged sealant; debris buildup.	Inspect roof panels for correct overlap and secure fastening. Check for any cracks or gaps in sealant and reapply if necessary. Clear any debris from the roof and gutters.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Difficulty during assembly.	Misaligned parts; incorrect hardware; missing steps.	Refer to the detailed instruction manual and diagrams. Ensure parts are oriented correctly before fastening. Verify you are using the correct hardware for each step. Do not force parts together.
Wood appears discolored or weathered.	Natural weathering; lack of protective treatment.	This is a natural process for wood exposed to elements. Clean the wood and apply a wood sealant or stain to restore and protect its appearance.

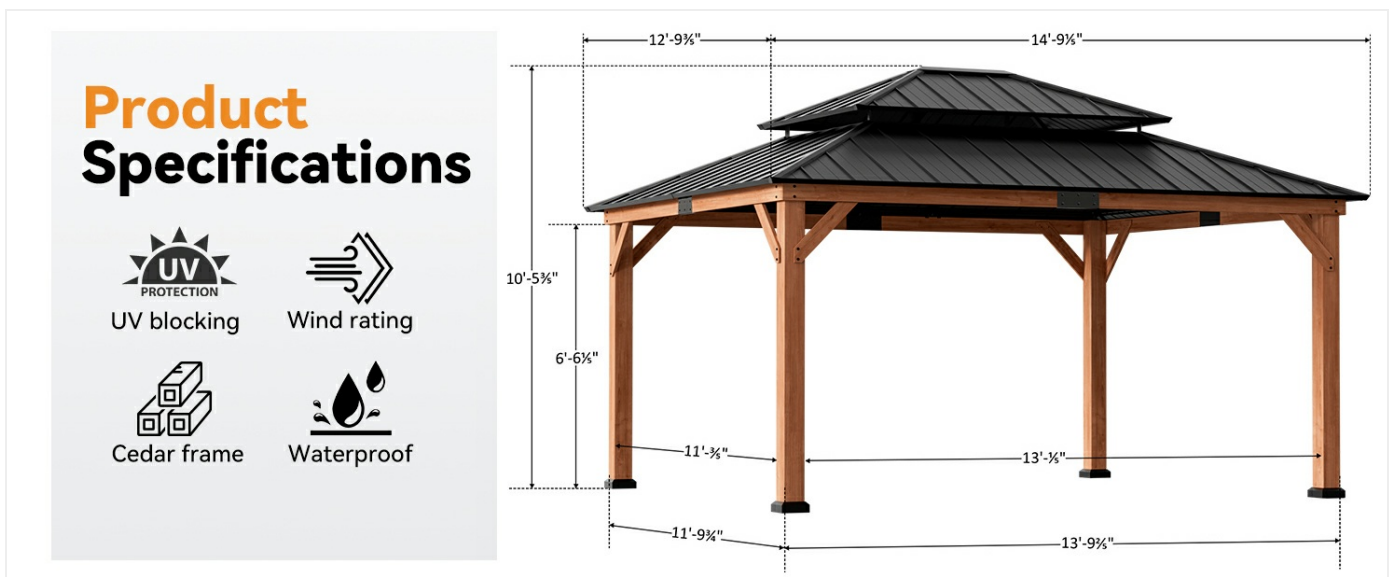


Image 8.1: Visual summary of key product specifications and dimensions.
