


Figure 1.1: Front cover of *Sonic the Hedgehog, Vol. 20: Cause & Effect*. The image displays Sonic and other characters, including Tails, Amy, and Silver, in a dynamic pose with a background suggesting recent conflict or a challenging environment.

The Diamond Cutters, though no longer an official unit, remain united in their efforts to reconstruct Emeraldville, receiving aid from neighboring communities. The unpredictable duo, Surge and Kit, also feature in the storyline, attempting to contribute in their unique ways, which often leads to mixed reactions from others.
