SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Indesit IN2FD14BNP80W is a freestanding dishwasher designed for easy placement in your kitchen. Ensure the appliance is level and securely positioned before connecting to water and power supplies.

Dimensions and Placement:

Allow adequate space around the dishwasher for ventilation and door opening. Connect the water inlet hose to a cold water tap and the drain hose to a suitable drain point, ensuring no kinks. The appliance requires a 220 Volt power supply.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your dishwasher is designed for efficient cleaning of up to 14 place settings. The control panel features a knob for program selection and buttons for additional functions.

Loading the Dishwasher:

Proper loading ensures optimal cleaning results. Place larger items in the lower rack and smaller, more delicate items in the upper rack. Ensure spray arms can rotate freely.

Available Programs:

- Eco 50°: The most efficient program for normally soiled dishes in terms of water and energy consumption.
- Intensive 65°: For heavily soiled dishes.
- Mixed 55°: For mixed loads with varying soil levels.
- Fast and Clean 28' 45°: A quick wash cycle for lightly soiled dishes without dried-on food residues. No drying phase.
- Pre-wash: A short rinse cycle for dishes to be washed later.
- **Push & Go:** A short wash and dry cycle for clean and shiny dishes with a single button press, no pre-washing required.

Special Functions:

• Delayed Start: Allows you to delay the start of the wash program by 2, 4, or 8 hours.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Cleaning the Filter System:

- Dishes are not clean: Ensure proper loading, check detergent dispenser, clean filters, and verify spray arm rotation.
- Water not draining: Check for blockages in the drain hose or filter system.
- Unusual noises: May indicate improper loading or foreign objects in the pump area.
