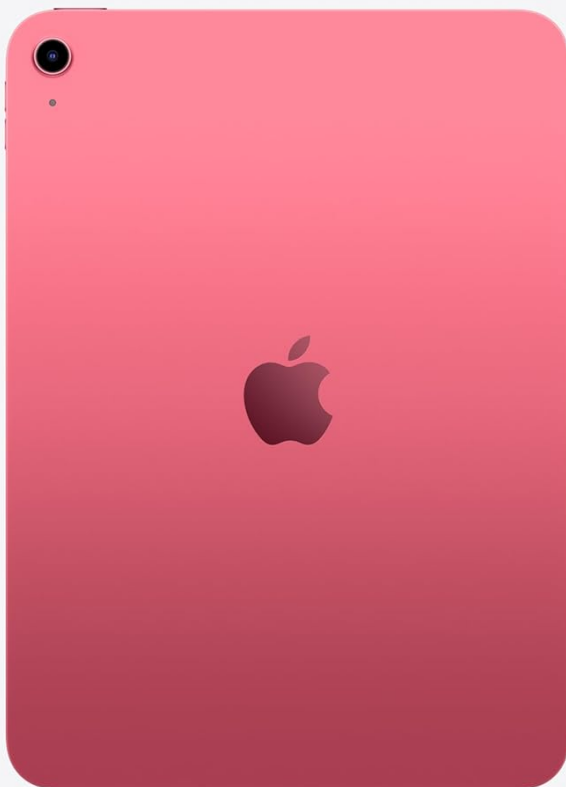
- **A16 Chip:** Delivers superfast performance for demanding applications, immersive games, and efficient photo/video editing.
- **11-inch Liquid Retina Display:** A stunning display with 2360-by-1640-pixel resolution, True Tone technology, and 500 nits brightness for comfortable viewing.
- **Advanced Cameras:** Features a 12MP Center Stage front camera for video calls and a 12MP Wide back camera with True Tone flash for high-quality photos and 4K videos.
- **Wi-Fi 6 Connectivity:** Provides fast and reliable wireless access for streaming, downloads, and uploads.
- **USB-C Connector:** For charging, data transfer, and connecting to external displays.
- **Touch ID:** Integrated into the top button for secure unlocking, app sign-ins, and Apple Pay.

- **iPadOS:** Enhances productivity with multitasking capabilities and support for Apple Pencil (sold separately) and Magic Keyboard Folio (sold separately).
- **All-Day Battery Life:** Designed to provide extended usage on a single charge.

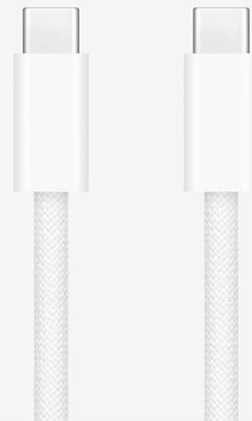

- Apple iPad 11-inch
- USB-C Charge Cable (1 meter)
- 20W USB-C Power Adapter

Initial Setup Steps:

1. **Charge Your iPad:** Connect the USB-C Charge Cable to the iPad's USB-C port and the 20W USB-C Power

Adapter. Plug the adapter into a power outlet. Allow the iPad to charge for at least 30 minutes before initial use.

2. **Power On:** Press and hold the top button until the Apple logo appears.
3. **Follow On-Screen Instructions:** The iPad will guide you through the initial setup process, which includes:
 - Selecting your language and region.
 - Connecting to a Wi-Fi network.
 - Setting up Touch ID for secure authentication.
 - Creating a passcode.
 - Restoring data from a backup (iCloud or computer) or setting up as a new iPad.
 - Signing in with your Apple ID or creating a new one.
 - Enabling location services and Siri (optional).
4. **Complete Setup:** Once all steps are completed, your iPad will be ready for use.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Navigating iPadOS:

The iPad operates on iPadOS, designed for intuitive touch navigation. Use gestures to interact with apps and content.

- **Home Screen:** Swipe up from the bottom edge of the screen to go to the Home Screen.
- **App Switcher:** Swipe up from the bottom edge and pause in the middle of the screen to view open apps.
- **Control Center:** Swipe down from the top-right corner to access quick settings.
- **Notifications:** Swipe down from the top-left corner to view notifications.
- **Multitasking:** iPadOS supports Split View and Slide Over for using multiple apps simultaneously.

Using Touch ID:

Touch ID is integrated into the top button. Place your registered finger on the top button to:

- Unlock your iPad.
- Authorize purchases from the App Store, iTunes Store, and Apple Books.

- Sign in to compatible apps.

Camera Functions:

The iPad features a 12MP Wide back camera and a 12MP Center Stage front camera.

- **Taking Photos:** Open the Camera app, select Photo mode, and tap the shutter button.
- **Recording Videos:** Select Video mode in the Camera app. The back camera supports 4K video recording at various frame rates.
- **Center Stage:** The front camera automatically keeps you centered in the frame during video calls, even as you move around.

Connectivity:

Your iPad supports Wi-Fi 6 for high-speed internet access and Bluetooth 5.3 for connecting accessories.

- **Wi-Fi:** Go to Settings > Wi-Fi to connect to available networks.
- **Bluetooth:** Go to Settings > Bluetooth to pair with Bluetooth devices like headphones or keyboards.

Accessories (Sold Separately):

The iPad is compatible with the Apple Pencil (USB-C or 1st generation) and the Magic Keyboard Folio, enhancing its functionality for creative and productivity tasks.

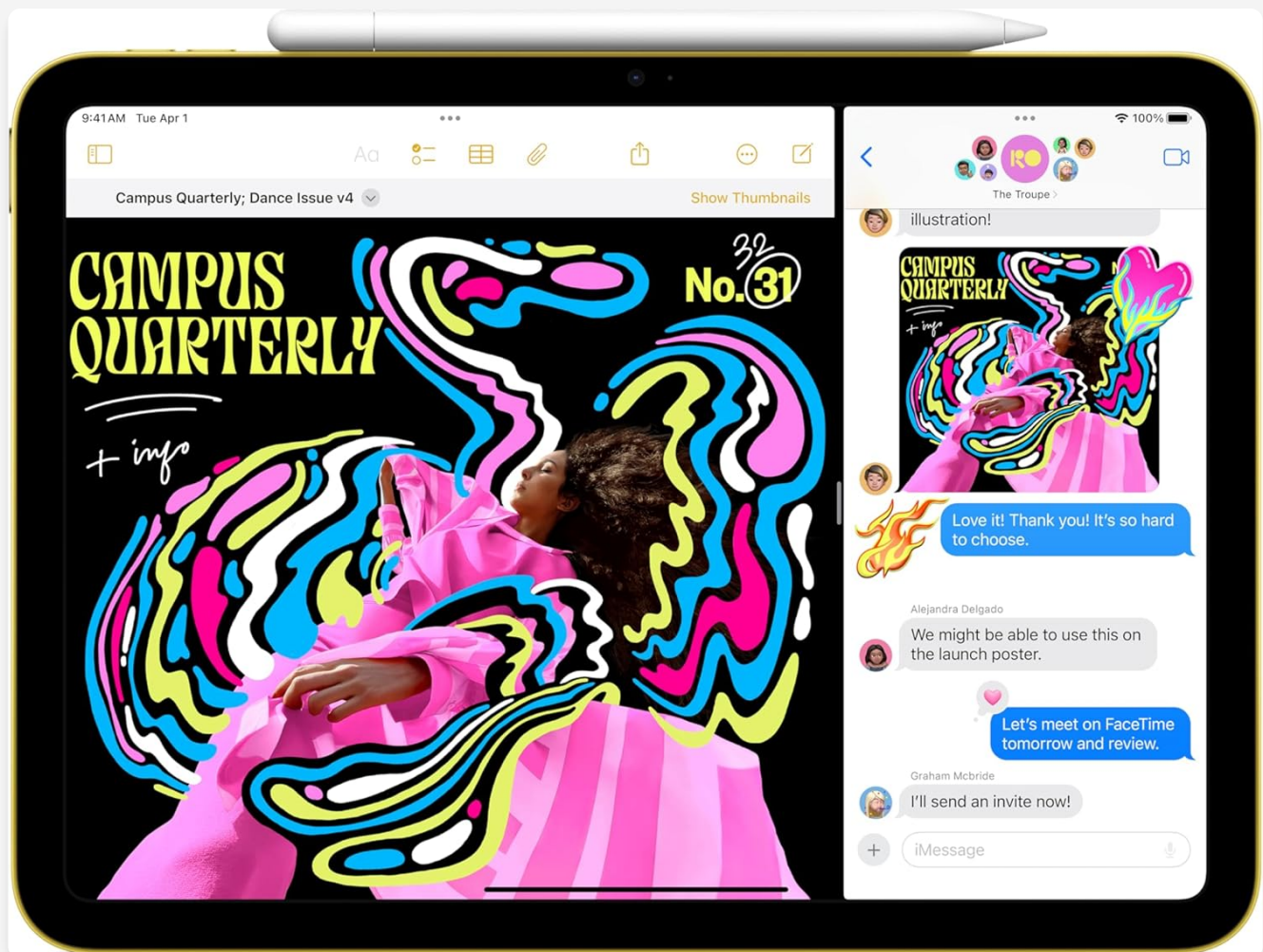


Image: An Apple iPad screen showing a digital drawing application, with an Apple Pencil positioned nearby, illustrating its use for creative tasks.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning Your iPad:

- Unplug all cables and turn off your iPad.
- Use a soft, lint-free cloth, slightly dampened with water, to clean the screen and exterior.
- Avoid getting moisture in any openings. Do not use window cleaners, household cleaners, aerosol sprays, solvents, alcohol, ammonia, or abrasives to clean your iPad.

Battery Care:

- For optimal battery longevity, avoid exposing your iPad to extreme temperatures (above 95° F or below 32° F).
- If storing your iPad long-term, charge it to about 50% every six months to prevent deep discharge.

Software Updates:

- Regularly check for and install iPadOS updates to ensure your device has the latest features, security enhancements, and performance improvements. Go to Settings > General > Software Update.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions:

Issue	Possible Solution
-------	-------------------

Issue	Possible Solution
iPad not turning on or unresponsive	Ensure the iPad is charged. Force restart by pressing and holding both the top button and the Home button (if applicable) or volume up/down and top button (for models without Home button) until the Apple logo appears.
Wi-Fi connectivity problems	Check Wi-Fi settings (Settings > Wi-Fi). Restart your Wi-Fi router. Forget the network and reconnect. Reset network settings (Settings > General > Transfer or Reset iPad > Reset > Reset Network Settings).
Apps crashing or freezing	Close and reopen the app. Check for app updates in the App Store. Restart your iPad. Ensure iPadOS is up to date.
Battery draining quickly	Check battery usage in Settings > Battery to identify power-consuming apps. Adjust screen brightness. Disable unnecessary background app refresh. Update iPadOS.
Touch ID not working	Ensure your finger is clean and dry. Re-register your fingerprint in Settings > Touch ID & Passcode. Restart your iPad.

If issues persist, consider contacting Apple Support or visiting an authorized service provider.


