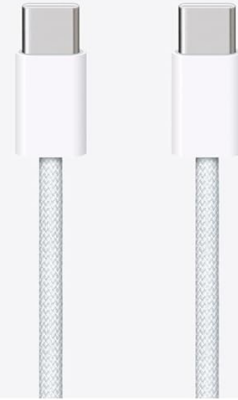

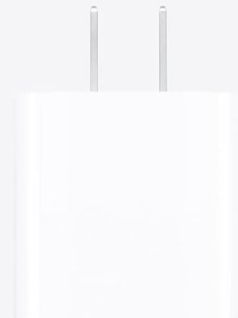

2.2 Powering On and Initial Setup

1. **Charge the iPad:** Connect the USB-C Charge Cable to the iPad's USB-C port and the 20W USB-C Power Adapter. Plug the adapter into a power outlet.
2. **Power On:** Press and hold the top button until the Apple logo appears.
3. **Follow On-Screen Instructions:** The iPad will guide you through selecting your language and region, connecting to Wi-Fi, setting up Touch ID, creating a passcode, and transferring data from a previous device or setting up as new.
4. **Apple ID:** Sign in with your Apple ID or create a new one to access services like the App Store, iCloud, and FaceTime.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Liquid Retina Display

The 11-inch Liquid Retina display features LED backlighting, Multi-Touch with IPS technology, and a resolution of 2360-by-1640 pixels at 264 ppi. It supports P3 wide color, True Tone for adaptive white balance, and has an antireflective coating for improved visibility. The display offers 500 nits brightness and supports Apple Pencil Pro and Apple Pencil (USB-C).

3.2 Performance with M3 Chip

The iPad Air is powered by the Apple M3 chip, featuring an 8-core CPU (4 performance cores, 4 efficiency cores), a 9-core GPU with hardware-accelerated ray tracing, and a 16-core Neural Engine. This configuration provides significant performance for demanding applications, graphic-intensive games, and efficient multitasking. The device includes 8GB RAM and a Media Engine for accelerated video processing.

3.3 Cameras and Video

The iPad Air features a **12MP Wide back camera** with an $f/1.8$ aperture, digital zoom up to 5x, and Smart HDR 4. It supports 4K video recording at various frame rates (24, 25, 30, or 60 fps) and offers cinematic video stabilization.

The **Landscape 12MP Center Stage front camera** with an $f/2.0$ aperture is optimized for video calls, supporting 1080p HD video recording and features like Center Stage, which keeps you in the frame during video calls. It also includes Smart HDR 4 and Retina Flash with True Tone.

3.4 Connectivity

All models support **Wi-Fi 6E (802.11ax)** with 2x2 MIMO for fast wireless connections and Bluetooth 5.3. Wi-Fi + Cellular models additionally support 5G (sub-6 GHz) and Gigabit LTE. The USB-C port supports charging, DisplayPort, and USB 3 (up to 10Gb/s) for connecting external devices and displays.

3.5 Apple Pencil and Magic Keyboard

The iPad Air is compatible with [Apple Pencil Pro](#) and [Apple Pencil \(USB-C\)](#), transforming it into a versatile tool for drawing, note-taking, and marking up documents. The [Magic Keyboard for iPad Air](#) provides a comfortable typing experience with an integrated trackpad and doubles as a protective cover.

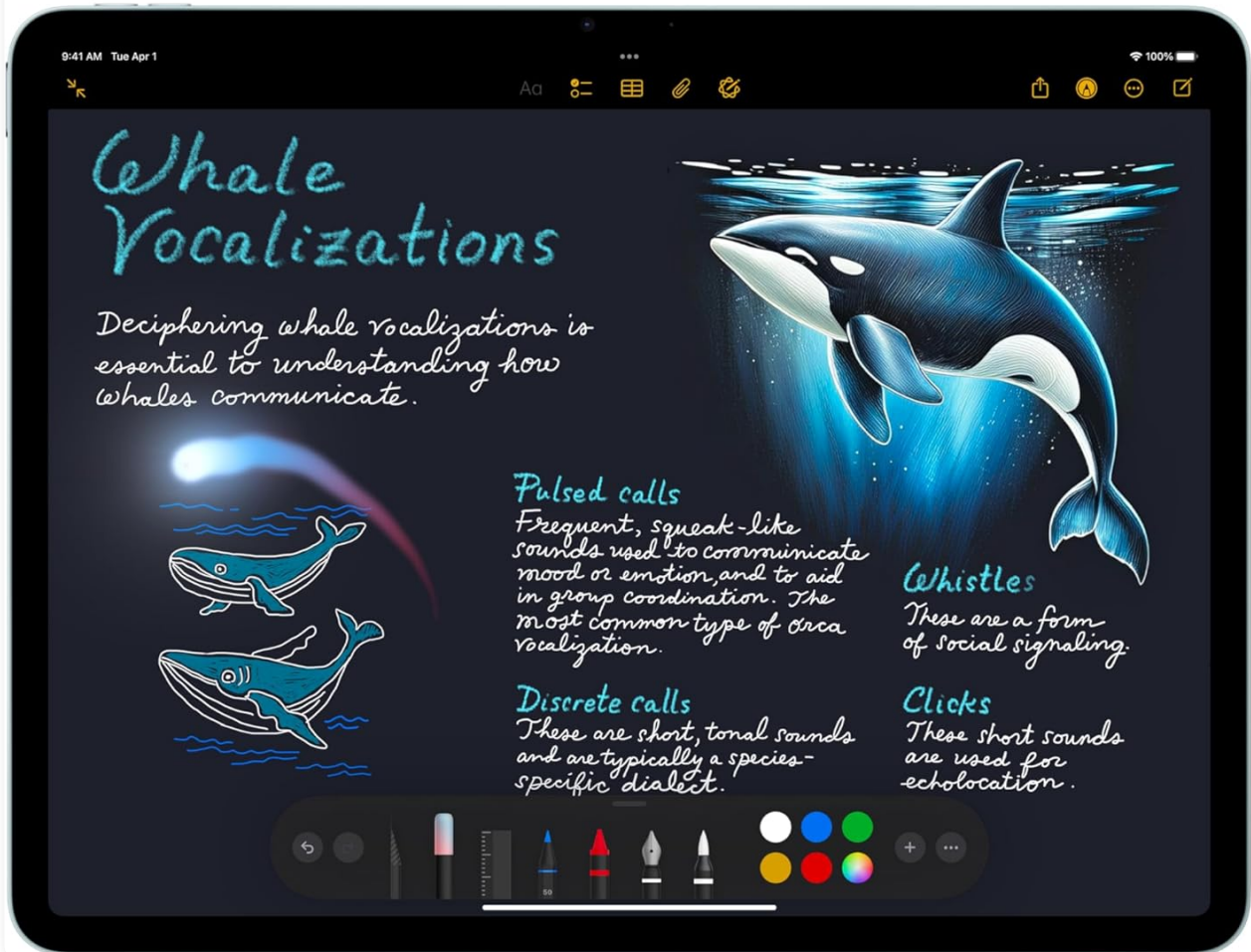

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Cleaning Your iPad Air

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and exterior.
- Avoid abrasive cloths, towels, paper towels, or similar items that could scratch the device.
- Do not use aerosol sprays, solvents, or abrasives.
- If necessary, lightly dampen the cloth with water.

4.2 Software Updates

Regularly update your iPadOS to ensure optimal performance, security, and access to the latest features. Go to **Settings > General > Software Update** to check for and install available updates.

4.3 Battery Care

To maximize battery lifespan, avoid exposing your iPad to extreme temperatures. For long-term storage, charge the battery to about 50% and power off the device.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your iPad Air, consider the following basic troubleshooting steps:

- **Restart:** A simple restart can resolve many minor software glitches. Press and hold the top button and either volume button until the power off slider appears, then drag the slider. To turn it back on, press and hold the top button.
- **Check Connections:** Ensure all cables (charging, accessories) are securely connected.
- **Software Updates:** Verify that your iPadOS is up to date.
- **App Issues:** If an app is not responding, force quit it by swiping up from the bottom of the screen (or double-pressing the Home button on older models) to open the App Switcher, then swipe the problematic app up and off the screen.
- **Wi-Fi/Bluetooth:** If experiencing connectivity issues, try toggling Wi-Fi or Bluetooth off and on in Control Center or Settings.
- **Factory Reset:** As a last resort for persistent software problems, you may need to erase all content and settings. Ensure you have a backup before proceeding (Settings > General > Transfer or Reset iPad > Erase All Content and Settings).
