EP-436 EntryPro Series 36-Door Networked Telephone Entry System

INSTRUCTION MANUAL

1. Product Overview

The EP-436 EntryPro Series is a sophisticated networked telephone entry system designed for managing access to up to thirty-six doors. This system integrates a 4.3-inch display with an intuitive keypad, providing a comprehensive and user-friendly solution for multi-door access control. 2. Setup and Installation

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power to unit / Display is off	Power cable disconnected, circuit breaker tripped, faulty power supply.	Check power connections. Verify circuit breaker. Test power supply.
Access code not working	Incorrect code entered, code expired, code not programmed, system error.	Verify code accuracy. Check code validity period. Confirm code is programmed in system. Restart unit if necessary.
Cannot connect to network	Ethernet cable disconnected, incorrect network settings, network issue.	Check Ethernet cable connection. Verify network settings (IP address, gateway). Consult network administrator.
Intercom call not connecting	Incorrect directory entry, faulty wiring, recipient phone issue.	Verify directory entry. Check intercom wiring. Ensure recipient phone is operational.
