SAFETY INFORMATION

To ensure safe use and prevent injury or damage, please adhere to the following safety guidelines:

- Always assemble the shelf according to the provided instructions.
- Distribute heavy items evenly on the shelves to prevent tipping.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 1000 lbs for the entire unit, and 60 lbs per individual shelf.
- Keep the shelf away from direct heat sources and avoid placing it near windows where it could be exposed to direct sunlight or extreme temperature fluctuations.
- Utilize the included wall connectors (anti-tipping device) to enhance security and stability, especially in households with children or pets.

- Secure Connections:** Ensure all screws, cam locks, and other fasteners are tightened securely, but do not overtighten to avoid damaging the wood.
- Install Anti-Tipping Device:** For safety, it is crucial to install the anti-tipping device as instructed. This secures the bookcase

to the wall, preventing accidental falls.

MAINTENANCE

- **Spills:** Immediately wipe up any spills to prevent staining or water damage.
- **Sunlight Exposure:** Prolonged exposure to direct sunlight can cause fading. Position the bookcase away from direct, intense sunlight if possible.
- **Humidity:** Maintain a stable humidity level in the room to prevent warping or cracking of the wood.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically check all assembly hardware (screws, bolts) and tighten if necessary to ensure stability.

TROUBLESHOOTING
