1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the proper installation, safe operation, and maintenance of your SECURA Log Spike, designed for compatibility with the Powertech PT5200 Chainsaw. Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and use to ensure safe and efficient operation.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):** Always wear appropriate PPE, including safety glasses, hearing protection, gloves, and protective clothing, when operating a chainsaw.
- **Inspect Before Use:** Before each use, inspect the log spike for any signs of damage, wear, or loose fasteners. Do not use if damaged.
- **Secure Attachment:** Ensure the log spike is securely attached to the chainsaw according to the installation instructions. A loose spike can be dangerous.
- **Stable Workpiece:** The log spike is designed to help stabilize the chainsaw against the workpiece. Always ensure the log or material being cut is stable and properly supported.
- **Keep Clear:** Maintain a safe distance from the cutting area and ensure no bystanders are in the vicinity.
- **Proper Handling:** Handle the chainsaw with both hands firmly. The log spike provides a pivot point, but control must be maintained at all times.

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Follow these steps to correctly install the SECURA Log Spike onto your Powertech PT5200 Chainsaw.

1. **Ensure Chainsaw is Off:** Before beginning installation, ensure the chainsaw engine is turned off, the spark plug cap is removed (if applicable), and the chain brake is engaged to prevent accidental startup.
2. **Locate Mounting Points:** Identify the designated mounting points on the side of your Powertech PT5200 Chainsaw's engine housing, typically near the guide bar attachment. These points are designed to accommodate the log spike.
3. **Align Log Spike:** Position the SECURA Log Spike against the chainsaw, aligning its two mounting holes with the corresponding holes on the chainsaw housing.
4. **Insert Fasteners:** Insert the appropriate bolts (not included, typically supplied with the chainsaw or purchased separately) through the log spike's holes and into the chainsaw's mounting points.
5. **Tighten Securely:** Using a suitable wrench, tighten the bolts firmly. Ensure the log spike is held securely in place and does not wobble. Do not overtighten, as this can damage the chainsaw housing.
6. **Final Check:** Visually inspect the installed log spike to confirm it is flush against the chainsaw and all fasteners are tight.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The log spike, also known as a bumper spike or felling dog, is used to provide leverage and stability when cutting wood.

- **Engage the Spike:** When making a cut, especially through larger logs, press the log spike firmly against the wood.
- **Pivot Point:** Use the spike as a pivot point to lever the chainsaw into the wood, reducing physical effort and improving control.
- **Maintain Control:** Always maintain a firm grip on both handles of the chainsaw. The spike assists in guiding the cut but does not replace proper chainsaw handling techniques.
- **Observe Kickback:** Be aware of potential kickback. The log spike can help mitigate some kickback by providing a stable anchor, but proper cutting angles and chain sharpness are crucial.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your log spike.

- **Cleaning:** After each use, clean any sawdust, sap, or debris from the log spike using a brush or cloth.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the log spike for signs of wear, bending, cracks, or dulling of the teeth. Also check the mounting bolts for tightness.
- **Replacement:** If the log spike becomes significantly worn or damaged, it should be replaced to maintain optimal performance and safety.
- **Storage:** Store the chainsaw with the log spike attached in a clean, dry place, away from moisture and extreme temperatures.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with the log spike.

- **Log Spike Feels Loose:**
 - Check the mounting bolts. Tighten them securely.
 - Inspect the mounting holes on both the spike and the chainsaw for damage or enlargement. If damaged, replacement may be necessary.
- **Log Spike Not Gripping Wood Effectively:**
 - Inspect the teeth of the log spike for excessive wear or dullness. A worn spike may need replacement.
 - Ensure you are applying sufficient pressure to engage the spike into the wood.







