SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Professional installation is highly recommended for the VIPER 3108V Security System. Incorrect installation can lead to vehicle damage or system malfunction. Please consult a certified automotive electronics technician for proper setup.

Key Installation Considerations:

- Main Unit Placement: The main control unit should be securely mounted in a hidden, dry location within the vehicle.
- **Siren Mounting:** Mount the siren in the engine compartment, facing downwards to prevent water accumulation, and away from heat sources.
- Antenna/Control Center: Position the antenna for optimal range, typically on the windshield or dashboard, ensuring the LED and valet switch are accessible.
- Wiring: All wiring connections must be secure, insulated, and routed away from moving parts or heat sources.
- Sensor Adjustment: The impact sensor sensitivity should be adjusted to prevent false alarms while still detecting legitimate threats.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using the Remote Transmitters:

- Arming the System (Lock Button): Press the Lock button once. The parking lights will flash once, and the siren will chirp once, indicating the system is armed. Doors will lock (if connected).
- **Disarming the System (Unlock Button):** Press the **Unlock** button once. The parking lights will flash twice, and the siren will chirp twice, indicating the system is disarmed. Doors will unlock (if connected).
- Trunk Release (Trunk Icon Button): Press and hold the Trunk Icon button for 3 seconds to open the vehicle's trunk (if connected).
- Auxiliary Function (Asterisk Button): Press the Asterisk (*) button to activate a programmed auxiliary function (e.g., power windows, rear defrost). Consult your installer for specific programming.
- Panic/Car Locator: Press and hold the Lock button for 3 seconds to activate the panic alarm. The siren will sound, and parking lights will flash. Press any button to turn off.

Valet Mode:

Valet mode allows you to temporarily disable the security features of the system, useful when servicing your vehicle. The keyless entry and auxiliary functions will still operate.

- Entering Valet Mode: Turn the ignition ON, then press and release the Valet Switch (integrated into the antenna) once. The LED will light solid, indicating valet mode is active.
- Exiting Valet Mode: Turn the ignition ON, then press and release the Valet Switch once. The LED will turn off, indicating valet mode is deactivated.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your VIPER 3108V Security System, follow these maintenance tips:

- Remote Battery Replacement: When the remote's range decreases or the LED on the remote dims, it's time to replace the battery. Refer to the remote's specific instructions for battery type and replacement procedure.
- Cleaning: Wipe the remote transmitters and Control Center with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Regular Testing:** Periodically test the system's arming, disarming, and siren functions to ensure everything is working correctly.

• **Professional Check-ups:** Consider having your system professionally inspected annually to ensure all components are functioning optimally and to check for any potential issues.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
System does not respond to remote.	Dead remote battery, out of range, or system in valet mode.	Replace remote battery. Move closer to the vehicle. Check if the system is in valet mode (solid LED on antenna) and exit if necessary.
Alarm triggers unexpectedly.	Impact sensor too sensitive, faulty sensor, or open door/hood/trunk.	Reduce impact sensor sensitivity. Check all doors, hood, and trunk are fully closed. If problem persists, consult an installer.
Siren does not sound.	Siren disconnected or faulty, or system in silent arm/disarm mode.	Check siren connection. Ensure system is not in silent mode (refer to installer for programming). If still no sound, siren may need replacement.
Keyless entry not working.	Vehicle's door lock actuators faulty, or system not properly connected to door locks.	Verify vehicle's door locks function manually. Consult an installer to check wiring and programming.




