PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Motorola RAZR 60 Ultra 5G 2025 is a foldable smartphone designed for advanced mobile communication and entertainment. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your device.

1. SETUP

1.1 Unboxing and Package Contents

Verify that all items are present in the package:

- Motorola Razr 60 Ultra (5G) Smartphone
- USB Type-C Cable
- SIM Tool
- Protective Case
- Quick Start Guide (this document)

1.2 SIM Card Installation

The device supports Dual SIM functionality (1x Nano-SIM slot, eSIM).

1. Power off the device.
2. Locate the SIM card tray on the side of the phone.
3. Insert the SIM tool into the small hole next to the tray to eject it.
4. Place your Nano-SIM card into the tray with the gold contacts facing down.
5. Carefully reinsert the tray into the phone.
6. For eSIM activation, follow the on-screen instructions during initial setup or refer to your carrier's guidelines.

1.3 Initial Power On and Setup

Press and hold the Power button until the Motorola logo appears. Follow the on-screen prompts to complete the initial setup, including language selection, Wi-Fi connection, Google account sign-in, and security settings.

2. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 Displays

- **Main Display:** A 7.0-inch 1224p Super HD Foldable AMOLED display with up to a 165Hz refresh rate. Unfold the device to access this primary screen.
- **External Display:** A 4.0-inch pOLED Flexible AMOLED display with up to a 165Hz refresh rate. This display provides quick access to notifications, widgets, and camera functions when the phone is folded.

2.2 Basic Navigation (Android 15)

Your device runs on Android 15. Navigate using gestures or on-screen buttons. Swipe up from the bottom to go home, swipe from the sides to go back, and swipe up and hold for recent apps.

2.3 Camera Usage

The device features a versatile camera system:

- **Rear Camera:** Dual 50 MP + 50 MP sensors for high-resolution photos and videos.
- **Front Camera:** A 50 MP sensor for selfies and video calls.

Open the Camera app from the home screen or external display to access various modes like Photo, Video, Portrait, and Night Vision.

2.4 Connectivity

The RAZR 60 Ultra supports multiple connectivity options:

- **Cellular:** 5G, 4G LTE, 3G, 2G GSM (Unlocked for GSM carriers).
- **Wi-Fi:** 802.11 a/b/g/n/ac/ax/be for high-speed internet access.
- **Bluetooth:** Version 5.4 for connecting wireless accessories.
- **NFC:** For contactless payments and quick pairing.
- **USB Type-C:** For charging and data transfer (USB 2.0).

2.5 Biometric Security

The device includes Fingerprint Recognition for secure unlocking and authentication. Set up your fingerprint in the Security settings menu.

3. MAINTENANCE

3.1 Battery Care

The device is equipped with a 4700 mAh non-removable battery. To prolong battery life:

- Avoid extreme temperatures.
- Use the provided USB Type-C cable and a compatible charger.
- Avoid fully discharging the battery frequently.

3.2 Cleaning Your Device

Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of the phone. Avoid abrasive materials or harsh chemicals. The device is **Not Water Resistant**, so avoid exposure to liquids.

3.3 Software Updates

Regularly check for and install software updates to ensure optimal performance and security. Go to *Settings > System > System updates*.

4. TROUBLESHOOTING

4.1 Common Issues

- **Device not powering on:** Ensure the battery is charged. Connect to a charger for at least 15 minutes before attempting to power on again.
- **Apps crashing:** Clear the app's cache (*Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage & cache > Clear cache*) or reinstall the app.
- **Poor network connectivity:** Check SIM card installation, restart the device, or contact your carrier.
- **Screen unresponsive:** Perform a force restart by holding the Power button for approximately 10-15 seconds.

4.2 Factory Reset

A factory reset will erase all data from your phone and restore it to its original factory settings. Back up important data before proceeding.

1. Go to *Settings > System > Reset options*
2. Select *Erase all data (factory reset)*.
3. Confirm your decision and enter your PIN/password if prompted.
