## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides detailed instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your new replacement laptop keyboard for the Huawei MateBook D14 2022 series. This keyboard features a Spanish (SP) layout and includes backlit functionality. Please read this manual thoroughly before proceeding with installation to ensure proper function and to avoid damage.

## 2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The replacement keyboard is designed to seamlessly integrate with your Huawei MateBook D14 2022 laptop, offering a comfortable and responsive typing experience. It includes all standard keys, function keys, and a dedicated numeric keypad (if applicable). The backlit feature enhances visibility in low-light conditions.

### 3. COMPATIBILITY

This keyboard is compatible with the following Huawei MateBook D14 2022 laptop models:

- NbDE-WDI9
- NbDE-WDH9
- NbDE-WFH9
- NbDE-WDH9AL
- NbDE-WFH9BL
- NbDE-WFE9

Before installation, verify your laptop's model number to ensure full compatibility. The model number is typically found on a sticker on the bottom of your laptop or within the system information settings.

### 4. INSTALLATION GUIDE

Installing a laptop keyboard requires careful handling and some technical proficiency. If you are unsure about any step, it is recommended to seek professional assistance.

## 4.1. Safety Precautions

- **Power Off:** Always ensure your laptop is completely powered off and disconnected from the power adapter.
- **Battery Disconnect:** Disconnect the internal battery before proceeding with any internal component replacement.
- **Static Discharge:** Use an anti-static wrist strap or frequently touch a grounded metal object to discharge static electricity.
- **Tools:** Use appropriate tools, such as small Phillips head screwdrivers and plastic spudgers, to avoid damaging components.

## 4.2. Required Tools

- Small Phillips head screwdriver
- Plastic spudger or pry tool
- Anti-static wrist strap (recommended)

## 4.3. Installation Steps

1. **Disassemble Laptop:** Carefully disassemble your laptop according to its specific service manual or a reliable disassembly guide for your Huawei MateBook D14 model. This typically involves removing the bottom cover, battery, and any components obstructing access to the keyboard.
2. **Locate Keyboard Cables:** Identify the keyboard ribbon cables (usually two: one for keys, one for backlight) connected to the motherboard.
3. **Disconnect Cables:** Gently lift the small retaining clips on the ZIF (Zero Insertion Force) connectors and carefully pull out the ribbon cables.
4. **Remove Old Keyboard:** Unscrew any screws securing the old keyboard and carefully pry it out from the laptop chassis. Note how it is seated.
5. **Install New Keyboard:** Position the new keyboard into the laptop chassis, ensuring it sits flush.
6. **Connect Cables:** Carefully insert the new keyboard's ribbon cables into their respective ZIF connectors on the motherboard and gently push down the retaining clips to secure them. Ensure the cables are fully inserted and not creased.
7. **Reassemble Laptop:** Reassemble your laptop by reversing the disassembly steps. Ensure all screws are tightened appropriately and no cables are pinched.
8. **Test Functionality:** After reassembly, connect the power adapter and power on the laptop. Test all keys, including function keys and the backlight, to ensure proper operation.

# 5. OPERATION

---

## 5.1. Basic Keyboard Functionality

The keyboard functions as a standard Spanish (SP) layout keyboard. All alphanumeric keys, punctuation, and special characters operate as expected. The layout includes specific keys for Spanish characters such as 'Ñ' and 'Ç', and accent marks.

## 5.2. Backlight Control

This keyboard features an integrated backlight. The backlight can typically be controlled using a dedicated function key combination on your laptop. Common combinations include:

- **Fn + F3** (to decrease brightness)
- **Fn + F4** (to increase brightness)
- **Fn + Spacebar** (some models use this for toggling backlight on/off or cycling brightness levels)

Refer to your laptop's original user manual for the exact key combination to control the keyboard backlight.

## 5.3. Function Keys (Fn)

The function keys (F1-F12) often have secondary functions when pressed in combination with the **Fn** key. These functions typically control:

- Screen brightness adjustment
- Volume control (mute, decrease, increase)
- Media playback controls (play/pause, stop, previous, next)
- Wireless (Wi-Fi/Bluetooth) toggle
- External display output switching
- Keyboard backlight control

The specific icons on the function keys indicate their secondary functions. Consult your laptop's documentation for a complete list of Fn key combinations.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

---

Proper maintenance can extend the lifespan of your keyboard and ensure optimal performance.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a mild cleaning solution to wipe the keycaps. Avoid spraying liquids directly onto the keyboard.
- **Dust Removal:** Use compressed air to remove dust and debris from between the keys. Hold the can upright to prevent propellant discharge.
- **Avoid Spills:** Protect the keyboard from liquid spills, as these can cause permanent damage to the internal circuitry.
- **Gentle Use:** Avoid excessive force when typing or cleaning, which can damage key mechanisms.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your new keyboard, try the following troubleshooting steps:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Keyboard not responding	Loose ribbon cable connection, incorrect installation, driver issue.	Ensure ribbon cables are securely connected. Reinstall keyboard drivers (if applicable). Restart laptop.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Certain keys not working	Dust/debris under key, faulty key mechanism, damaged ribbon cable.	Use compressed air to clear debris. Check ribbon cable for damage. If problem persists, the key or keyboard may be faulty.
Backlight not working	Backlight ribbon cable loose/damaged, backlight driver issue, incorrect Fn key combination.	Ensure backlight ribbon cable is securely connected. Try different Fn key combinations. Update display/keyboard drivers.
Incorrect key output (e.g., 'Z' types 'Y')	Incorrect keyboard language setting in operating system.	Verify and set the keyboard language to "Spanish (Spain)" or "Spanish (Traditional Sort)" in your operating system settings.

If these steps do not resolve the issue, consider contacting the seller or a qualified technician for further assistance.
