IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury.

- Do not operate the air purifier with a damaged cord or plug.
- Keep the power cord away from heated surfaces.
- Do not immerse the air purifier in water or other liquids.
- Unplug the appliance before cleaning or performing any maintenance.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- Do not block air inlets or outlets.
- Use only genuine AIRTOK replacement filters.



Control Panel Features:

- **Power Button:** Turns the unit on/off.
- **Fan Speed Button:** Cycles through Low, Medium, and High fan speeds.
- **Timer Button:** Sets the operating time for 2, 4, or 8 hours.
- **Child Lock Button:** Prevents accidental changes to settings.
- **Night Light Button:** Toggles the night light on/off.
- **Filter Reset Indicator:** Illuminates when filter replacement is needed.

SETUP

Before First Use: Filter Installation

The H13 True HEPA filter comes pre-installed in the unit but is sealed in plastic packaging. You must remove this packaging before operating the air purifier.

1. **Step 1:** Place the appliance upside down. Turn the bottom cover counter-clockwise to unlock it.
2. **Step 2:** Remove the old filter (if replacing) or the new filter with its plastic packaging.
3. **Step 3:** Remove the plastic packaging from the new filter and install the new filter into the unit.
4. **Step 4:** Turn the base cover clockwise to lock it securely.
5. **Step 5:** Plug in the air purifier. If the filter indicator light is on, press and hold the filter button for 3 seconds until you hear a beep to reset the filter life counter.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Power On/Off

- Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.
- Press the **Power Button** on the control panel to turn the unit on. The purifier will start in the default fan speed.
- Press the **Power Button** again to turn the unit off.

Adjusting Fan Speed

- Press the **Fan Speed Button** to cycle through the available fan speeds: Low, Medium, and High.
- The current fan speed setting will be indicated on the LED display.

Timer Function

- Press the **Timer Button** to set the operating time. Each press will cycle through 2 hours, 4 hours, 8 hours, and then continuous operation (no timer).
- The selected timer duration will be displayed on the control panel. The unit will automatically turn off once the set time has elapsed.

Timer Function

Don't worry about leaving the air purifier on—set a timer for 2, 4 or 8 hours.

Night Light and Sleep Mode

- Press the **Night Light Button** to turn the night light on or off.
- In Sleep Mode, the fan operates at its lowest speed (approx. 25 dB) and the display lights are dimmed or turned off to ensure a quiet and undisturbed sleeping environment.

Sleep Soundly Every Night

Use a Lowest Fan Speed with Gentle Night Light for Sleep Deeply

Child Lock Function

- To activate the Child Lock, press and hold the **Child Lock Button** for 3 seconds. The child lock indicator will illuminate.
- Once activated, all other buttons on the control panel will be unresponsive.
- To deactivate the Child Lock, press and hold the **Child Lock Button** again for 3 seconds. The indicator light will turn off.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning the Air Purifier

- Always unplug the air purifier before cleaning.
- Wipe the exterior of the unit with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

- The air intake vents can be cleaned with a soft brush or vacuum cleaner to remove dust buildup.

Filter Replacement

The filter replacement indicator light will illuminate when it's time to replace the filter, typically every 3-4 months, depending on usage and air quality. Using a dirty filter will reduce the purification efficiency.

Follow the steps outlined in the "Setup: Filter Installation" section to replace the filter. Remember to reset the filter life counter by pressing and holding the filter button for 3 seconds after replacement.

Note: Only use genuine AIRTOK replacement filters to ensure optimal performance and maintain warranty validity.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Air purifier does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outage; child lock activated.	Ensure power cord is securely plugged in. Check power outlet. Deactivate child lock by pressing and holding the child lock button for 3 seconds.
Airflow is weak or purification is ineffective.	Filter is dirty or clogged; air inlets/outlets blocked.	Replace the filter. Ensure there are no obstructions around the air intake and outlet vents.
Unit is making unusual noise.	Filter not installed correctly; foreign object inside.	Check if the filter is properly seated and the bottom cover is securely locked. Unplug the unit and check for any foreign objects.
Filter replacement indicator remains on after changing filter.	Filter life counter not reset.	Press and hold the filter button for 3 seconds to reset the filter life counter.



