3. SETUP

3.1. Installing Batteries

1. Locate the battery compartment cover on the back of the remote control.
2. Slide the cover downwards or press the latch to open it.
3. Insert two AAA batteries (not included), ensuring the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals align correctly with the indicators inside the compartment.
4. Replace the battery compartment cover by sliding it back into place until it clicks securely.

3.2. Initial Pairing/Programming

This universal remote is designed to work with a wide range of devices. Depending on your specific device (TV, U-Verse S10 Receiver, Streaming Device, Cable Box), programming may involve different methods. Please try the following common methods:

- **Automatic Code Search:**

- a. Turn on the device you wish to control (e.g., TV, Cable Box).
- b. Press and hold the 'SET' button (or a similar programming button, if available) on the remote until the indicator light stays on.
- c. While holding 'SET', press the device button you want to program (e.g., 'TV', 'STB'). The indicator light should blink.
- d. Release both buttons.
- e. Point the remote at the device and repeatedly press the 'POWER' button until the device turns off.
- f. Once the device turns off, immediately press the 'SET' button again to save the code. The indicator light should turn off.
- g. Test other functions like volume and channel to ensure proper operation.

- **Manual Code Entry:**

- a. Refer to the code list provided with your remote (if applicable) or search online for codes specific to your device brand.
- b. Turn on the device you wish to control.
- c. Press and hold the 'SET' button until the indicator light stays on.
- d. Enter the 3 or 4-digit code for your device using the number buttons. The indicator light should blink with each digit entered.
- e. If the code is valid, the indicator light will turn off. If it blinks rapidly, the code is incorrect; try another code.
- f. Test the remote's functions. If it doesn't work, try the next code on the list.

Note: For U-Verse S10 Receiver compatibility, some users have reported challenges with direct linking. Ensure your receiver is in a discoverable mode or consult your U-Verse receiver's manual for specific remote pairing instructions if automatic or manual code entry does not yield results.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once programmed, your universal remote can control various functions of your entertainment devices. Below are common button functions:

4.1. Device Selection Buttons

- **STB:** Selects the Set-Top Box (e.g., U-Verse S10 Receiver, Cable Box).
- **TV:** Selects the Television.
- **DVD:** Selects a DVD/Blu-ray player.
- **AUX:** Selects an auxiliary device.

4.2. Basic Control Buttons

- **POWER:** Turns the selected device on or off.
- **VOL +/-:** Adjusts the volume up or down.
- **CH +/-:** Changes channels up or down.
- **MUTE:** Mutes or unmutes the audio.
- **LAST:** Returns to the previously viewed channel.

- **GUIDE:** Displays the program guide.
- **MENU:** Accesses the device's main menu.
- **OK / ENTER:** Confirms a selection or enters a menu.
- **Navigation Arrows (Up, Down, Left, Right):** Navigates through menus and options.
- **BACK:** Returns to the previous screen or menu.
- **INFO:** Displays information about the current program or selection.

4.3. Playback and DVR Control Buttons

- **RECORD:** Starts recording the current program.
- **STOP:** Stops playback or recording.
- **PLAY:** Starts playback.
- **PAUSE:** Pauses playback.
- **REW (Rewind):** Rewinds playback.
- **FFWD (Fast Forward):** Fast forwards playback.
- **SKIP:** Skips forward.
- **REPLAY:** Replays a short segment.

4.4. Numeric Keypad

- **0-9:** Used for direct channel entry, code entry, or numeric input.
- **ENTER / ZOOM:** Confirms channel entry or activates zoom function.
- **DELETE:** Deletes characters or items.
- **SPACE:** Inserts a space.

4.5. Special Function Buttons

- **ON DEMAND:** Accesses On Demand content.
- **SETUP:** Used for remote programming or device setup.
- **BROWSE:** Opens a browsing interface.
- **GO INTERACTIVE:** Accesses interactive features.
- **EXIT TO TV:** Switches back to live TV.
- **A, B, C, D (Colored Buttons):** Often used for specific functions within menus or applications, as indicated on screen.

5. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the remote. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Battery Replacement:** Replace batteries when the remote's response becomes sluggish or the indicator light does not illuminate. Always replace both batteries at the same time with new ones of the same type.
- **Storage:** Store the remote in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. If storing for extended periods, remove the batteries to prevent leakage.
- **Avoid Drops:** Protect the remote from physical impact, as drops can damage internal components.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Universal Replacement Remote, please refer to the table below for common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Remote not responding to device.	Batteries are dead or incorrectly inserted. Remote is not programmed correctly for the device. Obstruction between remote and device.	Replace batteries, ensuring correct polarity. Re-program the remote using the setup instructions. Remove any obstructions and ensure direct line of sight.
Some buttons work, but others don't.	Partial programming or specific button malfunction.	Try re-programming the remote. If the issue persists, the button may be faulty.
Device does not turn off/on with the power button.	Incorrect code programmed or device is not compatible.	Try different programming codes for your device. Verify device compatibility with the remote. Note that some U-Verse S10 receivers may require specific pairing steps from their own manual.
Indicator light does not illuminate.	Batteries are completely drained or remote is damaged.	Replace batteries. If still no light, the remote may be damaged and require replacement.
