1. INTRODUCTION

This instruction manual provides important information regarding the installation, use, and maintenance of your new aqinsfai replacement inner pot for Toshiba rice cookers. Please read this manual carefully before using the product to ensure proper function and longevity.

This inner pot is designed as a high-quality replacement part, ensuring compatibility and performance with specific Toshiba rice cooker models.

3. COMPATIBILITY

This aqinsfai inner pot is specifically designed to be compatible with the following Toshiba rice cooker models:

- **Toshiba RC-18NMF**
- **Toshiba RC-18JMC**
- **Toshiba RC-18NMI**

Please verify your rice cooker model number before installation to ensure proper fit and function.

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Follow these steps to install the replacement inner pot into your compatible Toshiba rice cooker:

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove the new inner pot from its packaging.
2. **Inspect:** Check the inner pot for any signs of damage from shipping. If damaged, do not use and contact customer support.
3. **Clean:** Before first use, wash the inner pot with warm, soapy water and rinse thoroughly. Dry completely.
4. **Placement:** Gently place the clean inner pot into the main body of your Toshiba rice cooker. Ensure it sits flat and securely within the heating element. Do not force it.
5. **Verify Fit:** Confirm that the inner pot is properly seated and does not wobble. A correct fit is crucial for efficient and safe operation of the rice cooker.

Once installed, your rice cooker is ready for use with the new inner pot.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The aqinsfai inner pot functions as the cooking vessel within your Toshiba rice cooker. Its operation is directly tied to the rice cooker's main unit.

1. **Add Ingredients:** Place your desired amount of rice and water into the inner pot according to your recipe or the markings inside the pot.
2. **Close Lid:** Ensure the rice cooker lid is properly closed and sealed.
3. **Start Cooking:** Operate your Toshiba rice cooker as per its original instruction manual. The inner pot will facilitate the cooking process by evenly distributing heat.
4. **Serving:** After cooking, use a non-abrasive rice paddle or spoon to serve rice from the inner pot to avoid scratching the non-stick surface.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** After each use, allow the inner pot to cool down. Wash it with warm water and a mild dish soap using a soft sponge or cloth.
- **Dishwasher Use:** The inner pot is dishwasher safe. Place it on the top rack for best results.
- **Avoid Abrasives:** Do not use abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, or metal utensils, as these can damage the non-stick coating.
- **Stubborn Food:** For stubborn food residue, soak the pot in warm, soapy water for a period before cleaning.
- **Storage:** Store the clean and dry inner pot inside the rice cooker or in a safe place to prevent scratches or dents.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your aqinsfai replacement inner pot, consider the following:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Inner pot does not fit properly.	Incorrect model compatibility or improper placement.	Verify your rice cooker model number against the compatible list (Section 3). Ensure the pot is seated flat and centered.
Food sticks to the pot.	Damaged non-stick coating or insufficient water/oil.	Ensure you are using appropriate cooking ratios. Avoid using metal utensils. If coating is severely damaged, replacement may be necessary.
Uneven cooking.	Inner pot not seated correctly or issue with the rice cooker's heating element.	Check that the inner pot is fully seated. If the problem persists, consult your Toshiba rice cooker's manual for troubleshooting its heating system.
