## 1. INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the user manual for your new Google Pixel 9 smartphone. This guide provides essential information on setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your device. The Google Pixel 9 combines advanced technology with user-friendly design, offering a powerful and intuitive mobile experience.

## 2. SETUP

### 2.1. Unboxing and Initial Charge

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Before first use, it is recommended to fully charge your Pixel 9 using the provided USB-C to USB-C cable and a compatible power adapter (sold separately).

### 2.2. Inserting the SIM Card

1. Locate the SIM card tray on the side of your Pixel 9.
2. Insert the SIM ejector tool (included in the box) into the small hole on the tray and press firmly until the tray pops out.
3. Place your Nano SIM card(s) into the tray with the gold contacts facing down. The Pixel 9 supports Dual SIM functionality.
4. Gently push the tray back into the phone until it clicks into place.

### 2.3. Powering On and Initial Configuration

Press and hold the Power button on the side of the device until the Google logo appears. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the initial setup, including connecting to Wi-Fi, signing in with your Google

account, and setting up security features like fingerprint recognition.

## 3. OPERATING YOUR GOOGLE PIXEL 9

### 3.1. Display and Navigation

The Pixel 9 features a 6.3-inch OLED display with a dynamic refresh rate up to 120Hz, providing smooth visuals. Navigate the device using touch gestures. Swipe up from the bottom to go home, swipe from the sides to go back, and swipe up and hold for recent apps.

### 3.2. Performance

Powered by the Google Tensor G4 processor and 12 GB of RAM, the Pixel 9 delivers efficient multitasking and responsive performance for applications and games.

### 3.3. Camera System

The Pixel 9 is equipped with a dual rear camera system: a 50 MP main sensor and a 48 MP ultrawide lens (123° field of view). The front camera is 10.5 MP. Advanced AI features enhance photography, including:

- **Add Me:** Allows users to insert themselves into photos.
- **Pixel Studio:** Enables image creation from text prompts.

The device includes a 4700 mAh battery. It supports 45W USB-PD fast charging and 15W wireless charging. For optimal charging, use compatible USB-PD chargers.

### 3.5. Security Features

Unlock your device securely using the integrated fingerprint recognition sensor.

### 4.1. Durability and Protection

The Pixel 9 is designed with durability in mind, featuring Corning Gorilla Glass Victus 2 for scratch resistance and protection against minor drops and spills. It is also water resistant.

Google provides seven years of OS and security updates for the Pixel 9, ensuring your device remains secure and up-to-date with the latest features. Regularly check for and install available updates via Settings > System > System update.

To clean your Pixel 9, use a soft, lint-free cloth. Avoid abrasive materials or harsh chemicals. For stubborn marks, slightly dampen the cloth with water. Do not submerge the device in water.

- **Restart the Device:** A simple restart can resolve many minor software glitches.
- **Check for Software Updates:** Ensure your device is running the latest software version.

- **Clear Cache:** For app-specific issues, try clearing the app's cache via Settings > Apps.
- **Factory Reset:** As a last resort, a factory reset can resolve persistent software problems. Back up your data before performing a factory reset.
