Components

The AIPER Scuba S1 consists of the main robotic unit, an internal dual filtration system, and a charging adapter. The robotic unit features a control panel, durable caterpillar tracks for movement, and brushes for scrubbing surfaces.

SETUP

- 1. **Initial Charging:** Before first use, fully charge the robot using the provided charging adapter. Ensure the charging port is dry before connecting. The battery indicator will show charging status.
- 2. **Filter Installation:** Ensure the desired filter (standard or ultrafine) is correctly installed in the filter basket. Refer to the "Maintenance" section for details on filter types and installation.
- 3. **App Download and Connection:** Download the AIPER app from your device's app store. Follow the in-app instructions to pair your Scuba S1 cleaner via Bluetooth or Wi-Fi. This enables smart control and OTA updates.
- 4. **Placement in Pool:** Gently lower the cleaner into the pool. Ensure it is fully submerged and air bubbles have escaped before starting operation.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Starting a Cleaning Cycle

- 1. Manual Start: Press the power button on the robot's control panel once it is submerged in the pool.
- 2. App Start: Open the AIPER app, select your Scuba S1, and choose your desired cleaning mode.

Cleaning Modes

- Automatic: Cleans both the pool floor and walls, including the waterline.
- Floor Only: Focuses cleaning solely on the pool floor.
- Wall Only: Cleans only the pool walls and waterline.
- ECO Mode: Provides periodic cleaning for ongoing maintenance.

The WavePath 2.0 navigation system optimizes the cleaning path for maximum coverage, ensuring no area is missed.

Retrieving the Cleaner

Once the cleaning cycle is complete or the battery is low, the cleaner will typically move to the edge of the pool. Use the floating line or carefully pull the cleaner out of the water using its handle. Avoid pulling it out by the power cord (if applicable) or other delicate parts.

MAINTENANCE

Filter Cleaning

Regular cleaning of the filter basket and filters is crucial for maintaining optimal cleaning performance.

- 1. Remove the cleaner from the pool and open the filter compartment.
- 2. Extract the filter basket.
- 3. Rinse the filter basket and filters thoroughly with a garden hose. For the 3-micron ultrafine filter, handle with care as the fibers can be delicate.

4. Ensure all debris is removed before reinserting the filters and closing the compartment.

General Cleaning and Storage

- Wipe down the exterior of the cleaner with a soft cloth after each use.
- Store the cleaner in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Ensure the battery is charged periodically during long storage periods to maintain battery health.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cleaner does not turn on.	Low battery; power button not pressed correctly.	Charge the cleaner fully. Ensure the power button is pressed firmly.
Poor cleaning performance / Not picking up fine debris.	Clogged filter; incorrect filter type for debris; worn brushes.	Clean the filter basket and filters thoroughly. Ensure the 3-micron ultrafine filter is used for fine debris. Inspect and replace brushes if worn.
Cleaner gets stuck or moves erratically.	Obstruction; air trapped inside; software glitch.	Remove any large obstructions. Gently shake the cleaner to release trapped air. If using the app, check for and apply any available OTA updates. Try restarting the cleaner.
Cleaner does not climb walls effectively.	Low battery; dirty brushes/tracks; water chemistry imbalance.	Ensure the battery is fully charged. Clean the caterpillar tracks and brushes. Check pool water chemistry (e.g., calcium hardness, pH).


