5. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Installation Steps:

1. **Prepare the Vehicle:** Park the vehicle on a level surface, engage the parking brake, and turn off the engine. Disconnect the negative terminal of the vehicle's battery to prevent accidental airbag deployment or electrical shorts. Wait at least 10 minutes after disconnecting the battery before proceeding.
2. **Access the Steering Wheel Controls:** Carefully remove the airbag module from the steering wheel according to your vehicle's service manual. This typically involves releasing clips or screws from the rear or sides of the steering wheel.
3. **Disconnect Old Switch:** Locate the wiring harness connected to the existing steering wheel control switch. Gently disconnect the electrical connectors and unclip the old switch from its mounting points.
4. **Install New Switch:** Align the QDXCJF replacement switch with the mounting points on the steering wheel. Press firmly until it clicks securely into place. Connect the electrical wiring harness to the new switch, ensuring all connections are snug.
5. **Reassemble Steering Wheel:** Carefully reattach the airbag module to the steering wheel, ensuring all clips or screws are properly secured.
6. **Reconnect Battery:** Reconnect the negative terminal of the vehicle's battery.
7. **Test Functionality:** Start the vehicle and test all functions of the new steering wheel control switch, including audio volume, track selection, mode, and cruise control, to ensure proper operation.

 - Check for any blown fuses related to the audio system or cruise control in your vehicle's fuse box (refer to your vehicle's owner's manual for fuse locations).
- **Intermittent Functionality:**
 - Loose connections can cause intermittent operation. Re-check all wiring connections.
 - Ensure the switch is securely seated in its mounting points within the steering wheel.
- **Incorrect Functionality:**
 - Double-check that the installed switch is the correct OE part number (84250-02560) for your specific vehicle model and year. An incorrect part may lead to incompatible functions.
