1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the MasterPRO FOODIES 1000W Blender. This appliance is designed for efficient blending, mixing, pureeing, and crushing various ingredients, including ice. To ensure safe and optimal performance, please read this instruction manual thoroughly before first use and retain it for future reference.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons.

- Read all instructions before operating the blender.
- Do not immerse the motor base in water or other liquids. Clean only with a damp cloth.
- Unplug from the outlet when not in use, before assembling or disassembling parts, and before cleaning.
- Avoid contact with moving parts. Blades are sharp. Handle with care.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been dropped or damaged in any manner.
- The use of attachments not recommended or sold by the manufacturer may cause fire, electric shock, or injury.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let the cord hang over the edge of a table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Always operate the blender with the lid in place.
- Never put your hands or other utensils into the blender jar while blending to avoid severe injury and damage to the blender.
- Ensure the safety lock system is engaged before operating.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

3. PRODUCT COMPONENTS

Familiarize yourself with the parts of your MasterPRO FOODIES Blender:

- **Motor Base:** Contains the 1000W motor, control dial, and power cord.
- **Glass Jar (1.5 L):** The main blending container with measurement markings.
- **Blade Assembly:** Stainless steel blades attached to a base, designed for efficient blending and crushing.
- **Lid:** Covers the glass jar during operation.
- **Lid Cap:** A removable cap in the lid for adding ingredients during blending.

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Before first use, wash all parts that will come into contact with food (glass jar, lid, lid cap, and blade assembly) in warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry. The motor base should only be wiped with a damp cloth.

1. Place the motor base on a clean, dry, and stable surface. Ensure the power cord is unplugged from the electrical outlet.
2. Carefully attach the blade assembly to the bottom of the glass jar by twisting it clockwise until securely fastened.
3. Place the assembled glass jar onto the motor base. Ensure it is seated correctly and the safety lock system engages. You should feel it click into place.
4. Add your ingredients to the glass jar. Do not exceed the maximum fill line indicated on the jar.
5. Place the lid securely onto the glass jar, then insert the lid cap into the opening in the lid.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once the blender is assembled and filled with ingredients:

1. Plug the power cord into a 220V electrical outlet.
2. Turn the control dial to your desired speed setting:
 - **Speed 1:** For softer ingredients and lighter blending tasks.
 - **Speed 2:** For harder ingredients and more intensive blending, such as crushing ice.
 - **Pulse (P):** For short bursts of power. Turn the dial to 'P' and hold, then release to stop. This is ideal for chopping or when you need precise control over consistency.
3. Do not operate the blender continuously for more than 60 seconds. Allow the motor to rest for a few minutes between cycles to prevent overheating.
4. If you need to add ingredients during blending, remove the lid cap and carefully add them through the opening. Replace the cap immediately.
5. Once blending is complete, turn the control dial to the '0' (off) position and unplug the appliance.
6. Carefully remove the glass jar from the motor base and pour out the contents.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Proper cleaning and maintenance will extend the life of your blender.

1. Always unplug the blender before cleaning.
2. **Motor Base:** Wipe the motor base with a damp cloth. Do not immerse it in water or any other liquid.
3. **Glass Jar, Lid, and Blade Assembly:** These parts can be washed in warm, soapy water. For stubborn residue, you can fill the jar with warm water and a drop of dish soap, then run the blender on a low speed for a few seconds. Rinse thoroughly. The glass jar and blade assembly are generally dishwasher safe, but always check for specific markings or consult the manufacturer's website if unsure.
4. Dry all parts thoroughly before reassembling or storing.
5. Store the blender in a dry place.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your blender, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Blender does not turn on.	Not plugged in; safety lock not engaged; power outage.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged in. Check that the glass jar is correctly seated and locked onto the motor base. Verify power supply.
Ingredients are not blending smoothly.	Too little liquid; too many ingredients; ingredients are too large.	Add more liquid. Reduce the amount of ingredients. Cut ingredients into smaller pieces. Use the pulse function to break up larger chunks.
Blender stops during operation.	Overheating; motor overload.	Turn off and unplug the blender. Remove some ingredients if overloaded. Let the motor cool down for at least 15-20 minutes before restarting.
Leakage from the bottom of the jar.	Blade assembly not tightened; seal damaged.	Ensure the blade assembly is securely twisted onto the glass jar. Check the rubber seal for damage and replace if necessary.
