


Image: Various plastic sprues containing the unbuilt components of the Revell Tyrrell P34/2 model kit, including body panels, chassis, and wheels.

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

This model kit requires assembly, painting, and decaling. Please read the entire instruction manual before starting. Recommended tools (not included) typically include plastic cement, hobby knife, side cutters, sandpaper, paint, and brushes.

- Preparation:** Carefully remove all parts from the sprues using side cutters. Clean any excess plastic (flash) with a hobby knife or sandpaper.
- Sub-Assembly:** Follow the illustrated instructions to assemble smaller components first, such as the engine, cockpit, and suspension.
- Painting:** Paint parts according to the color guide provided in the instructions. Allow paint to dry completely before proceeding.
- Main Assembly:** Attach sub-assemblies to the main chassis and body. Ensure proper alignment and secure bonding with plastic cement.
- Decals:** Apply decals carefully using water and a decal setting solution for best results. Refer to the decal placement guide.
- Final Details:** Attach any remaining small parts, such as mirrors, antennas, and the rear wing.

## DISPLAY AND CARE

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Once assembled, your Revell Tyrrell P34/2 model is a display piece. Handle it with care to prevent damage to delicate parts and paintwork.

- **Display Location:** Place your model on a stable, flat surface away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity to prevent fading or warping.
- **Cleaning:** Dust regularly with a soft, dry brush or a gentle air blower. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cloths, which can damage the paint and decals.
- **Handling:** Always pick up the model by its sturdy base or main body. Avoid touching delicate parts like wings, mirrors, or antennas.

## TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

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Here are solutions to common problems encountered during model kit assembly:

Problem	Solution
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Problem	Solution
Parts do not fit together properly.	Ensure all sprue gates are cleanly removed. Lightly sand mating surfaces if necessary. Verify part numbers against the instructions.
Decals do not adhere or wrinkle.	Ensure the surface is clean and glossy. Use decal setting solution to help decals conform to irregular surfaces and eliminate air bubbles.
Paint finish is uneven or rough.	Apply paint in thin, even coats. Ensure proper ventilation and temperature. Allow sufficient drying time between coats. Lightly sand between coats if needed.
Small parts break during removal or assembly.	Use sharp, appropriate tools (e.g., fine-point hobby knife, precision side cutters). Exercise caution and apply minimal force. Repair with plastic cement if possible.
