- 2. **Inspect System:** While the reservoir is empty, inspect for any signs of leaks or damage to hoses and connections. Address any issues before refilling.
- 3. **Refill Reservoir:** Slowly pour the BraunAbility 406416KS Hydraulic Fluid into the reservoir. Use a funnel to prevent spills.
- 4. Check Fluid Level: Fill to the "FULL" mark indicated on the reservoir or dipstick. Do not overfill.
- 5. **Bleed System (if necessary):** Some hydraulic systems may require bleeding to remove air. Consult your lift's manual for this procedure.
- 6. Secure Cap: Replace and securely tighten the reservoir cap.
- 7. **Test Operation:** Restore power to the lift and perform several full cycles (up and down) to circulate the new fluid and check for proper operation and leaks.

5. MAINTENANCE GUIDELINES

Regular inspection and timely replacement of hydraulic fluid are essential for the longevity and safe operation of your Braun wheelchair lift.

- Fluid Clarity: Periodically check the hydraulic fluid for clarity. The fluid should be clear and free of discoloration or particles.
- Replacement Schedule: Replace the hydraulic fluid whenever it becomes unclear, discolored, or at
 intervals recommended by your lift's manufacturer, typically every 1-2 years or as specified in your lift's
 manual.
- Fluid Level: Regularly check the fluid level and top off if necessary, using only BraunAbility 406416KS Hydraulic Fluid.
- Leak Detection: Inspect the hydraulic system for any signs of leaks around hoses, fittings, and cylinders. Address leaks immediately.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Lift operates slowly or erratically.	Low hydraulic fluid level, contaminated fluid, or air in the system.	Check fluid level and top off. If fluid is unclear, replace it. Bleed the system if air is suspected (refer to lift manual).

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Hydraulic fluid appears cloudy or discolored.	Fluid contamination (water, dirt, or other fluids) or degradation.	Replace the hydraulic fluid immediately. Inspect the system for sources of contamination.
Fluid leakage.	Loose fittings, damaged hoses, or worn seals.	Identify the source of the leak. Tighten fittings, replace damaged hoses or seals. Consult a qualified technician for repairs.



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
