1. INTRODUCTION

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Salange HY260Pro is a compact smart projector featuring native 1080P resolution with 4K support, automatic focus and keystone correction, and integrated Android 11 OS for direct streaming. It includes WiFi 6 and Bluetooth 5.4 connectivity, along with a short-throw lens for flexible placement.

2.1 Key Features

- **Native 1080P Resolution:** Delivers clear, sharp images. Supports 4K video input.
- **Auto Focus & Auto Keystone:** Automatically adjusts image clarity and shape for optimal viewing.
- **Short Throw Ratio (0.8:1):** Projects large images from a short distance.
- **Android 11 OS:** Access built-in streaming applications directly.
- **WiFi 6 Connectivity:** Dual-band 2.4G/5G for stable and fast wireless streaming.
- **Bluetooth 5.4:** For connecting external audio devices.
- **Built-in 5W Hi-Fi Speaker:** Provides integrated audio.
- **180° Adjustable Stand:** Allows for versatile projection angles, including ceiling projection.

2.2 Ports and Connections

The projector includes various ports for connecting external devices:

- HDMI Input
- USB Port
- Audio Output (3.5mm jack)
- Power Input

3. SETUP

3.1 Initial Power-On

1. Connect the power cord to the projector's power input and then to a power outlet.
2. Press the power button on the projector or the remote control to turn on the device.

3.2 Placement and Projection

Position the projector on a stable surface. The short-throw lens allows for a 100-inch screen from approximately 5 feet away. The 180° adjustable stand offers flexibility for various projection angles, including walls and ceilings.

Short Throw Projector 0.8:1

Experience a giant 100-inch screen from just 5 feet away, which cuts projection distance in half compared to other projector.

3.3 Auto Focus and Keystone Correction

The projector features automatic focus and keystone correction to ensure a clear and rectangular image. These adjustments typically occur within seconds of powering on or repositioning the projector.

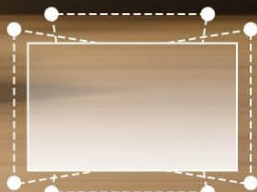
- **Auto Focus:** The projector automatically adjusts the lens for optimal clarity.
- **Auto Keystone Correction:** The image is automatically squared, even if the projector is placed at an angle.
- **Manual Trapezoid Adjustment:** If side projection is required, use the remote control to navigate to "Projection Settings" > "Manual Trapezoid" to fine-tune the four corners of the projection screen.
- **Digital Zoom:** Adjust the image size from 50% to 100% via settings.

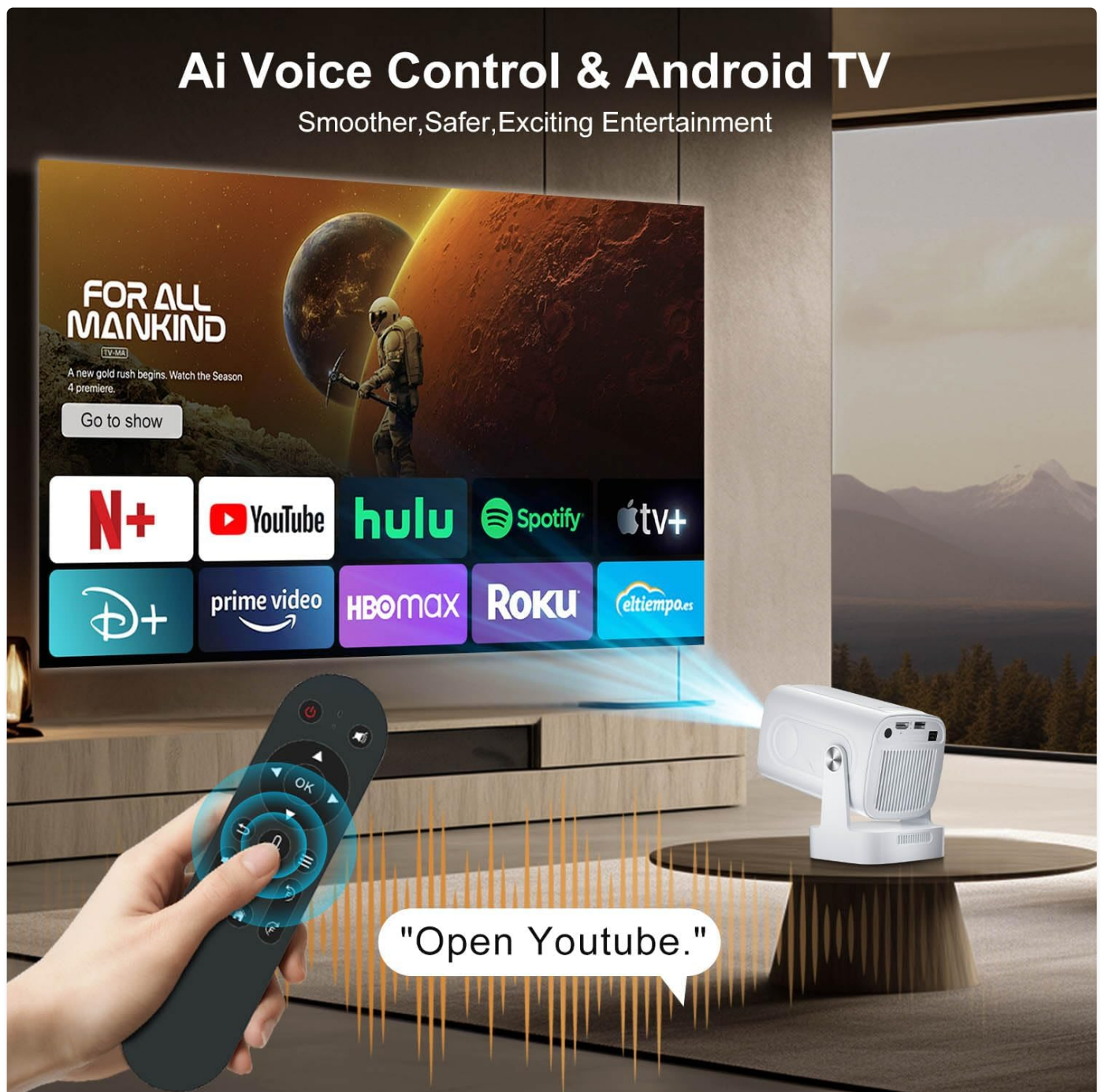

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Navigation and Android OS

The projector runs on Android 11, providing access to a variety of applications. Use the included remote control to navigate the interface.

- **Remote Control:** The remote functions as an air mouse for easier navigation.
- **Built-in Apps:** Access pre-installed streaming services like Netflix, YouTube, Hulu, and Prime Video.
- **App Store:** Download additional applications from the integrated app store. If an app is incompatible, uninstall and re-download it.
- **AI Voice Control:** Use voice commands for hands-free operation (e.g., "Open Youtube").



4.2 Connectivity

The projector offers multiple ways to connect to networks and devices.

- **WiFi 6 (2.4G/5G):** Connect to your wireless network for internet access and streaming.
- **Bluetooth 5.4:** Pair with external Bluetooth speakers or headphones for enhanced audio.
- **Screen Mirroring:** Wirelessly cast content from iOS, Android, or Windows 10 devices via Miracast or Airplay.
- **HDMI:** Connect external devices such as laptops, gaming consoles, or TV sticks.
- **USB:** Play media files directly from a USB drive.

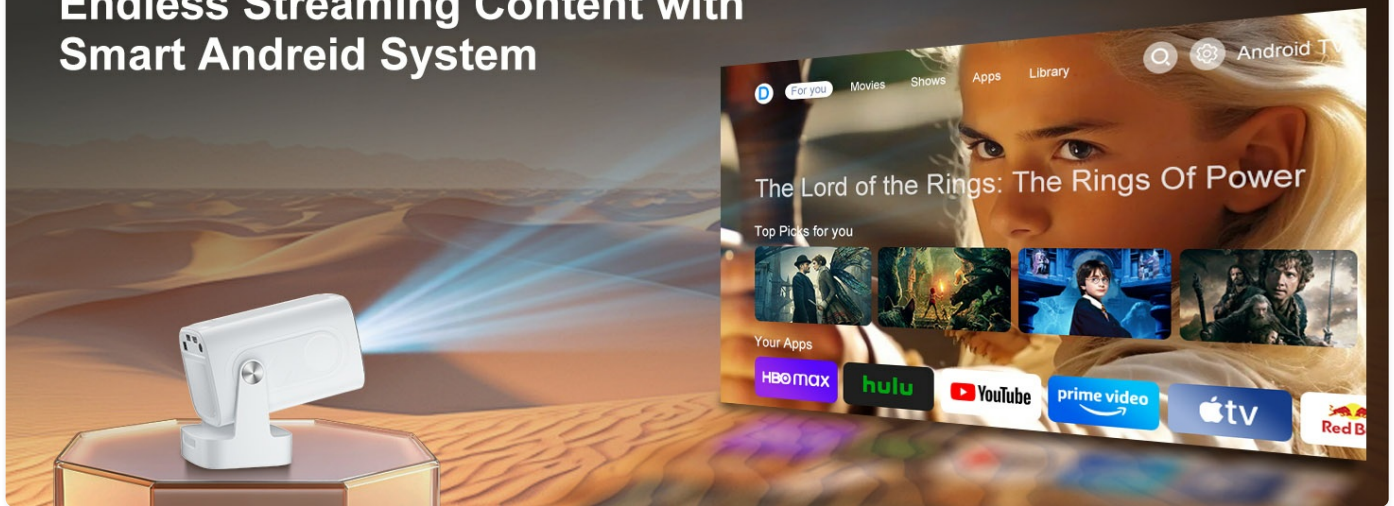


Image: Bluetooth 5.4 connectivity for audio devices.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning the Lens

Use a soft, lint-free cloth specifically designed for optical lenses to gently wipe the projector lens. Avoid abrasive materials or harsh chemicals.

5.2 Dust Filter

The projector is equipped with an easy-clean dust filter. Regularly check and clean the filter to maintain optimal performance and prevent overheating. Refer to the device's physical markings for filter location and removal instructions.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Salange HY260Pro projector, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **No Image / Blurry Image:**
 - Ensure the projector is powered on and connected correctly.
 - Allow auto-focus to complete. If still blurry, manually adjust focus in "Projection Settings."
 - Check for obstructions in front of the lens.
- **Image is Distorted / Not Rectangular:**
 - Allow auto-keystone correction to complete.
 - If projecting from the side, go to "Projection Settings" > "Manual Trapezoid" and adjust the four points.
- **No Sound:**
 - Increase the volume on the projector and your source device.
 - Check if external Bluetooth speakers are connected and properly paired.
 - Ensure the audio output cable (if used) is securely connected.
- **Cannot Connect to WiFi:**
 - Ensure WiFi is enabled on the projector.

- Verify the WiFi password.
- Restart the projector and your router.
- **Streaming App Issues (Freezing/Incompatibility):**
 - Ensure a stable internet connection.
 - Try uninstalling and re-downloading the problematic app from the app store.
 - Some streaming services may restrict screen mirroring due to copyright protection.
