INTRODUCTION

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Follow these steps to properly install the washer drip tray:

1. **Prepare the Area:** Ensure the floor area where the washing machine will be placed is clean, dry, and level.
2. **Position the Drip Tray:** Carefully place the drip tray in the desired location. Ensure it is centered and stable.
3. **Move the Washer:** With assistance, carefully lift and slide your washing machine onto the drip tray. Ensure all four feet of the washing machine are securely inside the tray and are not resting on the edges.
4. **Check Stability:** Gently rock the washing machine to confirm it is stable and balanced on the drip tray. Adjust if necessary.
5. **Connect Hoses:** Reconnect water supply hoses and the drain hose to the washing machine, ensuring all connections are tight and free of leaks.

Important: Always disconnect power and water supply to the washing machine before attempting to move it. It is recommended to have at least two people for moving a washing machine to prevent injury or damage.

OPERATION AND FUNCTION

The washer drip tray operates passively by collecting any water that may escape from the washing machine during its operation. It acts as a containment barrier, preventing water from spreading across the floor. The tray does not require any active operation once installed.

Regularly inspect the drip tray for any accumulated water. If water is present, it indicates a leak from your washing machine that requires immediate attention. Address the source of the leak promptly to prevent further issues.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and effectiveness of your washer drip tray, follow these simple maintenance guidelines:

- **Regular Inspection:** Periodically check the drip tray for any signs of water accumulation, debris, or damage.
- **Cleaning:** If water or debris is found, carefully slide the washing machine off the tray (with assistance) and clean the tray with mild soap and water. Rinse thoroughly and ensure it is completely dry before repositioning the washing machine.
- **Avoid Harsh Chemicals:** Do not use abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals on the drip tray, as these can damage the material.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Drip tray does not fit under the washer.	Incorrect tray size or washer dimensions.	Verify the dimensions of your washing machine and compare them with the product specifications. Ensure the tray is designed for your specific washer type.
Water is found in the drip tray.	Washing machine is leaking.	Identify the source of the leak from the washing machine (e.g., hose connections, pump, tub). Repair or replace the faulty component. Contact a qualified appliance technician if necessary.
Tray appears damaged or cracked.	Physical impact or material fatigue.	A damaged tray may not effectively contain leaks. Consider replacing the drip tray if it shows significant damage.
