YARIKI P60 Air Purifier Instruction Manual

Model: P60

1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the YARIKI P60 Air Purifier. This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use of your new air purifier. Please read it thoroughly before operation and retain it for future reference.

The YARIKI P60 is designed to improve indoor air quality by filtering out various airborne particles and odors, offering a cleaner and more comfortable environment. It features an H13 HEPA filter, aromatherapy function, night light, and quiet operation.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always unplug the air purifier before cleaning, maintenance, or when not in use.
 - Do not operate the appliance with a damaged cord or plug. Contact customer service for assistance.
 - Keep the air inlet and outlet clear of obstructions.
 - Do not immerse the unit in water or other liquids.
 - This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
 - Only use official YARIKI replacement filters to ensure proper function and maintain warranty.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The YARIKI P60 Air Purifier is equipped with a multi-layer filtration system and user-friendly controls to enhance your indoor air quality.

Key Features:

- **H13 True HEPA Filtration:** Captures 99.97% of airborne particles as small as 0.3 microns, including pet dander, dust, pollen, and smoke.

- **Aromatherapy Function:** Integrated groove for adding essential oils to diffuse pleasant fragrances.
- **Quiet Operation:** Operates at an ultra-low noise level of 24dB, ideal for bedrooms and quiet spaces.
- **Night Light:** Soft, warm night light function for a peaceful ambiance.
- **Timer Settings:** Customizable operation for 2, 4, or 8 hours.
- **Filter Replacement Indicator:** Alerts you when it's time to change the filter.

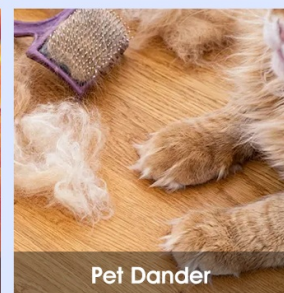


Figure 2: 3-Stage Filtration System

The 3-stage filtration system includes:

1. **Preliminary Filter:** Captures large particles like dust, hair, and pet fur.
2. **H13 True HEPA Filter:** Traps fine particles such as pollen, dust, and pet dander.
3. **Activated Carbon Filter:** Absorbs odors, fumes, and volatile organic compounds (VOCs).

4. SETUP

1. **Unpack the Unit:** Carefully remove the air purifier from its packaging.
2. **Install the Filter:**
 - Unplug the air purifier.
 - Separate the product from the middle by twisting the bottom section counter-clockwise.
 - Remove the filter, which is typically stored inside the unit in a plastic bag.
 - Remove the plastic wrap from the filter.
 - Reinstall the filter into the bottom section of the air purifier.
 - Align the two halves and rotate clockwise to secure them in place.

Easy to Install

We recommend changing the filter every 4-6 months
(The AC power adapter is stored inside the air purifier)

3. **Connect Power:** Plug the power adapter into the air purifier and then into a suitable electrical outlet.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The control panel is located on the top of the unit. All functions are activated via touch controls.

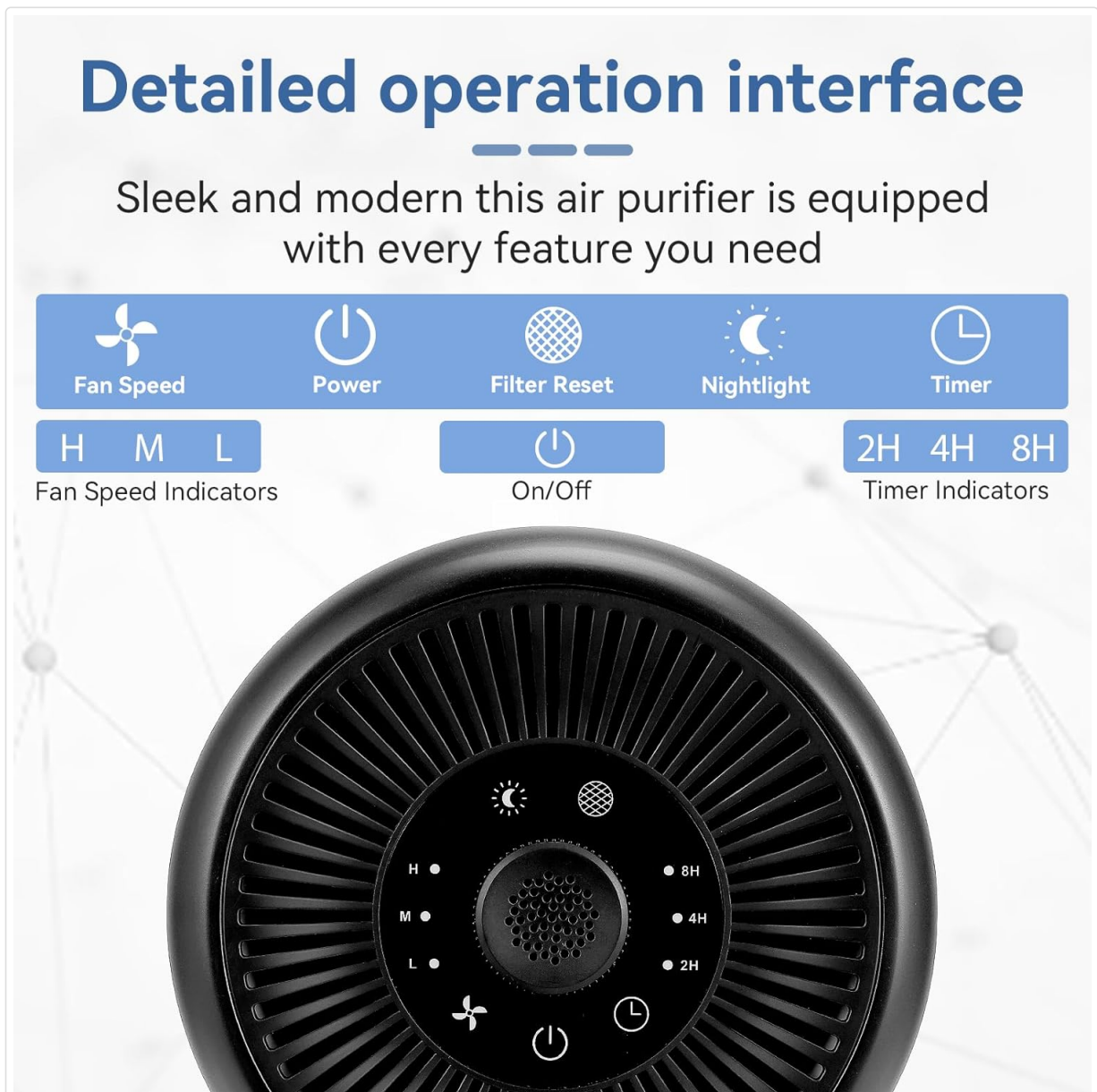


Figure 4: Detailed Operation Interface

Power On/Off:

- Touch the **Power button** (🔌) to turn the unit on or off.

Fan Speed Control:

- Touch the **Fan Speed button** (🌀) to cycle through Low (L), Medium (M), and High (H) fan speeds. The corresponding indicator light will illuminate.

Night Light Function:

- Touch the **Night Light button** (💡) to turn the soft night light on or off.

Timer Settings:

- Touch the **Timer button** (🕒) to set the operating time for 2, 4, or 8 hours. The unit will automatically shut off after the selected time.

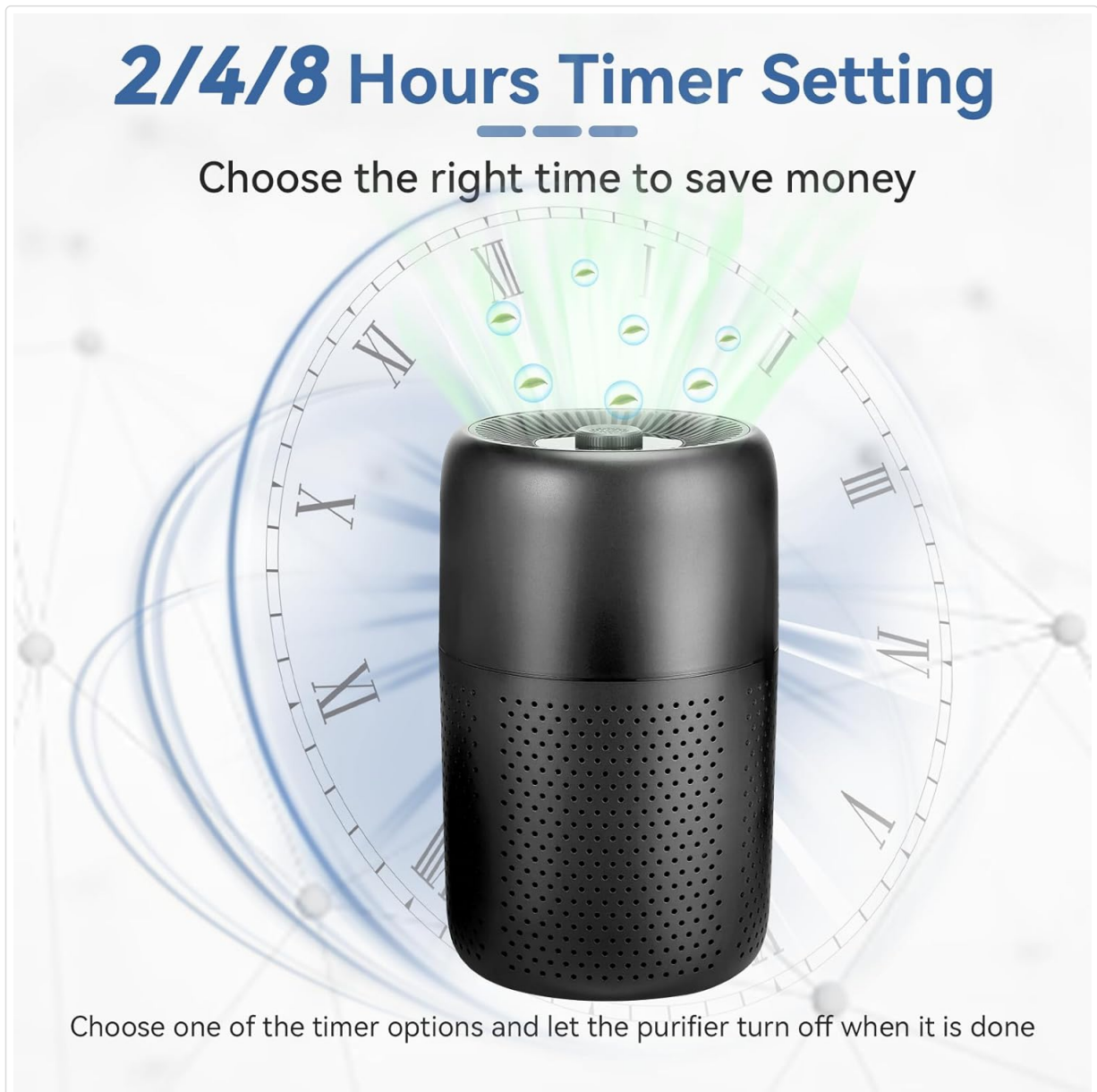


Figure 5: Timer Setting Options

Aromatherapy Function:

- Locate the groove on the air outlet of the purifier.
- Add 4-5 drops of your preferred essential oil (not included) into this groove.
- As the purifier circulates air, the fragrance will be diffused throughout the room.

Add Your Favourite Fragrances

Add a few drops of essential oil to the groove to breathe fresh air and

6. MAINTENANCE

Filter Replacement:

The YARIKI P60 air purifier's filter should be replaced after approximately 1500 hours of use. A red indicator light on the control panel will illuminate to remind you.

- To maintain optimal purification, it is recommended to purchase official replacement filters (ASIN: B0F1MH56B8 or B0F1MKXXNW). Other filter elements are not compatible with P60 air purifiers.
- Follow the filter installation steps outlined in Section 4.2.
- After replacing the filter, press and hold the **Filter Reset button** (🔄) for 3 seconds to reset the filter replacement reminder.

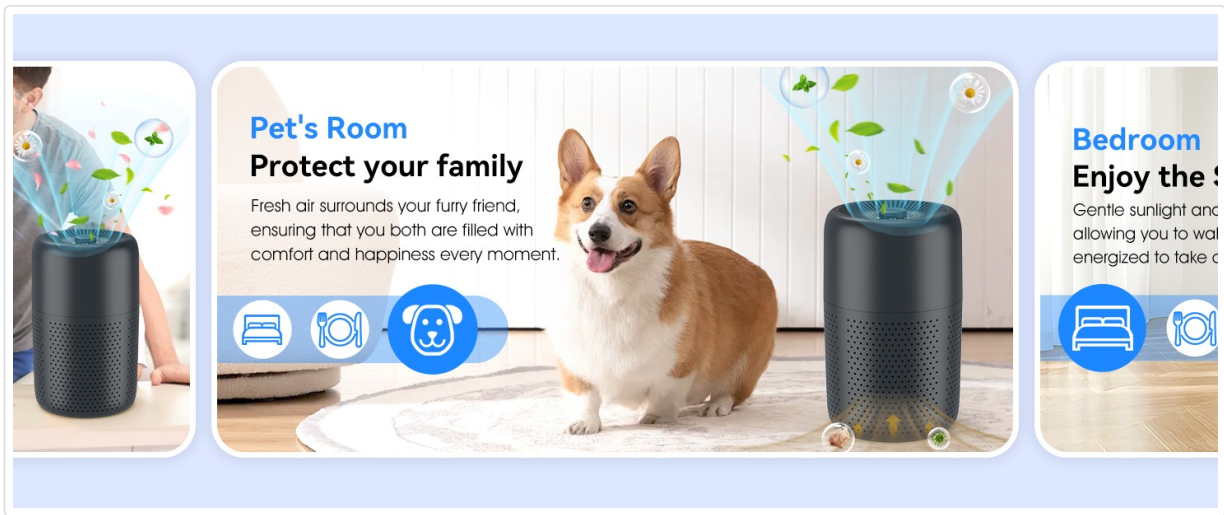


Figure 7: Filter Replacement Indicator

Cleaning the Unit:

- Wipe the exterior of the air purifier with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Ensure the unit is unplugged before cleaning.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your YARIKI P60 Air Purifier, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit does not turn on.	No power supply.	Check if the power cord is securely plugged into the unit and the outlet. Ensure the outlet is functional.
Reduced air flow or purification.	Clogged filter.	Check the filter replacement indicator. Replace the filter if necessary.
Unusual noise during operation.	Obstruction in fan or loose parts.	Unplug the unit and check for any foreign objects. Ensure the filter is correctly installed and the unit is securely assembled.
Aromatherapy scent is weak.	Insufficient essential oil.	Add more drops of essential oil to the aromatherapy groove.
