1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your Blackview Color 8 unlocked smartphone. Please read this manual carefully to ensure proper use and to maximize the device's performance and longevity.

3. DEVICE LAYOUT

Familiarize yourself with the physical components of your Blackview Color 8 smartphone.

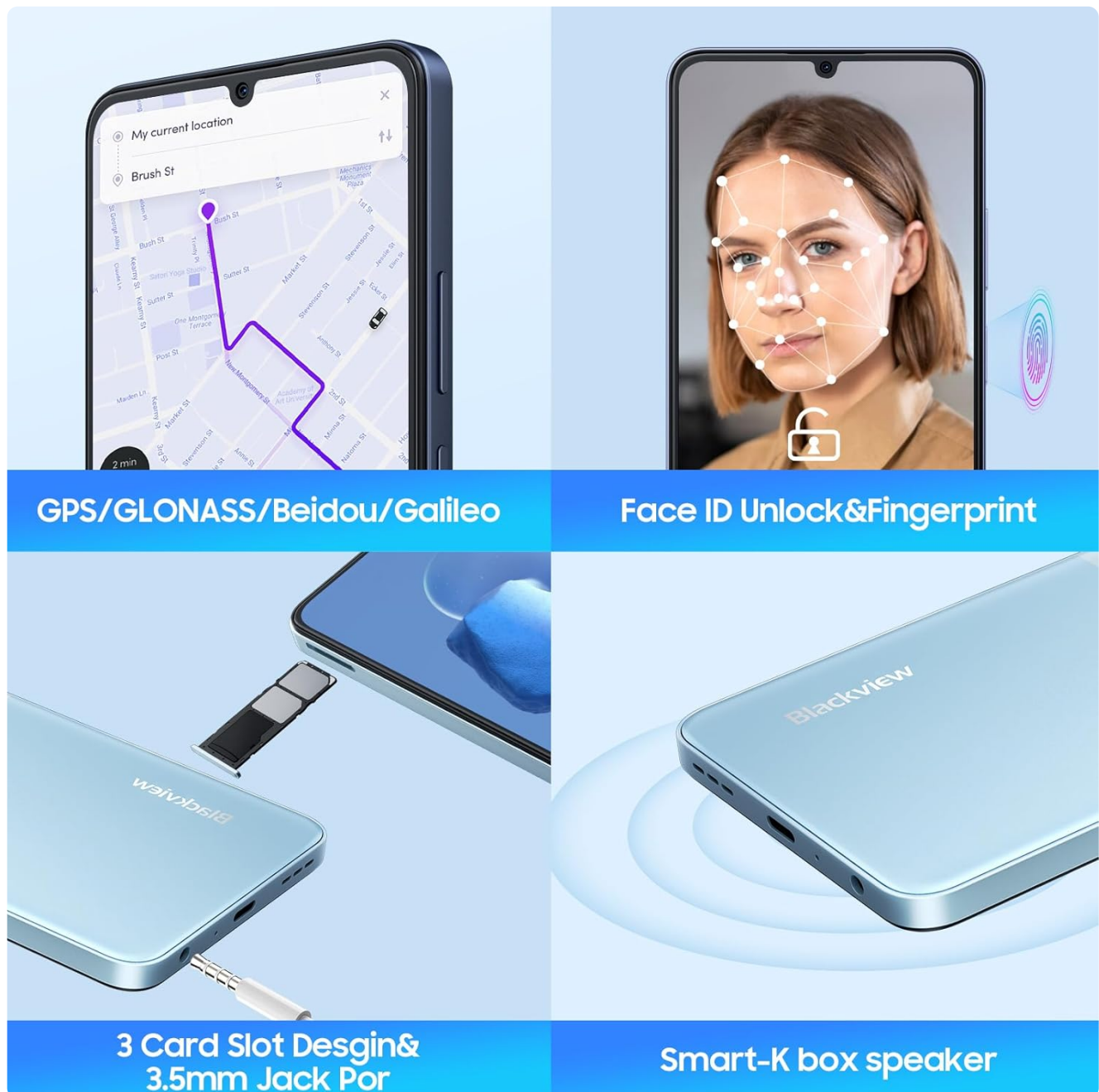


Image: A detailed view of the Blackview Color 8, highlighting the 3-card slot, 3.5mm headphone jack, and smart-K box speaker.

- **Power Button / Fingerprint Sensor:** Located on the side, used to power on/off the device and for fingerprint authentication.
- **Volume Buttons:** Adjust media and call volume.
- **USB Type-C Port:** For charging and data transfer.
- **3.5mm Audio Jack:** For connecting wired headphones.
- **Speaker:** Audio output.
- **Microphone:** For calls and voice recording.

- **SIM/SD Card Tray:** Holds two Nano SIM cards and one MicroSD/TF card.
- **Front Camera:** For selfies and video calls.
- **Rear Cameras:** Main camera and auxiliary lenses.

4. SETUP

4.1. Installing SIM and SD Cards

Your Blackview Color 8 supports two Nano SIM cards and one MicroSD/TF card for expanded storage.

1. Locate the SIM tray on the side of the phone.
2. Insert the SIM ejector tool into the small hole next to the tray and press gently until the tray pops out.
3. Place your Nano SIM cards (SIM1 and SIM2) and MicroSD/TF card into the designated slots on the tray, ensuring the gold contacts face downwards.
4. Carefully reinsert the tray into the phone until it clicks into place.

Benefit from the flexibility of three card slots, allowing you to store vital data with an impressive up to 1TB TF card expansion, all while enjoying the convenience of dual SIM cards for enhanced connectivity wherever your adventures lead.

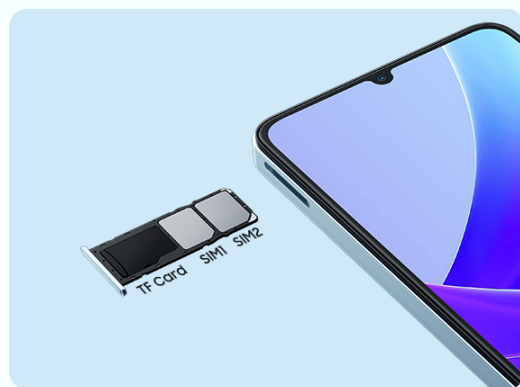


Image: A close-up of the Blackview Color 8's triple card slot, showing spaces for two SIM cards and one TF (MicroSD) card.

4.2. Initial Power On and Setup

1. Press and hold the Power button until the Blackview logo appears.
2. Follow the on-screen prompts to select your language, connect to Wi-Fi, and set up your Google account.
3. You will be guided through setting up security features like fingerprint and face unlock.

5. OPERATING YOUR DEVICE

5.1. Display and Navigation

The Blackview Color 8 features a 6.75-inch HD+ display with a 90Hz refresh rate for smooth visuals.

- **Touch Gestures:** Swipe, tap, pinch-to-zoom for navigation and interaction.

5.2. Calls and Messaging

Use the Phone app to make and receive calls. The Messages app handles SMS and MMS.

- **Making a Call:** Open the Phone app, enter the number, and tap the call icon.
- **Sending a Message:** Open the Messages app, tap 'Start chat', enter recipient and message.
- **Call Recording:** The device supports call recording functionality, which can be enabled in settings.

5.3. Camera Functions

The Blackview Color 8 is equipped with a 50MP main rear camera and an 8MP front camera.

- **Camera Modes:** Access various modes including Panorama, Beauty, Portrait, Night Mode, HDR, and Pro Mode.

5.4. Audio Features

5.6. Security Features

- **Fingerprint Unlock:** Register your fingerprint using the side-mounted sensor for quick and secure access.
- **Face ID Unlock:** Use the front camera to unlock your device with facial recognition.

- **4G Network:** Supports 4G FDD and WCDMA bands. Compatible with GSM carriers like T-Mobile, Speedtalk,

Mint Mobile, etc. (Not compatible with CDMA carriers like AT&T, Verizon).

- **Wi-Fi:** Supports 5G Wi-Fi for fast internet access.
- **Bluetooth 5.0:** For connecting wireless accessories.
- **GPS:** Integrated GPS, GLONASS, Galileo, and Beidou for precise navigation.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1. Battery Care

- Avoid extreme temperatures, which can degrade battery life.
- Do not fully discharge the battery regularly. Charge before it drops below 20%.
- Use only the original or certified compatible charger and cable.

6.2. Software Updates

Your device runs on Android 14 with Doke OS 4.0. Regularly check for system updates to ensure optimal performance and security.

1. Go to **Settings > System > System Update**.
2. Follow the on-screen instructions to download and install any available updates.

6.3. Cleaning Your Device

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to wipe the screen and body.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- For ports and openings, use a soft brush or compressed air carefully.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Blackview Color 8, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Solution

Problem	Solution
Device does not power on	Ensure the battery is charged. Connect to a charger for at least 10 minutes, then try powering on again.
Poor network signal	Check if SIM card is properly inserted. Try restarting the device. Verify network settings and ensure you are within network coverage.
Camera not working	Restart the phone. Clear the cache and data of the Camera app in Settings > Apps.
Apps are slow or freezing	Close background apps. Clear app caches. Ensure sufficient storage space. Restart the device.
Fingerprint sensor not responding	Ensure your finger is clean and dry. Re-register your fingerprint in Settings > Security.
