# Philips TAT5000 True Wireless Bluetooth Earbuds

MODEL: TAT5000BK/00 USER MANUAL

## Introduction

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and efficient use of your Philips TAT5000 True Wireless Bluetooth Earbuds. Please read this guide thoroughly before operating the device and retain it for future reference. These earbuds feature Adaptive Noise Canceling Pro, 6-mic call technology, and Bluetooth 5.4 multipoint connectivity, designed for a superior audio experience.

## Setup

### 1. Charging the Earbuds and Case

Before first use, fully charge the earbuds and charging case. Connect the USB-C charging cable to the charging port on the case and to a power source. The charging indicators on the case will show the charging status. A full charge provides up to 40 hours of total playtime (10 hours from earbuds + 30 hours from case with ANC off). A 15-minute quick charge provides approximately 3 hours of playtime.

### 2. Pairing with Your Device

1. Ensure the earbuds are charged and placed in the charging case.
2. Open the charging case. The earbuds will automatically enter pairing mode.
3. On your device (smartphone, tablet, laptop), enable Bluetooth and search for new devices.
4. Select "Philips TAT5000" from the list of available devices to connect.
5. For Android devices, Google Fast Pair allows for instant connection. For Windows devices, Microsoft Swift Pair offers quick pairing.

- The earbuds support Bluetooth 5.4 multipoint connectivity, allowing connection to two devices simultaneously.

### 3. Selecting the Right Eartips

Choose the soft silicone eartips (S/M/L) that provide the most comfortable and secure fit for optimal sound quality and noise cancellation performance.

## Operating Instructions

---

### 1. Power On/Off

- **Power On:** Open the charging case, and the earbuds will power on automatically.
- **Power Off:** Place the earbuds back into the charging case and close the lid. They will power off automatically.

### 2. Music Playback (Touch Controls)

- **Play/Pause:** Tap the touch panel on either earbud once.
- **Next Track:** Double-tap the touch panel on the right earbud.
- **Previous Track:** Double-tap the touch panel on the left earbud.

### 3. Call Management (Touch Controls)

- **Answer/End Call:** Tap the touch panel on either earbud once.
- **Reject Call:** Press and hold the touch panel on either earbud for 2 seconds.

### 4. Noise Control Modes

The earbuds feature Adaptive Noise Canceling Pro. Tap the touch panel (specific earbud/pattern may vary, refer to app for customization) to cycle through modes:

- **Adaptive Noise Canceling (ANC):** Reduces ambient noise.
- **Awareness Mode:** Allows you to hear your surroundings.
- **Quick Awareness:** Amplifies voices for quick conversations without removing earbuds.

### 5. Philips Headphones App

Download the Philips Headphones App for additional features, including:

- Customizing touch controls.
- Adjusting Equalizer (EQ) settings.
- Managing ANC levels and modes.
- Receiving firmware updates.

## Maintenance

### Cleaning

- Gently wipe the earbuds and charging case with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth.
- Remove eartips and clean them with mild soap and water, then dry thoroughly before reattaching.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, alcohol, or chemical solvents.

### Water Resistance

The earbuds are IPX5 water resistant, meaning they are protected against sweat and splashes of water. They are not designed for submersion in water. Ensure the charging port is dry before charging.

### Storage

Store the earbuds in their charging case when not in use to protect them and conserve battery life. Avoid extreme temperatures.

## Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Earbuds do not power on	Low battery	Place earbuds in the charging case and charge fully.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cannot pair with device	Bluetooth off, earbuds not in pairing mode, or device too far	Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your device. Open the charging case to activate pairing mode. Move device closer to earbuds. Try forgetting the device in Bluetooth settings and re-pairing.
No sound or poor sound quality	Incorrect eartip size, low volume, or connection issue	Adjust eartips for a secure fit. Increase volume on your device. Reconnect earbuds to your device.
ANC not working effectively	Improper fit, or ANC mode not active	Ensure earbuds are properly seated in your ears with the correct eartip size. Verify ANC is enabled via touch controls or the Philips Headphones App.
Charging case not charging	Faulty cable or power source	Try a different USB-C cable and power adapter. Ensure the charging port is clean and dry.
