## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The ORGBRO X8 Thermal Tattoo Stencil Printer is a lightweight and portable device designed for creating high-quality tattoo stencils. Utilizing advanced thermal technology, it operates without ink cartridges, ensuring clean and efficient printing. It supports various paper sizes (A4, A5, A6) and offers wireless connectivity via Bluetooth for mobile devices (phones/tablets) and USB for PCs, making it a versatile tool for both professional tattoo artists and beginners.

- **3-in-1 Printing & Ease of Use:** Supports A4, A5, and A6 tattoo transfer paper. Features direct printing without the need to peel yellow paper, preventing wrinkles and ensuring perfect flatness. The professional-grade printhead delivers fast and clear results.
- **Smart Editing App:** The user-friendly "Tattoo Go" app (available for Android and iOS) allows for

zooming, rotating, and adding multiple images for batch printing. It includes a library of free tattoo patterns and supports importing custom designs, with a filter function to convert photos into outlines.

- **Broad Compatibility:** Connects via Bluetooth with Android and iOS phones/tablets. For PCs, it supports Windows, macOS, ChromeOS, and Linux systems via USB Type-C connection (Bluetooth is not available for PCs).
- **Ink-Free Printing:** Utilizes advanced thermal technology, eliminating the need for ink or cartridges. This ensures clean images, quick production, and avoids clogs or mess.

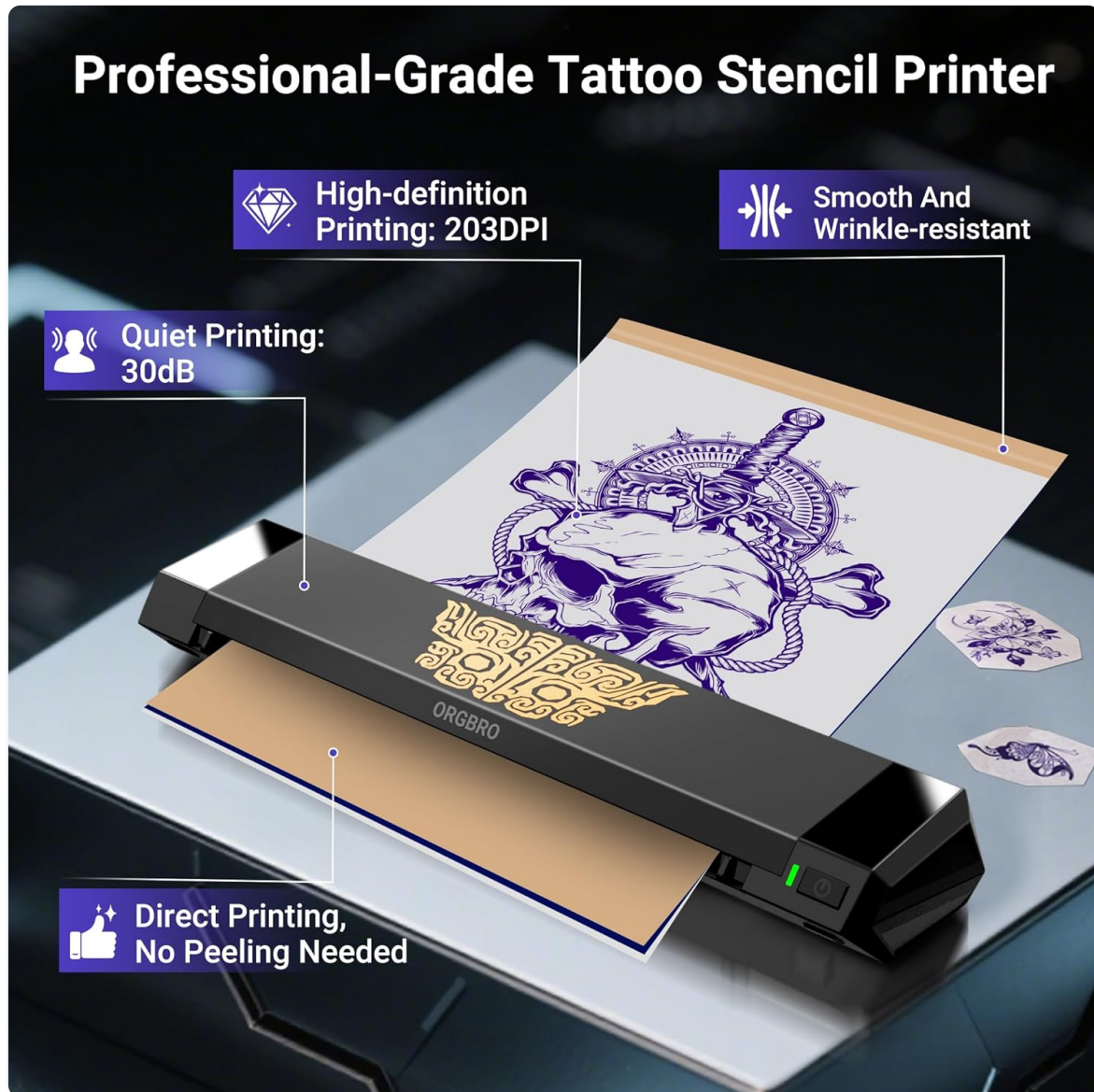

## SETUP GUIDE

### 1. Powering On and Charging

To power on the printer, press and hold the power button located on the side until the indicator light illuminates. For charging, connect the provided Type-C cable to the printer and a suitable power source. The indicator light will show charging status.

### 2. App Installation and Connection

The ORGBRO X8 printer is controlled via the "Tattoo Go" application. Follow these steps to install and connect:

- **Download the App:** Scan the QR code provided in the user's guide or search for "Tattoo Go" on the Apple App Store (for iOS) or Google Play Store (for Android).
- **Connect via Bluetooth (Mobile Devices):** Open the "Tattoo Go" app, navigate to the device connection section, and select the "X8" printer from the list of connectable devices. Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your mobile device.



- **Connect via USB (PC):** For Windows, macOS, ChromeOS, or Linux systems, connect the printer to your computer using the provided USB Type-C cable. Install the necessary drivers from the included USB disk or download them from the official ORGBRO website.

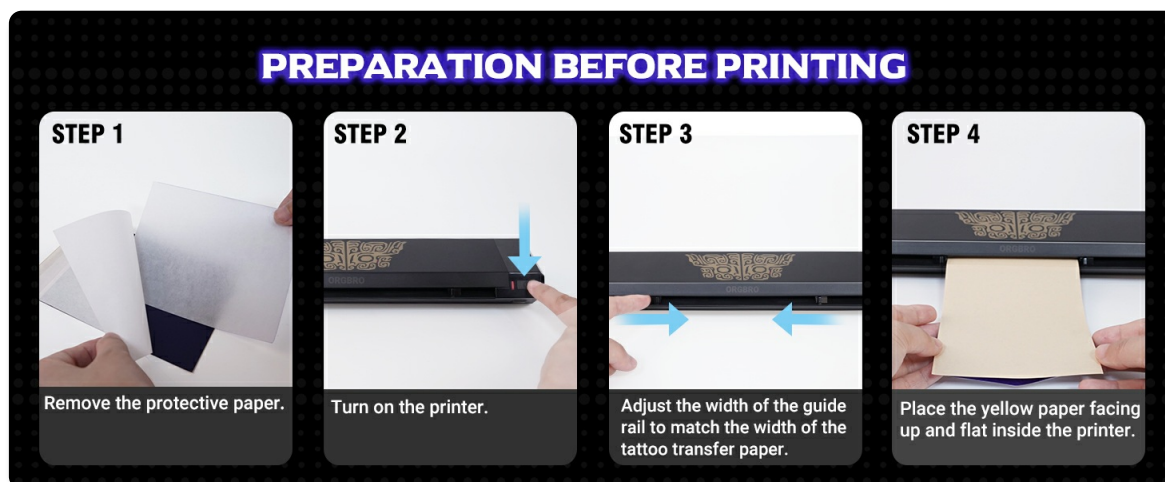


Image: Instructions for downloading the "Tattoo Go" app and connecting the printer to a phone or tablet via Bluetooth.

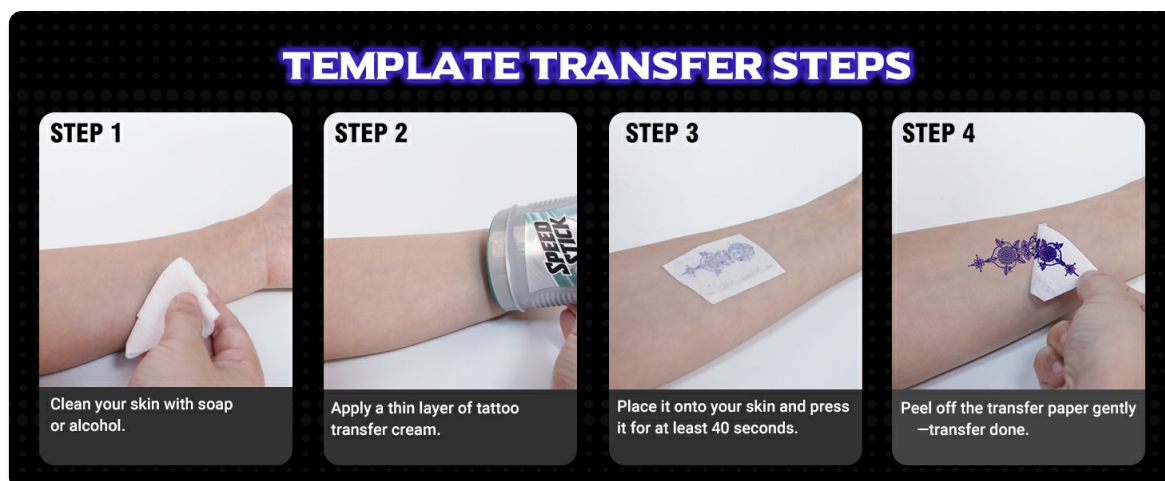


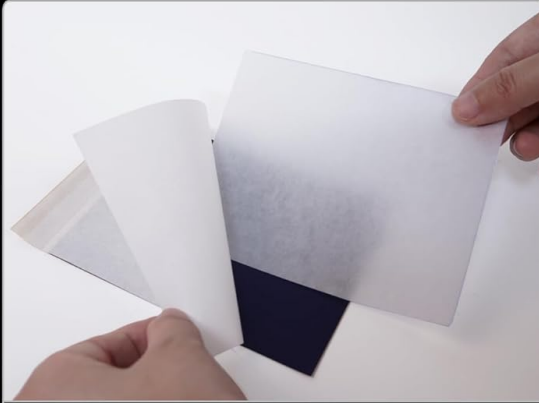
Image: Instructions for connecting the printer to a PC or laptop using a USB cable and installing the necessary drivers.

### 3. Loading Transfer Paper

Proper paper loading is crucial for optimal print quality. Follow these steps:

1. Remove the protective paper from the tattoo transfer sheet.
2. Adjust the width of the guide rails on the printer to match the width of your tattoo transfer paper (A4, A5, or A6).
3. Insert the transfer paper with the yellow side facing up and flat into the printer's feed slot. The printer will automatically pull the paper into position.

# Pattern Printing Steps



1. Remove the protective paper.



2. Turn on the printer.



3. Adjust the width of the guide rail to match the width of the tattoo transfer paper.



4. Place the yellow paper facing up and flat inside the printer.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 1. Designing and Editing with "Tattoo Go" App

The "Tattoo Go" app provides various tools for preparing your stencil design:

- **Image Import:** Import designs from your device's gallery or choose from the app's extensive library of tattoo patterns.
- **Editing Tools:** Utilize features like zooming, rotating, cropping, and erasing to perfect your design.
- **Filter Function:** Convert photos into clear outlines suitable for stenciling.
- **Batch Printing:** Combine multiple images for efficient printing.

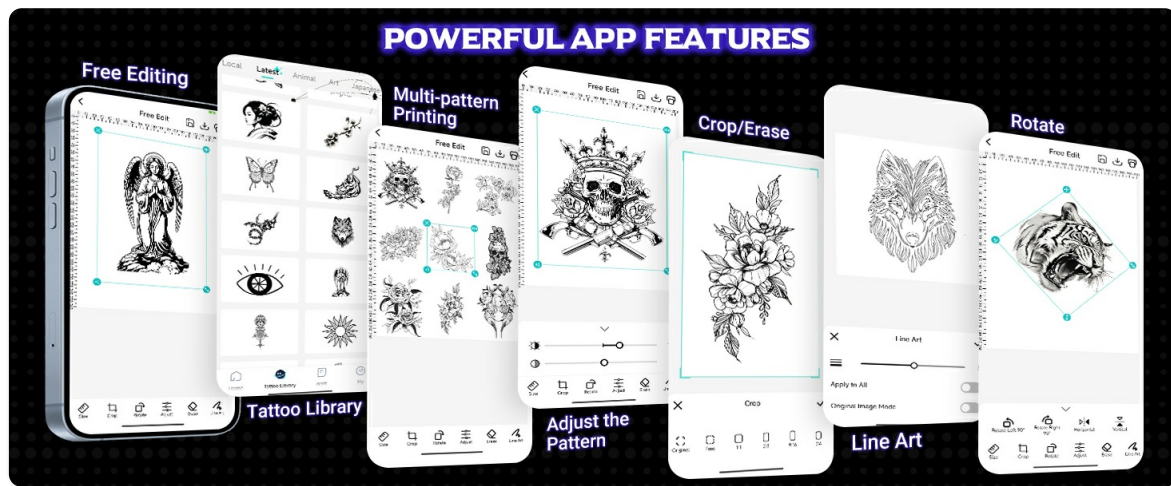


Image: A visual guide to the powerful editing features available within the "Tattoo Go" application.

## 2. Printing Your Stencil

Once your design is ready and paper is loaded:

1. In the "Tattoo Go" app, select the desired paper type (A4, A5, or A6) to ensure correct scaling and print quality.
2. Initiate the print command from the app. The printer will quickly produce a high-resolution stencil.

## 3. Applying the Tattoo Stencil

To transfer the printed stencil onto the skin:

1. Clean the skin area thoroughly with soap or alcohol to remove oils and impurities.
2. Apply a thin, even layer of tattoo transfer cream to the cleaned skin.
3. Carefully place the printed stencil onto the prepared skin, pressing firmly and evenly for at least 40 seconds.
4. Gently peel off the transfer paper. The design should now be clearly transferred onto the skin.

# Template Transfer Steps



1. Clean your skin with soap or alcohol.



2. Apply a thin layer of tattoo transfer cream.



3. Place it onto your skin and press it for at least 40 seconds.



4. Peel off the transfer paper gently —transfer done.

## MAINTENANCE

The ORGBRO X8 printer is designed for low maintenance due to its ink-free thermal technology. To ensure longevity and optimal performance:

- Keep the printer clean and free from dust and debris. Use a soft, dry cloth for external cleaning.
- Avoid exposing the printer to extreme temperatures or direct sunlight.
- Store the printer and transfer paper in a cool, dry place.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

### Common Issues and Solutions:

- **Printer not connecting via Bluetooth:** Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your device and within the "Tattoo Go" app. Restart both the printer and your device, then attempt to reconnect.



- **Poor print quality or faded stencils:** Verify that the transfer paper is loaded correctly with the yellow side up. Check the app's print settings for density and ensure the original image is clear.
- **Paper jams:** If paper gets stuck, gently open the printer's lid (by pressing the side buttons) and carefully remove any jammed paper. Ensure the paper guides are correctly adjusted for the paper size.
- **Printer lid open error:** If the app indicates the printer lid is open, ensure it is securely closed. Press down firmly on both sides of the lid until it clicks into place.





