SETUP

1. Unboxing and Initial Inspection

Carefully remove the laptop and all accessories from the packaging. Check for any visible damage. Ensure all included components are present: laptop, power adapter, and documentation.

2. Connecting the Power Adapter

Connect the power adapter to the laptop's power connector and then plug it into a power outlet. It is recommended to fully charge the battery before the first use.

3. Initial Power On

Open the laptop lid and press the power button. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the Windows 11 setup process, including language selection, network connection, and user account creation.

4. Connecting Peripherals

Utilize the available ports to connect external devices such as a mouse, external display, or USB drives.

OPERATING YOUR LAPTOP

1. Using the Keyboard and Touchpad

The laptop features a full-size keyboard and a precision touchpad. Familiarize yourself with the function keys (Fn) for quick access to settings like volume, brightness, and wireless connectivity.

2. Display and Graphics

The 15.3-inch WUXGA IPS display provides clear visuals. You can adjust display settings, including resolution and scaling, through Windows settings. The Intel UHD Graphics handles everyday visual tasks efficiently.

3. Power Management

To conserve battery life, utilize Windows power plans. The laptop supports Rapid Charge Boost for quick charging. For optimal battery health, avoid frequently draining the battery completely or leaving it fully charged for extended periods.

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning Your Laptop

Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a screen cleaner to clean the display. For the keyboard and chassis, use a soft cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

2. Software Updates

Regularly check for and install Windows updates and driver updates from Lenovo's official support website to ensure optimal performance and security.

3. Storage Management

Periodically clean up unnecessary files and applications to maintain sufficient free space on your SSD for better performance.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter:

- **Laptop not powering on:** Ensure the power adapter is securely connected and the battery has sufficient charge. Try a different power outlet.
- **Screen is blank or flickering:** Restart the laptop. If connected to an external monitor, try disconnecting it. Check display driver updates.
- **Slow performance:** Close unnecessary applications. Check for background processes consuming high resources. Ensure sufficient free storage space.
- **Wi-Fi connectivity issues:** Restart your router and laptop. Check Wi-Fi drivers. Ensure airplane mode is off.

- **Keyboard or touchpad not responding:** Restart the laptop. Check for driver updates.

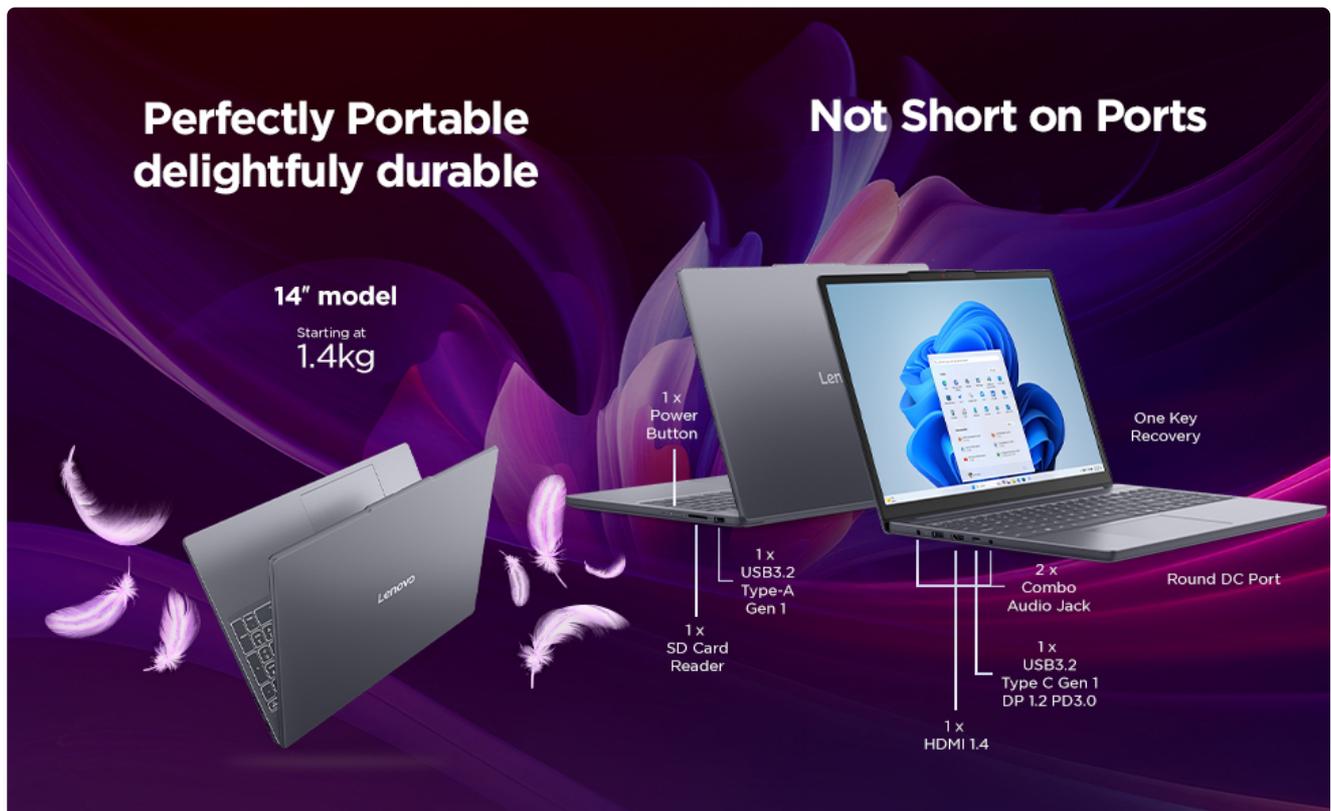


Figure 5: Warranty and Accidental Damage Protection Information
