INTRODUCTION

Welcome to your AULCMEET RC-340C Replacement Remote Control. This manual provides essential information for setting up and operating your new remote control, designed for seamless compatibility with ONKYO DX7211, DX-7011, and DX7011 CD Players. Please read these instructions carefully to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your device.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The AULCMEET RC-340C is a dedicated replacement remote control, pre-programmed to work with specific ONKYO CD Player models. It features a standard layout for CD player functions, ensuring ease of use without complex setup procedures.

SETUP

1. Battery Installation

The AULCMEET RC-340C remote control requires two (2) AAA batteries (not included) for operation. Follow these steps to install the batteries:

1. Locate the battery compartment on the back of the remote control.

- 2. Press down on the latch and slide the battery cover downwards to open it.
- 3. Insert two new AAA batteries, ensuring the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals align correctly with the markings inside the compartment.
- 4. Slide the battery cover back into place until it clicks securely.

2. Initial Use

This remote control is designed to work immediately with compatible ONKYO CD Players (DX7211, DX-7011, DX7011) without any programming or pairing required. Once batteries are installed, point the remote at your CD player and begin operation.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The AULCMEET RC-340C remote provides full functionality for your ONKYO CD Player. Below is a general guide to common button functions:

- **DISPLAY:** Toggles display information on the CD player.
- CD: Selects the CD function if your system has multiple inputs.
- REPEAT: Repeats the current track or entire disc.
- PLAY (►): Starts CD playback.
- PAUSE (||): Pauses CD playback. Press again to resume.
- STOP (): Stops CD playback.
- **SKIP** (◄◄ / ► ►): Skips to the previous or next track.
- FAST FORWARD/REWIND (◄◄◄ / ► ►): Fast forwards or rewinds within a track.
- Numerical Keys (0-9, +10): Directly select track numbers. Use +10 for tracks above 9.
- MEMORY: Used for programming custom playback sequences. Refer to your CD player's original manual for detailed programming instructions.
- **CLEAR:** Clears programmed memory or other settings.
- **TIME EDIT:** Likely used for editing track times or programming. Refer to your CD player's original manual.
- **NEXT SELECTION:** Navigates through options or selections.
- PEAK SEARCH: Scans for the loudest part of a track.
- A-B: Repeats a specific section between two points (A and B).
- SHUFFLE: Plays tracks in a random order.

For advanced functions or specific settings not detailed here, please consult the original user manual for your ONKYO CD Player model.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your remote control, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

• Remote is unresponsive:

- Ensure the remote is pointed directly at the infrared sensor on your ONKYO CD player.
- Check if the batteries are inserted correctly with the correct polarity (+/-).
- Replace the batteries with new AAA batteries. Weak batteries are a common cause of unresponsiveness.
- Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the CD player.

• Certain buttons do not work:

- This remote is a replacement for specific ONKYO CD Player models. Verify your CD player model is listed as compatible (DX7211, DX-7011, DX7011).
- Some functions may be specific to your CD player's capabilities. Refer to your CD player's original
- Clean the remote's surface and buttons with a soft, dry cloth to remove any dirt or debris that might be obstructing button presses.
