1. INTRODUCTION

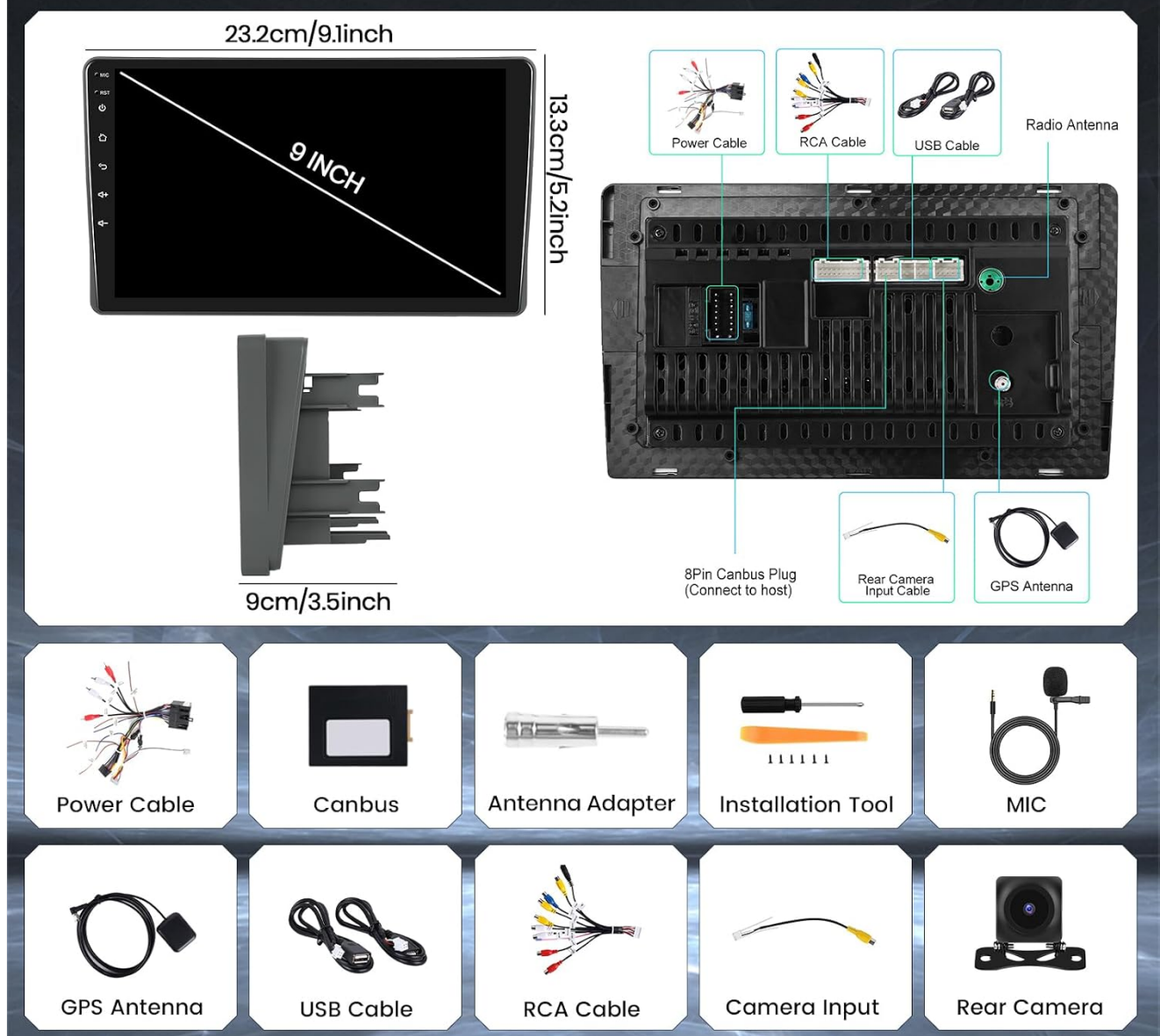

4. INSTALLATION GUIDE

4.1 General Installation

The Hikity Android 15 car stereo is designed for a direct fit in Fiat Panda models (2003-2012). Professional installation is recommended. Ensure the vehicle's battery is disconnected before starting any electrical work.

4.2 Car Stereo Wiring Diagram

Refer to the provided wiring diagram for connecting the main power, audio outputs, USB, and other essential cables. Ensure all connections are secure to prevent malfunctions.

Reversing Camera & Canbus Wiring

Tip: The reverse input cable must be plugged in even if the reverse camera is not being used. Otherwise it will affect Bluetooth and WiFi signal reception.

Reversing Camera Wiring

Red Cable ①: Connects to the positive terminal of the car's reverse light cable

Black Cable ②: Connects to the negative terminal of the car's reverse light cable

There is no need to connect the other two red extension cables ③ and ④.

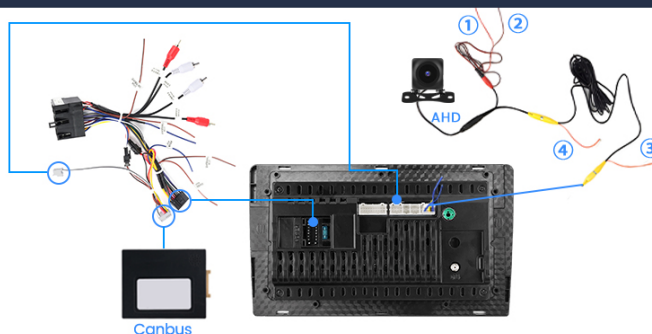

4.3 Reverse Camera Wiring

The unit includes a reverse camera for enhanced safety. Follow these steps for wiring:

1. Connect the **Red Cable (1)** from the camera to the positive terminal of the car's reverse light cable.
2. Connect the **Black Cable (2)** from the camera to the negative terminal of the car's reverse light cable.
3. The reverse input cable must be plugged into the head unit even if the reverse camera is not being used. Failure to do so may affect Bluetooth and WiFi signal reception.
4. There is no need to connect the other two red extension cables (3) and (4) unless specified by your vehicle's specific wiring requirements.

Reversing Camera & Canbus Wiring

Tip: The reverse input cable must be plugged in even if the reverse camera is not being used. Otherwise it will affect Bluetooth and WiFi signal reception.

Reversing Camera Wiring

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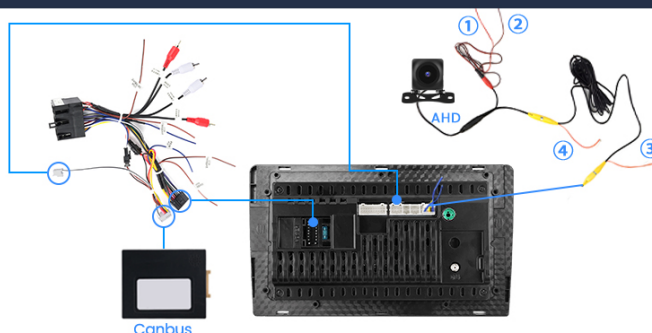

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Power On/Off

Press and hold the power button (usually located on the front panel or a soft button on the screen) to turn the unit on or off. A short press typically mutes the audio or puts the unit into standby mode.

5.2 Touch Screen Interface

The 9-inch IPS touch screen provides intuitive control. Navigate through menus, select applications, and adjust settings by tapping or swiping. The interface supports split-screen functionality, allowing two applications to run simultaneously.

5.3 Wireless CarPlay & Android Auto

Connect your iPhone or Android smartphone wirelessly to access navigation, music, calls, and messages directly on the car stereo display. This feature provides a safer way to use your phone's functions while driving.

- Ensure Bluetooth and Wi-Fi are enabled on your smartphone.
- On the car stereo, select the CarPlay or Android Auto icon.
- Follow the on-screen prompts to pair your device.

5.4 Mirror Link

Mirror Link allows you to display your smartphone's screen directly onto the car stereo. This is useful for apps not natively supported by CarPlay or Android Auto.

- Connect your smartphone via USB or Wi-Fi.
- Select the 'Mirror Link' option on the car stereo.
- Follow the instructions on both devices to establish the connection.

The built-in GPS module supports both online and offline navigation. Download maps for offline use or connect to Wi-Fi for real-time traffic updates and online mapping services.

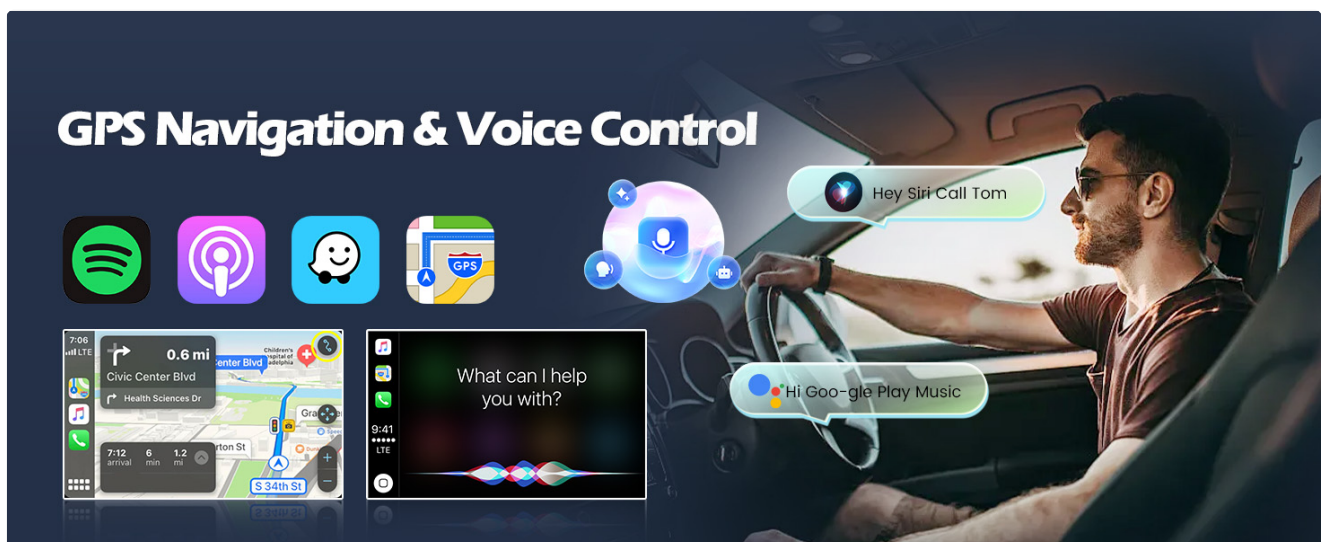


Image: The GPS navigation interface on the car stereo, alongside icons for voice control, demonstrating how to use voice commands for navigation and media playback.

5.6 FM/RDS Radio

5.7 Bluetooth Connectivity

Bluetooth 5.0 enables hands-free calling and wireless audio streaming. Pair your smartphone to make and receive calls safely and enjoy your music library without cables.

- Go to the Bluetooth settings on the car stereo.
- Enable Bluetooth on your smartphone and search for available devices.
- Select the car stereo from the list and confirm pairing.

5.8 Steering Wheel Control (SWC)

- Access the SWC learning function in the system settings.
- Follow the on-screen instructions to assign functions to your steering wheel buttons.

5.9 Backup Camera

5.10 Audio Settings (EQ, DSP)

Customize your audio experience with the 32-band equalizer to fine-tune sound frequencies. The AI DSP (Digital Signal Processor) offers advanced sound effects, though activation may be required for full functionality.

6. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your car stereo, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the screen and exterior. For stubborn smudges, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen-safe cleaner. Avoid abrasive materials or harsh chemicals.
- **Temperature:** Avoid exposing the unit to extreme temperatures. Prolonged exposure to direct sunlight or very cold conditions can affect performance and lifespan.
- **Software Updates:** Periodically check for software updates through the system settings or the manufacturer's website to ensure you have the latest features and bug fixes.
- **Connections:** Ensure all cables are securely connected. Loose connections can lead to intermittent issues.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your car stereo, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit does not power on	Loose power connection, blown fuse, vehicle battery issue	Check power cables and fuse. Ensure vehicle battery is charged.
No sound	Volume too low, mute activated, loose speaker wires, incorrect audio settings	Increase volume, check mute status, verify speaker connections, adjust audio settings.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bluetooth/WiFi issues	Interference, incorrect pairing, reverse input cable not connected	Ensure reverse input cable is connected. Re-pair device. Check for interference. Restart unit.
Touch screen unresponsive	Software glitch, screen damage	Restart the unit. If issue persists, contact support.
Backup camera not displaying	Incorrect wiring, faulty camera, reverse gear not detected	Check camera wiring (positive/negative to reverse light). Ensure reverse gear is engaged.
