2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Domi 10'x12' Hardtop Gazebo is designed to provide a durable and comfortable outdoor living space. It features a galvanized steel double roof for enhanced airflow and weather resistance, along with integrated curtains and netting for privacy and insect protection.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

4. SETUP & ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the Domi Hardtop Gazebo requires two or more adults. Please follow the step-by-step instructions provided in the separate assembly manual included with your product. Ensure you have adequate space and all necessary tools before starting.

General Assembly Guidelines:

1. **Site Preparation:** Choose a level, stable surface for installation. Clear the area of any debris or obstructions.
2. **Unpack Components:** Carefully unpack all boxes and identify each part according to the assembly manual's parts list.
3. **Frame Assembly:** Assemble the main frame structure first, ensuring all bolts are hand-tightened initially.
4. **Roof Installation:** Install the galvanized steel roof panels according to the instructions, paying attention to the double-roof ventilation system.
5. **Curtains & Netting:** Attach the curtains and netting to the designated tracks or hooks.
6. **Final Tightening:** Once the entire structure is assembled, go back and securely tighten all bolts and fasteners.
7. **Anchoring:** Securely anchor the gazebo to the ground using appropriate hardware for your surface (e.g., concrete anchors, ground stakes).

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Using Curtains and Netting

The gazebo is equipped with dual-track systems for both mosquito netting and privacy curtains. These can be operated independently.

- **Mosquito Netting:** Pull the netting closed to create an insect-free environment while maintaining visibility and airflow. Use the zippers to open and close sections.
- **Privacy Curtains:** Pull the curtains closed for privacy or to block direct sunlight. Secure them with the attached ties when not in use.

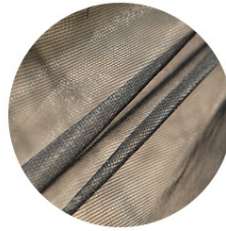

5.2 Utilizing Ceiling Hooks

The gazebo roof includes sturdy hooks designed to support lighting fixtures, ceiling fans, or decorative items. Each hook can support up to 20 lbs.

- Ensure items hung are within the weight limit.
- Distribute weight evenly if hanging multiple items.
- For electrical items, ensure proper outdoor-rated wiring and installation by a qualified professional.

5.3 Weather Considerations

While designed for all-weather durability, certain precautions should be taken:

- **High Winds:** In strong winds, it is recommended to remove curtains and netting to reduce wind resistance. Ensure the gazebo is securely anchored.
- **Heavy Snow:** While the roof can withstand significant snow loads, it is advisable to clear excessive snow accumulation to prevent structural stress.
- **Rain:** The sloped roof design facilitates water runoff. Ensure gutters (if applicable) are clear of debris.

6. MAINTENANCE & CARE

Regular maintenance will extend the life and appearance of your gazebo.

- **Cleaning Frame:** Wipe the metal frame with a soft cloth and mild soap and water. Rinse thoroughly and dry. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- **Cleaning Roof:** The galvanized steel roof can be cleaned with a soft brush or cloth and water. Remove any accumulated leaves or debris regularly.
- **Cleaning Curtains & Netting:** Hand wash with mild soap and cold water, or spot clean. Air dry completely before storing or reattaching. Do not machine wash or tumble dry.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically check all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they are tight. Tighten as needed.
- **Winter Storage (Optional):** While designed for year-round use, in areas with extreme winter conditions, you may choose to remove curtains and netting for storage indoors to prolong their life.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Gazebo feels unstable/wobbly	Loose connections; uneven ground; inadequate anchoring.	Check and tighten all bolts. Ensure installation surface is level. Verify anchors are properly secured.
Water pooling on roof	Debris blocking drainage; improper roof panel installation.	Clear any debris from the roof and drainage channels. Review roof assembly instructions to ensure panels are correctly installed and overlapping.
Curtains/Netting not sliding smoothly	Debris in tracks; damaged tracks; fabric snagging.	Clean tracks of any dirt or debris. Inspect tracks for damage. Ensure fabric is properly aligned in the tracks.
Rust spots on frame	Surface scratches exposing metal; prolonged exposure to moisture.	Clean affected area, lightly sand if necessary, and apply rust-inhibiting paint or touch-up paint.

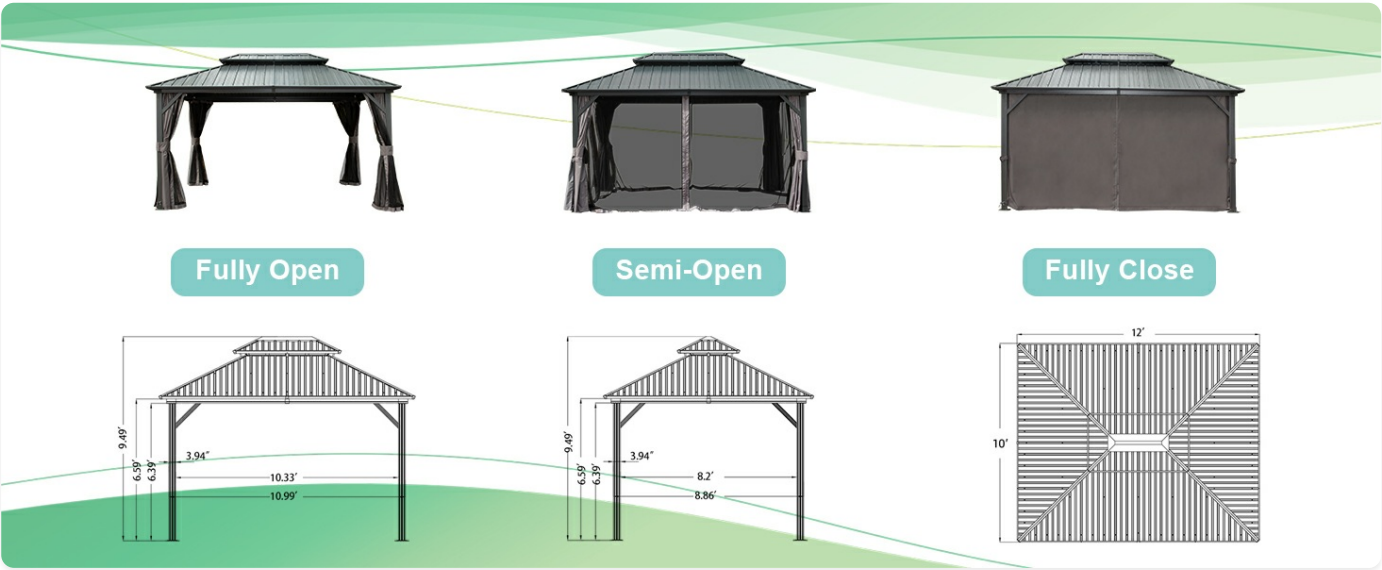


Image 8.1: Detailed dimensional drawing of the Domi 10'x12' Hardtop Gazebo, showing height, width, and depth.
