- **Outdoor Camera Series 2:** For outdoor surveillance with advanced features.
- **Power Cables:** For the Outdoor Camera Series 2.
- **Key Fob:** For convenient arming and disarming.

## SETUP

---

Setting up your SimpliSafe system is designed to be quick and straightforward, requiring no drilling or special tools. Follow these steps to get your system up and running:

1. **Power On the Base Station:** Plug in your Base Station. It is the brain of the system and will guide you through the initial setup process. Place it in a central location in your home for optimal signal coverage.

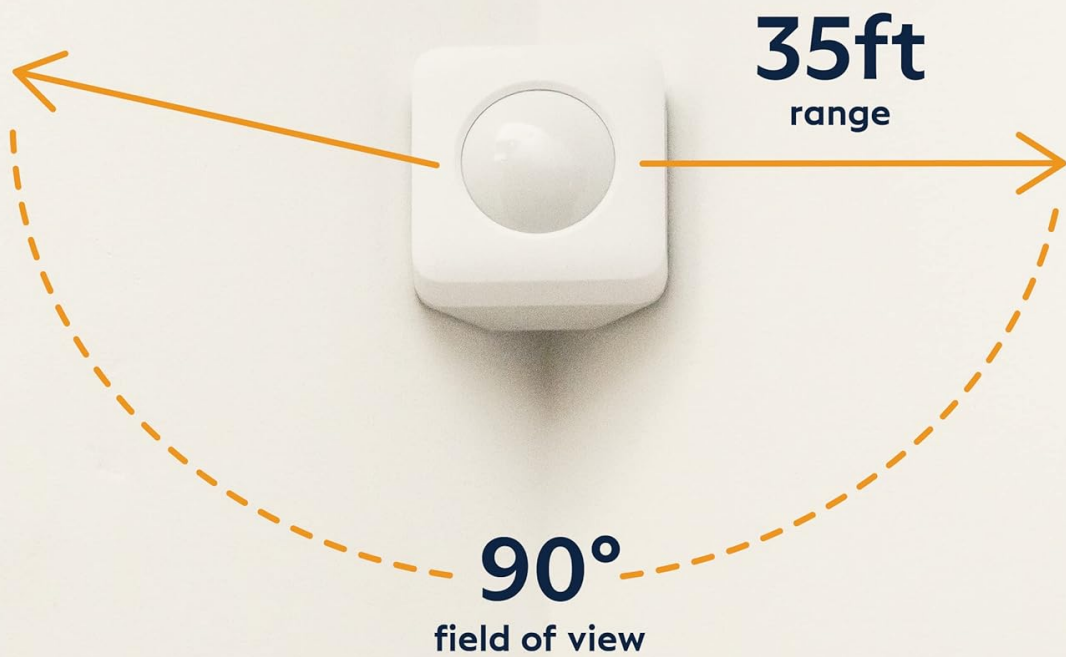



Figure 3: Plug in the Base Station to power it on.

2. **Install the Keypad:** Place the Keypad near an entrance you use every day. It features a wire-free design and lights up when needed.

3. **Place Entry Sensors:** Install the Entry Sensors on your doors, windows, or cabinets. These sensors alert you the instant they are opened.

4. **Install Outdoor Camera:** Position the Outdoor Camera Series 2 to monitor key outdoor areas. It offers a 140-degree field of view, 1080p HD resolution, and color night vision. It can be installed wirelessly with its rechargeable battery or wired using the included power cables.

## OPERATING YOUR SYSTEM

Your SimpliSafe system offers various modes and features to ensure your home's security.

### Arming and Disarming

- **Off Mode:** The system is disarmed. All sensors are inactive.
- **Home Mode:** Designed for when you are home. Entry sensors on doors and windows are active, but motion sensors (if added) are typically inactive to allow free movement inside.
- **Away Mode:** Activates all sensors, including entry and motion sensors, for full protection when no one is home.

You can arm or disarm your system using the Keypad, the Key Fob, or the SimpliSafe mobile application.

### Panic Button

The Keypad includes a hidden panic button for emergencies. Pressing this button will immediately trigger the alarm and, with professional monitoring, alert emergency services.

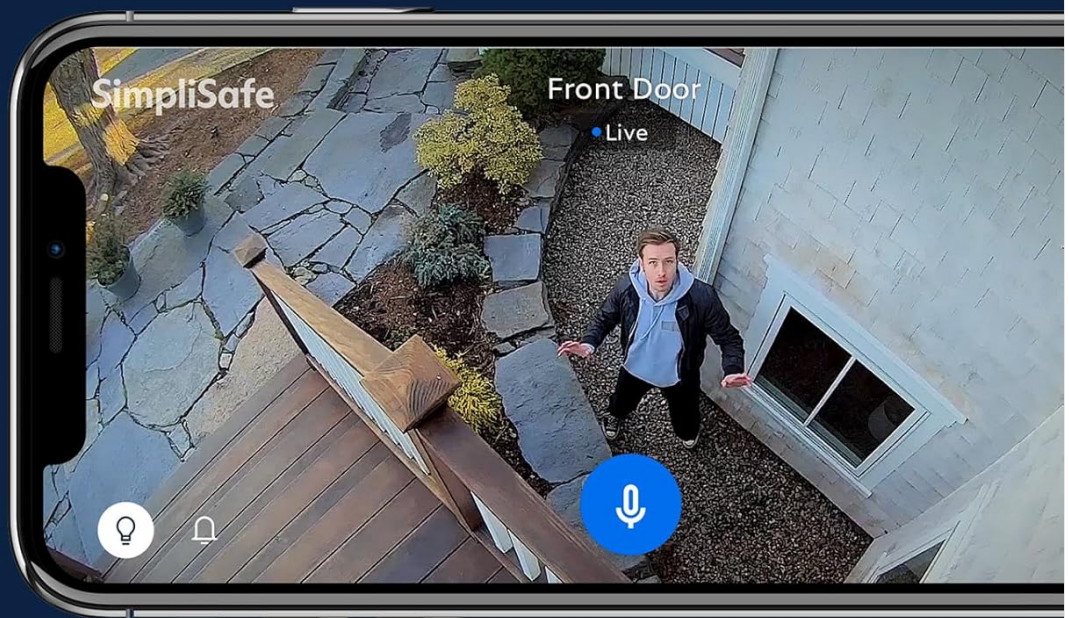
The Outdoor Camera Series 2 provides continuous surveillance. Key features include:

- **Color Night Vision:** Enhanced visibility in low-light conditions.

- **2-Way Audio:** Communicate with visitors or deter intruders.
- **SimpliSafe Active Guard Outdoor Protection (Optional):** With select monitoring plans, advanced AI identifies threats, and live agents can see, speak to, and sound a siren to deter intruders, even requesting police dispatch if necessary.

## MAINTENANCE

To ensure the optimal performance of your SimpliSafe system, regular maintenance is recommended:

- **Battery Replacement:** All wireless components, including Entry Sensors, Keypad, and Key Fob, are battery-powered. The Base Station has a backup battery that lasts up to 24 hours during a power outage. Replace batteries as indicated by system alerts or approximately every 3-5 years for sensors and key fobs, and as needed for the Outdoor Camera's rechargeable battery.
- **Cleaning:** Gently wipe down components with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Software Updates:** Ensure your Base Station and other components receive regular software updates, which are typically pushed automatically. These updates provide new features and security enhancements.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your SimpliSafe system, consider the following common troubleshooting steps:

- **No Power to Base Station:** Ensure the power cable is securely plugged into both the Base Station and a working electrical outlet. Check the outlet with another device.
- **Sensor Not Responding:** Check the battery in the sensor. Ensure the sensor and its magnet (for Entry Sensors) are properly aligned and within range of the Base Station.
- **Connectivity Issues:** Verify your home Wi-Fi network is active and the Base Station is connected. If issues persist, try restarting your router and the Base Station.
- **App Not Connecting:** Ensure your smartphone has a stable internet connection. Try logging out and back into the SimpliSafe App.
