- **Processor:** AMD Ryzen 7 5700U processor with up to 4.3 GHz max boost clock, 8 cores, and 16 threads for efficient multitasking.

SETUP

1. Initial Power On

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove the laptop and all accessories from the packaging.
2. **Connect Power:** Plug the AC adapter into the laptop's power port and then into a wall outlet.
3. **Power On:** Open the laptop lid and press the power button, typically located on the keyboard deck.
4. **Windows Setup:** Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the Windows 11 Pro initial setup, including language, region, network connection, and user account creation.

2. Connecting Peripherals

Connect external devices such as a mouse, keyboard, or external monitor to the appropriate ports. Refer to the "Ports" section in the specifications for port types and locations.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Basic Usage

- **Keyboard:** The laptop features a full-size keyboard with an independent numeric keypad.
- **Touchpad:** Use the integrated touchpad for navigation. Adjust sensitivity and gestures in Windows settings.
- **Power Management:** Utilize Windows power settings to optimize battery life and performance. The laptop offers up to 9 hours of battery life.

2. Connectivity

- **Wi-Fi:** Connect to wireless networks via Wi-Fi 6. Access network settings through the Windows taskbar.
- **Bluetooth:** Pair Bluetooth devices like headphones or speakers using Bluetooth 5.2. Manage devices in Windows settings.
- **Ethernet:** For a wired internet connection, connect an Ethernet cable to the dedicated port (if available on your specific model).

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning

- **Screen:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth lightly dampened with water or a screen cleaner. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- **Keyboard/Chassis:** Use a soft cloth to wipe surfaces. A can of compressed air can remove dust from between keys.
- **Ports:** Ensure ports are free of dust and debris.

2. Battery Care

- Avoid extreme temperatures.

- Do not fully discharge the battery frequently.
- For long-term storage, charge the battery to approximately 50-70%.

3. Software Updates

Regularly check for and install Windows updates and Acer driver updates to ensure system stability and security.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions:

- **No Power:** Ensure the AC adapter is securely connected and the power outlet is functional. Try a different outlet.
- **Display Issues:** If the screen is blank, try connecting an external monitor to check if the laptop is outputting video. Adjust display settings in Windows.
- **Wi-Fi Connectivity:** Check if Wi-Fi is enabled in Windows settings. Restart your router and the laptop.
- **Slow Performance:** Close unnecessary applications, check for malware, and ensure sufficient free storage space.

WOWPC Recovery USB

Your device includes a WOWPC recovery USB. In case of severe system issues or for a fresh installation, insert the USB and follow the on-screen instructions to access recovery options. This tool is designed to assist with system restoration and troubleshooting.
