PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Twin Size Low Loft Wood House Bed with Two Side Windows (White) is designed to provide a comfortable and engaging sleeping environment for children. Its unique house-shaped design, featuring a roof and two side windows, serves as both a bed and a play space. Constructed from sturdy pinewood, this bed offers enhanced stability and durability. Slats are included, eliminating the need for a box spring or foundation.

This low loft bed promotes a comforting atmosphere for better sleep while ensuring adequate air circulation due to its semi-enclosed structure.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Ensure all hardware is securely tightened before use. Periodically check and re-tighten as necessary.
- Do not allow children under 6 years of age on the upper bunk (if applicable, though this is a low loft).
- Use only mattresses that comply with the recommended dimensions to prevent entrapment.
- Do not attach or hang items on any part of the bed structure that are not designed for use with the bed, such as hooks, belts, or ropes, as they can pose a strangulation hazard.
- Keep small parts away from children during assembly to prevent choking hazards.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

This wood house bed comes in one package with clear instructions and all necessary hardware for assembly. It is

recommended to assemble the bed with at least two adults.

Required Tools (Not Included):

- Phillips head screwdriver
- Hammer (optional, for dowels if applicable)

Assembly Steps:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging and lay them out on a clean, soft surface (e.g., a carpet or blanket) to prevent scratches. Verify all parts are present against the included parts list.
2. **Assemble Side Panels:** Attach the side panels, ensuring the window cutouts are correctly oriented.
3. **Install Roof Structure:** Secure the roof beams and panels to the top of the bed frame.
4. **Attach Ladder:** Fasten the ladder securely to the designated attachment points on the bed frame.
5. **Place Slats:** Lay the wooden slats across the bed frame to form the mattress support. Ensure they are evenly spaced and secured if attachment points are provided.
6. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are in place, carefully tighten all screws and bolts. Do not overtighten.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Twin Size Low Loft Wood House Bed is designed for sleeping and light play activities within its structure. It is suitable for a standard twin-size mattress.

Usage Guidelines:

- Ensure the mattress fits snugly within the bed frame to prevent gaps.
- Do not jump on the bed.
- Do not allow more than one person on the bed at a time, unless specified by the weight capacity.
- Supervise children during play within the bed structure.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper maintenance will extend the life and appearance of your wood house bed.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the wood surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, which can damage the finish.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically (e.g., every 3-6 months) check all bolts, screws, and fasteners to ensure they are tight. Re-tighten as needed to maintain structural integrity.
- **Wood Care:** Protect the wood from extreme temperature changes and direct sunlight, which can cause warping or fading.
- **Spills:** Clean up spills immediately to prevent staining or damage to the wood.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed feels wobbly or unstable.	Loose hardware.	Check and tighten all bolts and screws. Ensure all connections are secure.
Parts do not align during assembly.	Incorrect orientation of parts; missing or damaged dowels/hardware.	Review the assembly instructions carefully. Ensure parts are oriented correctly. Contact customer support if parts are damaged or missing.
Squeaking noises.	Loose connections; friction between wood parts or slats.	Tighten all hardware. Apply a small amount of paraffin wax or silicone spray to contact points between slats and frame if squeaking persists.
