# PHILIPS Baristina Espresso Machine

## USER MANUAL

### Introduction

Welcome to the world of effortless espresso with your new PHILIPS Baristina Espresso Machine. Designed for simplicity and quality, this compact machine grinds, tamps, and brews fresh coffee with just one swipe, bringing cafe-style coffee directly to your home.

### Safety Information

- Read all instructions before use.
- Do not immerse the appliance, cord, or plug in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning the appliance.
- Use only original PHILIPS accessories and parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions, or has been damaged in any manner.
- For household use only.

## Setup

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. **Placement:** Place the machine on a stable, level surface away from heat sources and water.
3. **Water Tank:** Fill the water tank with fresh, cold water. Ensure it is properly seated.

4. **Bean Hopper:** Open the bean hopper lid and fill with fresh whole coffee beans. Close the lid securely.

- 5. Initial Rinse:** Before first use, perform an initial rinse cycle without coffee to clean the internal system. Refer to the operating instructions for brewing a Lungo, but without adding coffee beans to the portafilter.

## Operating Instructions

The Baristina machine simplifies espresso making with its intuitive design.

### Brewing Espresso

1. **Insert Portafilter:** Ensure the portafilter is clean and empty. Insert it into the machine's brewing head and swipe the handle to the right until it clicks into place. The machine will automatically grind and tamp the beans.

2. **Select Drink:** Press the "Espresso" button for a single shot, or the "Extra Shot" button for a more intense flavor.

3. **Enjoy:** Your fresh espresso will be dispensed directly into your cup.

## Brewing Lungo

1. **Insert Portafilter:** As with espresso, insert the portafilter and swipe the handle.
2. **Select Lungo:** Press the "Lungo" button for a longer, Italian-style mini-Americanos.

## Maintenance and Cleaning

### Cleaning the Portafilter

1. **Eject Grounds:** After brewing, press the ejection button on the portafilter to release the coffee puck. The coffee puck can be composted.

3. **Wipe Clean:** Wipe the portafilter with a dry cloth. There are no messy hidden compartments.

## Cleaning the Drip Tray

The drip tray should be emptied and rinsed regularly.

## Descaling

Descaling is important to prevent mineral buildup. Refer to the full user manual (PDF link provided below) for detailed descaling instructions.

## Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your Baristina machine, try the following common solutions:

- **No Coffee Dispensed:** Check if the water tank is filled and properly inserted. Ensure the portafilter is correctly locked in place.

- **Weak Espresso:** Ensure you are using fresh, quality coffee beans. Check if the bean hopper is sufficiently filled. Try the "Extra Shot" option for increased intensity.
- **Machine Not Turning On:** Verify the power cord is securely plugged into both the machine and a working electrical outlet.
- **Leaking:** Check that the water tank and drip tray are correctly positioned and not overfilled. Inspect the portafilter for any damage or improper seating.
