1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Sunvivi ZBM001 2.2LB Bread Maker Machine. This appliance is designed to simplify your bread-making process, offering a variety of programs for different types of bread and other culinary creations. Please read this manual thoroughly before operating the machine to ensure safe and efficient use. Keep this manual for future reference.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

1. Read all instructions.
2. Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
3. To protect against electric shock, do not immerse cord, plugs, or appliance in water or other liquid.
4. Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
5. Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts.
6. Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
7. The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may cause injuries.
8. Do not use outdoors.
9. Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter or touch hot surfaces.

10. Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
11. Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing hot oil or other hot liquids.
12. To disconnect, turn any control to "off," then remove plug from wall outlet.
13. Do not use appliance for other than intended use.

3. PRODUCT COMPONENTS AND FEATURES

Familiarize yourself with the parts of your bread maker and its key features.

3.1 Components Overview

- **Non-Stick Pan:** For baking bread.
- **Measuring Cup:** For precise liquid measurements.

- **Measuring Spoon:** For precise dry ingredient measurements.
- **Brush:** For cleaning.
- **Hook:** For removing the mixing paddle from baked bread.
- **Oven Mitt:** For safe handling of the hot bread pan.
- **Mixing Paddle:** For kneading dough.
- **Storage Box Lid:** Integrated compartment for accessories.

3.2 Control Panel and Display

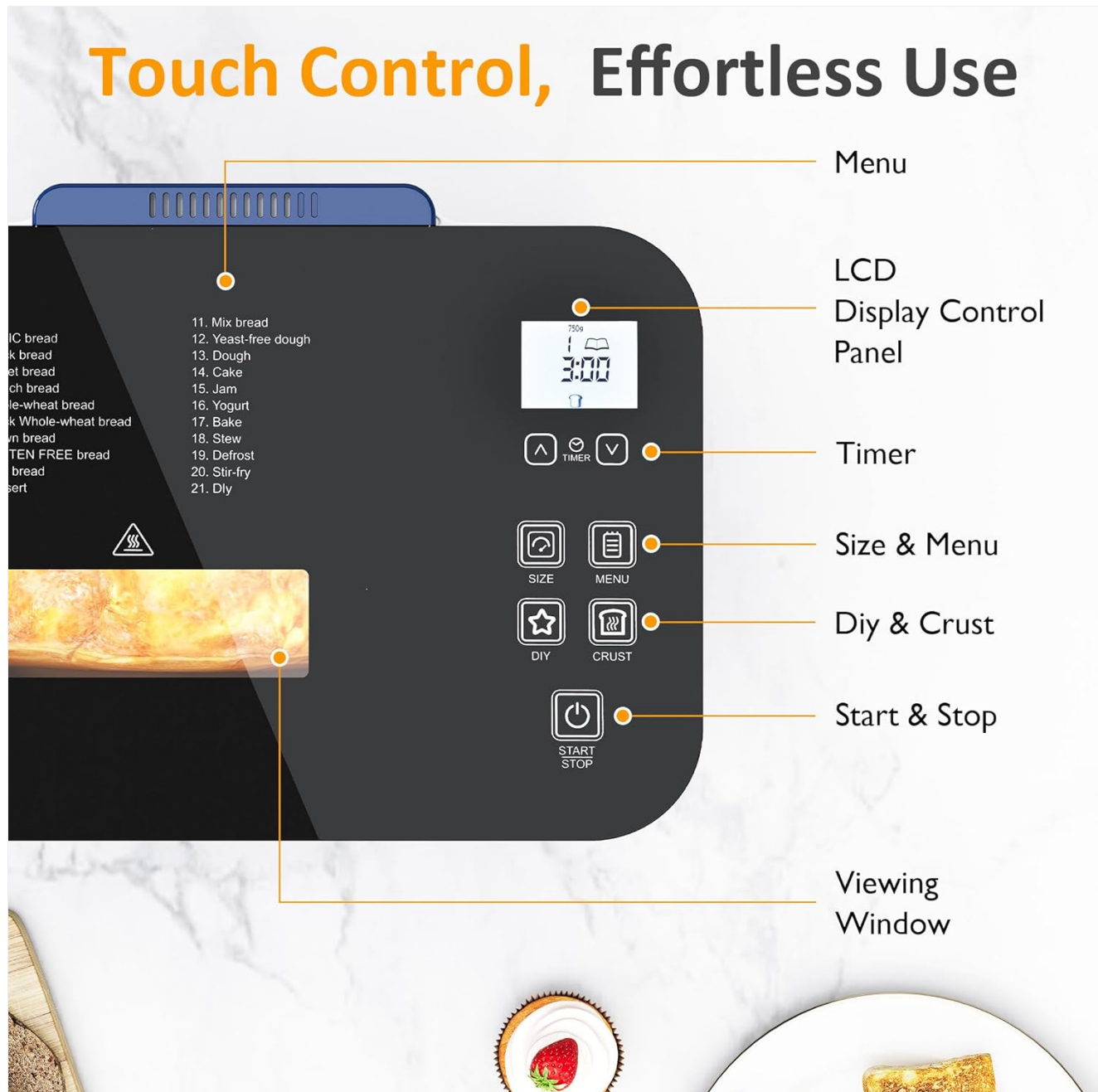

- **LCD Display Control Panel:** Shows program, time, and settings.
- **Menu Button:** Selects from 21 programmable modes.
- **Size & Menu Button:** Adjusts loaf size and selects menu programs.
- **DIY & Crust Button:** Customizes crust color and activates DIY mode.
- **Timer Buttons (Up/Down):** Sets delay timer.

- **Start & Stop Button:** Initiates or cancels a program.
- **Viewing Window:** Allows monitoring of the baking process.

4. SETUP

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove the bread maker and all accessories from the packaging.
2. **Clean:** Wash the bread pan, mixing paddle, measuring cup, and measuring spoon with warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry all parts. Wipe the exterior of the bread maker with a damp cloth.
3. **Placement:** Place the bread maker on a stable, flat, heat-resistant surface, away from direct sunlight and heat sources. Ensure adequate ventilation around the appliance.
4. **Insert Pan:** Place the non-stick bread pan into the baking chamber and twist it gently until it locks into place.
5. **Insert Paddle:** Attach the mixing paddle onto the shaft inside the bread pan.
6. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet. The machine will beep, and the display will show the default program.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This section details how to use your Sunvivi bread maker for various functions.

5.1 Adding Ingredients

Always add ingredients in the order specified in your recipe: liquids first, then dry ingredients, and finally yeast. Ensure the yeast does not come into direct contact with liquids or salt before mixing begins.

5.2 Program Selection (21-in-1 Menu)

The bread maker offers 21 programmable modes. Press the **MENU** button repeatedly to cycle through the available programs. The selected program number will be displayed on the LCD screen.

Available Programs include: Basic Bread, Sweet Bread, Gluten-Free, Cake, Jam, Yogurt, Stew, Stir-fry, Dough, Kneading, and more.

5.3 Loaf Size and Crust Color Selection

After selecting a program, you can customize the loaf size and crust color.

- **Loaf Size:** Press the **SIZE** button to choose between 1.1lb, 1.65lb, or 2.2lb.
- **Crust Color:** Press the **CRUST** button to select Light, Medium, or Dark crust.

5.4 Delay Timer Function (15-Hour)

The delay timer allows you to program the bread maker to start at a later time, up to 15 hours in advance.

1. Select your desired program, loaf size, and crust color.
2. Press the **TIMER** buttons (Up/Down) to set the desired delay time. The displayed time includes the baking cycle duration.
3. Press the **START/STOP** button to activate the delay timer. The machine will begin counting down and start baking when the set time is reached.

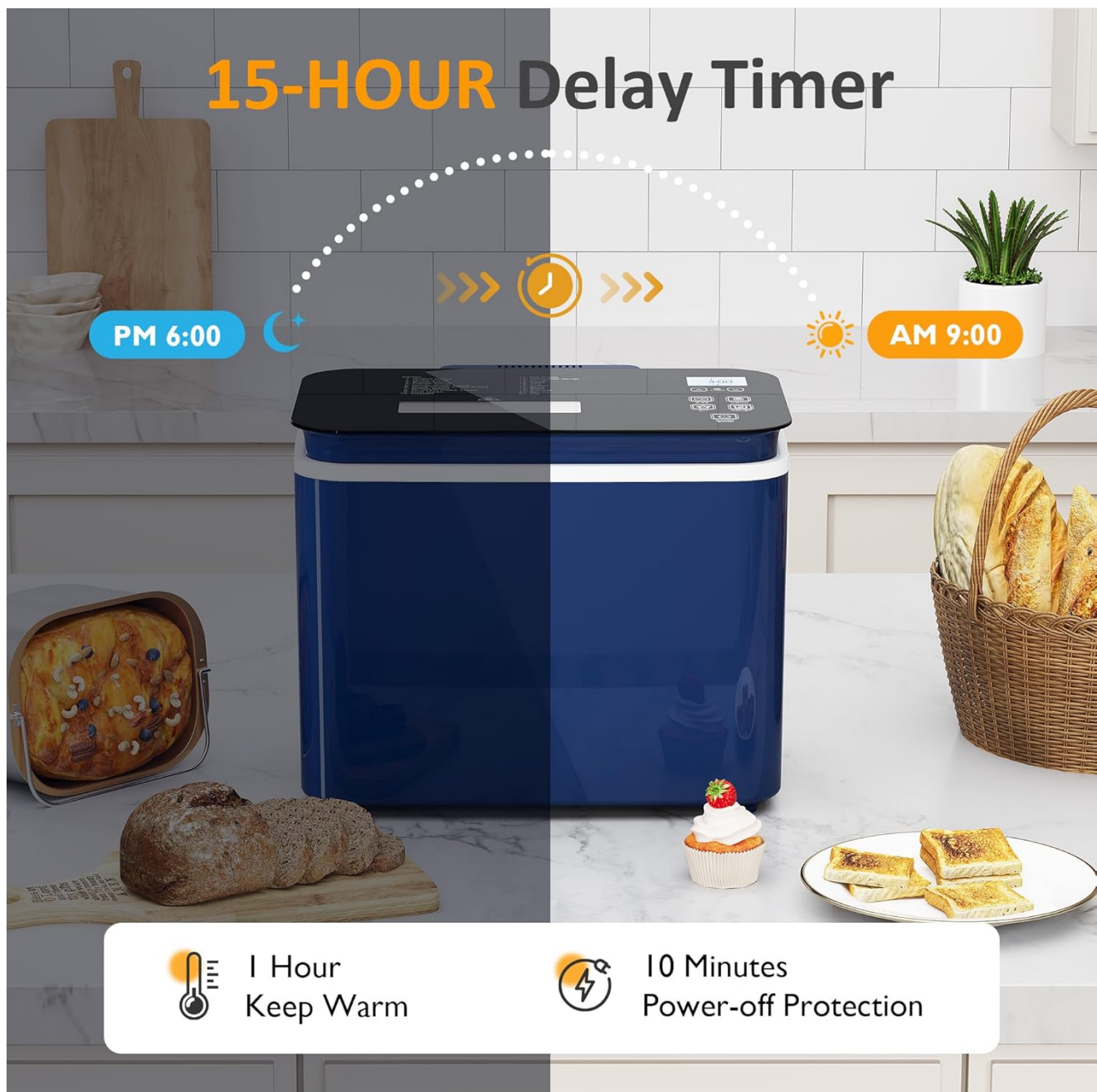

5.5 Keep Warm Function

After the baking cycle is complete, the bread maker will automatically switch to a 1-hour Keep Warm function to maintain the bread's temperature. This feature ensures your bread remains warm and fresh until you are ready to serve it.

5.6 Starting and Stopping

- **To Start:** After selecting your program and settings, press the **START/STOP** button once. The machine will begin operation.
- **To Stop/Cancel:** To stop an active program or cancel the delay timer, press and hold the **START/STOP** button for approximately 3 seconds until a beep sounds and the display resets.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning and maintenance will prolong the life of your bread maker.

1. **Unplug:** Always unplug the appliance from the power outlet and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
2. **Bread Pan and Mixing Paddle:** Remove the bread pan and mixing paddle. Wash them with warm, soapy water using a soft sponge. Do not use abrasive cleaners or metal scouring pads, as these can damage the non-stick coating. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely.
3. **Exterior:** Wipe the exterior of the bread maker with a soft, damp cloth. Do not immerse the main unit in water or any other liquid.
4. **Lid and Viewing Window:** Clean the lid and viewing window with a damp cloth. For stubborn stains, use a mild detergent.
5. **Storage:** Ensure all parts are dry before storing. Store the accessories in the built-in storage compartment.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your bread maker, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bread does not rise	Expired yeast, incorrect water temperature, too much salt/sugar	Check yeast expiration, use lukewarm water (105-115°F), ensure correct ingredient measurements.
Bread is too dense	Too much flour, not enough liquid, old yeast	Measure ingredients precisely, ensure fresh yeast.
Bread collapses in the middle	Too much liquid, too much yeast, high humidity	Reduce liquid slightly, reduce yeast slightly, adjust recipe for humidity.
Mixing paddle stuck in bread	Normal occurrence	Use the provided hook tool to carefully remove the paddle after the bread has cooled slightly.
Machine does not start	Not plugged in, program not selected, START/STOP not pressed	Ensure power cord is securely plugged in, select a program, press START/STOP button.


