3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

10.1 Inch Max Display

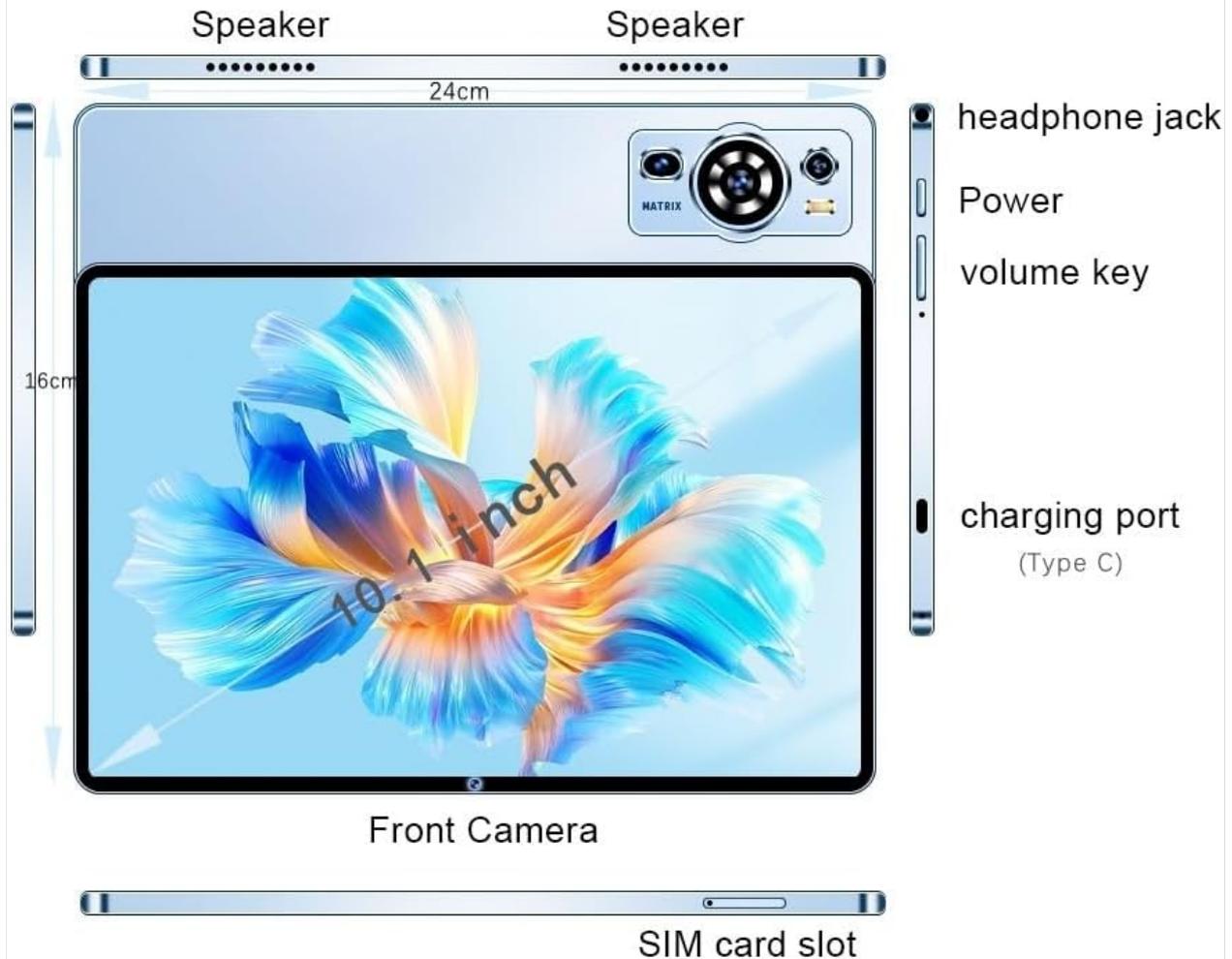


Image 3.1: Diagram illustrating the tablet's ports and buttons.

- **Headphone Jack:** For connecting wired headphones.
- **Power Button:** Press and hold to power on/off or restart. Press briefly to wake/sleep the screen.
- **Volume Keys:** Adjust the tablet's volume.
- **Charging Port (Type C):** Connect the provided USB-C cable for charging.
- **Front Camera:** For video calls and selfies.
- **SIM Card Slot:** Insert a Nano-SIM card for 4G cellular connectivity and a microSD card for expandable storage.
- **Speakers:** Stereo speakers for audio output.

4. INITIAL SETUP

4.1. Charging the Tablet

Before first use, fully charge your tablet. Connect the provided USB-C charging cable to the tablet's charging port and plug the other end into a power adapter (not always included) or a computer's USB port. The battery indicator on the screen will show charging status.

4.2. Powering On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the Power Button until the UXD logo appears.

- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Power Button until the power options menu appears, then select "Power off."
- **To Restart:** Press and hold the Power Button until the power options menu appears, then select "Restart."

4.3. Inserting SIM and microSD Cards

Locate the SIM card slot on the side of the tablet. Use the provided SIM ejector tool (if included) to open the tray. Carefully place your Nano-SIM card and/or microSD card into the designated slots on the tray, ensuring correct orientation. Insert the tray back into the tablet until it clicks into place.

4.4. Connecting Accessories

- **Keyboard and Mouse:** These accessories typically connect via Bluetooth. Go to *Settings > Connected devices > Bluetooth* on your tablet, turn on Bluetooth, and pair with the keyboard and mouse. Follow the specific pairing instructions for each accessory.
- **Stylus:** The stylus can be used directly on the screen for drawing, writing, and navigation. No pairing is usually required for basic functionality.
- **OTG Dongle:** Connect the OTG dongle to the tablet's USB-C port to connect USB devices like flash drives or external hard drives.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Navigating Android 13

Your tablet runs on Android 13, offering an intuitive user interface. Swipe up from the bottom for the app drawer, swipe down from the top for quick settings and notifications. Use gestures or the navigation bar for Home, Back, and Recent Apps functions.

5.2. Connectivity

- **Wi-Fi 6:** To connect to Wi-Fi, go to *Settings > Network & internet > Internet*, select your desired network, and enter the password.
- **Bluetooth 5.0:** For connecting wireless headphones, speakers, or other Bluetooth devices, go to *Settings > Connected devices > Bluetooth*
- **4G Cellular:** If you have inserted a SIM card, enable mobile data in *Settings > Network & internet > Mobile network*.

5.3. Display Settings

The 10.1-inch HD IPS display offers vibrant visuals. Adjust brightness, dark theme, and font size in *Settings > Display*. The tablet supports features like eye protection modes to reduce strain.

5.4. Camera Usage

Your tablet is equipped with dual cameras. Open the Camera app to take photos or record videos. Tap on the screen to focus and use the on-screen controls for various modes and settings.

5.5. Battery Management

The 8000 mAh battery provides extended usage. To optimize battery life, adjust screen brightness, close unused apps, and enable battery saver mode when needed. Avoid extreme temperatures.

- **Media Consumption:** Watch videos and listen to music on the HD display and stereo speakers.

6. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- **Storage:** Store the tablet in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Software Updates:** Regularly check for and install system updates to ensure optimal performance and security. Go to *Settings > System > System update*
- **Protecting the Screen:** Apply the included screen protector to prevent scratches.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

This section addresses common issues you might encounter:

- **Tablet will not turn on:** Ensure the tablet is charged. Connect it to a charger for at least 30 minutes, then try powering on again. If it still doesn't turn on, perform a forced restart by holding the power button for 10-15 seconds.
- **Screen is unresponsive:** Restart the tablet. If the issue persists, ensure the screen is clean and free of debris.
- **Wi-Fi connection issues:** Check if Wi-Fi is enabled in settings. Restart your router and the tablet. Forget the network and reconnect.
- **Slow performance:** Close unused applications. Clear cache data from apps. Consider performing a factory reset (back up your data first).
- **Accessories not connecting:** Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on the tablet and the accessory is in pairing mode. Check battery levels of wireless accessories.

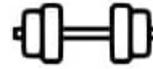
