## 1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the Beldray Compact Spotbuster Spot Cleaner. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new appliance. Please read these instructions thoroughly before first use and retain them for future reference.

The Beldray Compact Spotbuster is designed for effective spot cleaning of carpets, rugs, and upholstery, removing spills, stains, pet hair, and general dirt. Its integrated spray, scrubbing, and suction system offers a deep cleaning solution in a portable format.

## 2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Always observe basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and personal injury.

- Read all instructions before use.
- Do not immerse the appliance in water or any other liquid.
- Keep the appliance away from children and pets.
- Do not use the appliance if the power cord or plug is damaged.
- Use only cleaning solutions recommended for spot cleaners.
- Unplug the appliance from the power supply before cleaning or maintenance.
- Do not block ventilation openings.
- Do not use on wet surfaces or outdoors.
- Always ensure tanks are correctly installed before operation.

### 3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the components of your Beldray Compact Spotbuster.

- **Main Unit:** Contains the motor, clean water tank, and dirty water tank.
- **Clean Water Tank:** For fresh water and cleaning solution (800ml capacity).
- **Dirty Water Tank:** Collects extracted dirty water (500ml capacity).
- **Flexible Hose:** Connects the main unit to the cleaning tool.
- **Cleaning Tool:** Features a spray nozzle, scrubbing brush, and suction inlet.
- **Power Cord:** For connecting to an electrical outlet.

## 4. SETUP

---

Before first use, follow these steps to prepare your spot cleaner.

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. **Fill Clean Water Tank:**
  - Remove the clean water tank from the main unit.
  - Open the fill cap and fill with warm tap water (max 40°C) up to the 'MAX' line.
  - Add a suitable spot cleaning solution according to the solution manufacturer's instructions. Do

not overfill.

- Securely close the fill cap and reinsert the tank into the main unit.

3. **Connect Hose:** Ensure the flexible hose is securely connected to the main unit.
4. **Attach Cleaning Tool:** Firmly attach the desired cleaning tool to the end of the flexible hose.
5. **Position:** Place the spot cleaner on a flat, stable surface near the area to be cleaned.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

Always test the cleaning solution on an inconspicuous area of the material to be cleaned for colorfastness before full application.

### General Cleaning Steps:

1. **Plug In:** Connect the power cord to a suitable electrical outlet.
2. **Power On:** Press the power button on the main unit to turn on the cleaner.
3. **Pre-treat (Optional):** For stubborn stains, spray a small amount of cleaning solution directly onto the stain using the spray trigger on the cleaning tool. Allow it to soak for a few minutes.
4. **Spray and Scrub:** Hold the cleaning tool over the stain. Press the spray trigger to dispense solution while simultaneously moving the tool back and forth over the area to scrub the stain.
5. **Suction:** Release the spray trigger and continue moving the cleaning tool over the wet area to suction up the dirty solution. Repeat until the stain is removed and the area is as dry as possible.
6. **Monitor Dirty Water Tank:** Keep an eye on the dirty water tank. Empty it when it reaches the 'MAX' fill line or when cleaning is complete.
7. **Power Off:** Once cleaning is finished, press the power button to turn off the appliance and unplug it from the outlet.

### Cleaning Upholstery:

When cleaning upholstery, ensure the fabric is suitable for wet cleaning. Avoid over-wetting the fabric. Use gentle strokes and extract as much moisture as possible.

### **Cleaning Carpets and Rugs:**

For carpets and rugs, follow the general cleaning steps. For larger areas, work in small sections, overlapping slightly to ensure thorough cleaning. The expandable hose and deep cleaning brush are ideal for carpeted stairs.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your appliance.

### After Each Use:

1. **Empty Dirty Water Tank:** Remove the dirty water tank, open the drain cap, and pour out the dirty water. Rinse the tank thoroughly with clean water.
2. **Rinse Clean Water Tank:** If any solution remains, empty and rinse the clean water tank.
3. **Clean Cleaning Tool:** Detach the cleaning tool and rinse it under running water to remove any debris or residue.
4. **Wipe Down:** Wipe the exterior of the main unit and hose with a damp cloth.
5. **Dry:** Allow all components to air dry completely before reassembling and storing.

**Storage:** Store the appliance in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and out of reach of children.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Beldray Compact Spotbuster, refer to the following table for common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Appliance does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outlet faulty; power button not pressed.	Ensure plug is fully inserted. Test outlet with another device. Press power button firmly.
No spray from cleaning tool.	Clean water tank empty; tank not seated correctly; spray nozzle clogged.	Refill clean water tank. Reinstall tank securely. Clean spray nozzle.
Poor suction.	Dirty water tank full; hose/tool clogged; dirty water tank not seated correctly.	Empty dirty water tank. Clear any blockages in hose/tool. Reinstall dirty water tank securely.
Water leaking.	Tanks not sealed properly; caps loose; hose connection loose.	Ensure all caps are tight and tanks are correctly seated. Check hose connections.
