Introduction

What's Included

Your Bushnell Golf LPi Personal Launch Monitor package includes the following components:

- Launch Pro Indoor Device
- Power Cord/A/C Power Adapter
- USB-C Cable
- 48pc Club Marker Pack
- Alignment Stick
- Ethernet Cable

Setup

Follow these steps to set up your LPi Personal Launch Monitor:

1. **Placement:** Position the Launch Pro Indoor Device on a stable, flat surface approximately 7-8 feet behind the ball. Ensure there is clear line of sight to the ball and the hitting area.
2. **Power Connection:** Connect the power cord to the device and plug it into a standard electrical outlet.

3. **Ethernet Connection:** Connect the Ethernet cable from the device to your computer or network router. This ensures a stable data connection for optimal performance.
4. **Software Installation:** Install the required golf simulation software (e.g., FSX Play) on your computer. Follow the software provider's instructions for installation and account setup.
5. **Device Alignment:** Use the included alignment stick to ensure the device is correctly aligned with your target line. Refer to the software interface for visual alignment guides.
6. **Club Markers:** Apply the 48pc Club Marker Pack to your clubs as instructed by the software to enable accurate club data tracking.

Operating Instructions

1. **Launch Software:** Open your preferred golf simulation software (e.g., FSX Play) on your connected computer.
2. **Device Recognition:** Ensure the software recognizes the LPi device. The device status indicator should confirm a successful connection.
3. **Select Mode:** Choose your desired mode within the software, such as practice range, course play, or skill challenges.
4. **Prepare to Hit:** Place a golf ball on the hitting mat within the designated tracking area.
5. **Swing:** Execute your golf swing. The LPi device will capture ball and club data instantly.
6. **Review Data:** View your shot data, including ball speed, club speed, launch angle, spin, and more, directly on your computer screen or connected display.
