1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Monster S620 Portable Bluetooth Speaker. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your speaker to ensure optimal performance and longevity. The Monster S620 delivers powerful 40W sound with True Wireless Stereo capabilities, IPX8 waterproofing, and Bluetooth 5.4 connectivity, making it ideal for both indoor and outdoor use.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all safety instructions carefully before using this product. Failure to follow these instructions may result in

electric shock, fire, or serious injury.

- Do not expose the speaker to extreme temperatures or direct sunlight for prolonged periods.
- Do not disassemble, repair, or modify the speaker. This will void the warranty.
- Keep the speaker away from medical devices, as its magnetic field may interfere with their operation.
- Use only the provided charging cable or a certified equivalent.
- Ensure the charging port cover is securely closed when the speaker is exposed to water to maintain its IPX8 waterproof rating.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all items are present in the package:

- Monster S620 Portable Bluetooth Speaker
- USB Charging Cable
- User Manual
- Braided Carry Belt (attached or separate)

4. SETUP

4.1 Charging the Speaker

Before first use, fully charge the speaker. Connect the USB charging cable to the speaker's charging port and the other end to a USB power adapter (not included) or a computer's USB port. The charging indicator light will illuminate during charging and turn off when fully charged.

4.2 Powering On/Off

- To Power On: Press and hold the Power button for 2-3 seconds until you hear an audible prompt.
- To Power Off: Press and hold the Power button for 2-3 seconds until you hear an audible prompt.

4.3 Bluetooth Pairing

The Monster S620 uses Bluetooth 5.4 for fast and stable connections.

1. Ensure the speaker is powered on and in Bluetooth pairing mode (indicated by a flashing blue LED).
2. On your device (smartphone, tablet, computer), enable Bluetooth and search for new devices.
3. Select "Monster S620" from the list of available devices.
4. Once connected, the LED indicator will turn solid blue, and you will hear a confirmation sound.

4.4 True Wireless Stereo (TWS) Pairing

You can pair two Monster S620 speakers together for an enhanced stereo sound experience (80W total output).

1. Ensure both Monster S620 speakers are powered on and not connected to any Bluetooth device.
2. On one speaker (this will be the primary speaker), double-press the Bluetooth button. It will enter TWS pairing mode.
3. The two speakers will automatically connect to each other. You will hear a confirmation tone once TWS pairing is successful.
4. Now, connect your device to the primary speaker via Bluetooth as described in Section 4.3.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Basic Controls

Button/Function	Action	Description
Power Button	Press and Hold (2-3s)	Power On/Off
Volume +	Short Press	Increase Volume
Volume +	Long Press	Next Track
Volume -	Short Press	Decrease Volume
Volume -	Long Press	Previous Track
Play/Pause Button	Short Press	Play/Pause Music
Play/Pause Button	Short Press (during call)	Answer/End Call
Play/Pause Button	Long Press (during call)	Reject Call
Bluetooth Button	Short Press	Disconnect Bluetooth / Re-enter Pairing Mode
Bluetooth Button	Double Press	Initiate TWS Pairing (when not connected)

5.2 Call Handling

With the built-in microphone, you can answer calls directly through the speaker when connected via Bluetooth.

- To Answer/End a Call: Short press the Play/Pause button.

- To Reject a Call: Long press the Play/Pause button.

5.3 Waterproof Usage (IPX8)

The Monster S620 is IPX8 waterproof, meaning it can be submerged in water up to 1 meter for 30 minutes. It is suitable for use in showers, by the pool, or at the beach.

- Ensure the charging port cover is fully sealed before exposing the speaker to water.
- Do not submerge the speaker in saltwater or other corrosive liquids.
- After exposure to water, wipe the speaker dry before charging.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning

- Wipe the speaker with a soft, damp cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Ensure the speaker is dry before storing or charging.

6.2 Storage

- Store the speaker in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.
- If storing for an extended period, charge the battery to approximately 50% every few months to preserve battery life.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Speaker does not power on.	Battery is depleted.	Charge the speaker fully.
No sound.	Volume is too low or muted. Device not connected.	Increase volume on speaker and connected device. Ensure Bluetooth is connected.
Cannot pair with Bluetooth device.	Speaker is not in pairing mode. Device's Bluetooth is off. Interference.	Ensure speaker is flashing blue. Turn device's Bluetooth off/on. Move speaker closer to device.
TWS pairing fails.	Speakers are already connected to a device.	Disconnect both speakers from any Bluetooth devices before initiating TWS pairing.
Poor sound quality.	Low battery. Device too far from speaker. Obstructions.	Charge speaker. Move device closer (within 100 feet). Remove obstructions.




Figure 8.1: Illustration of the speaker's internal components, including high-tone loudspeaker and low-tone horn.
