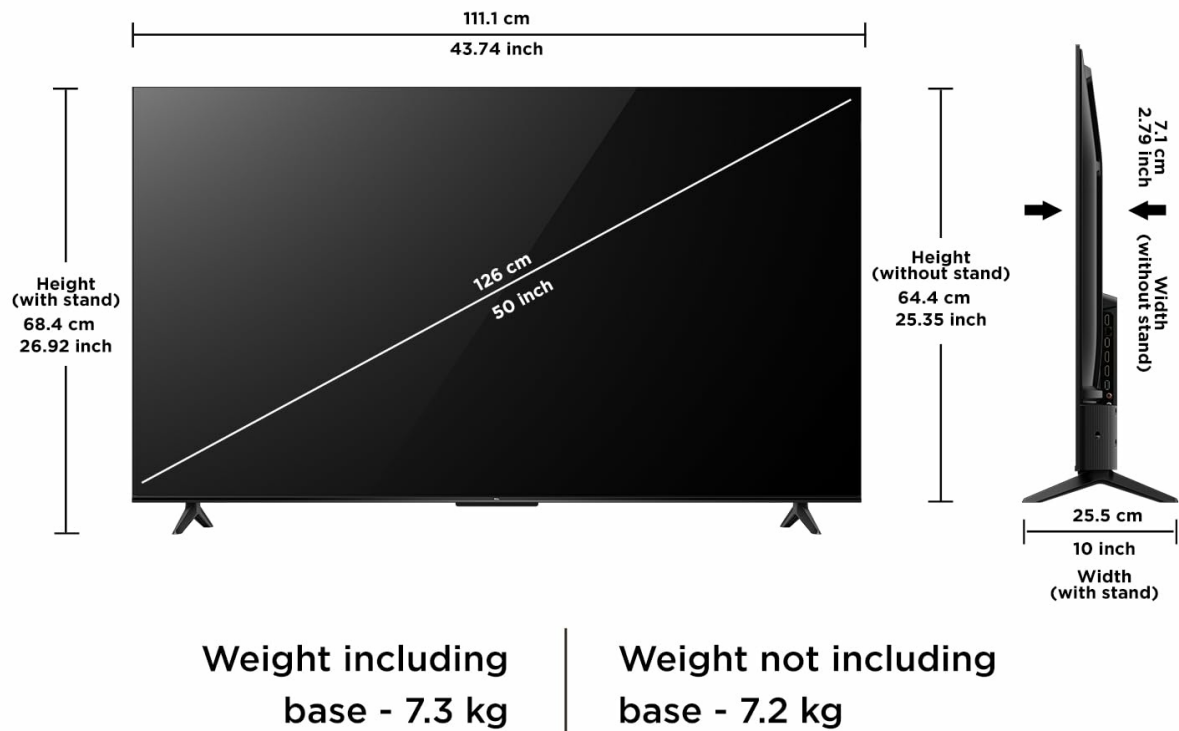


Image: Contents of the TV box, including the television unit, remote control with batteries, stand components, and an audio cable.

SETUP GUIDE

Attaching the Stand

1. Carefully place the TV screen-down on a soft, flat surface to prevent damage.
2. Align the stand components with the designated slots on the bottom of the TV.
3. Secure the stand using the provided screws. Ensure the stand is firmly attached before proceeding.

Note: For wall mounting, a fixed wall mount is not included and must be purchased separately. Consult a service provider for installation.

- **HDMI Ports (x3):** Connect Blu-ray players, gaming consoles, or other HDMI-enabled devices.
- **USB Port (x1):** For connecting USB storage devices to play media or for software updates.
- **LAN Port (x1):** For wired internet connection.
- **Antenna Input (x1):** Connect an external antenna for terrestrial broadcasts.
- **Satellite Input (x1):** Connect a satellite dish for satellite broadcasts.
- **AV IN Adapter (x1):** For connecting older devices using composite video and stereo audio cables.

Initial Power On

1. Connect the power cord to the TV and then to a power outlet.
2. Press the power button on the remote control or on the TV itself.
3. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the initial setup, including language selection, network connection, and Google TV account setup.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Remote Control Functions

The remote control provides access to all TV functions. Insert the two AAA batteries into the remote control.

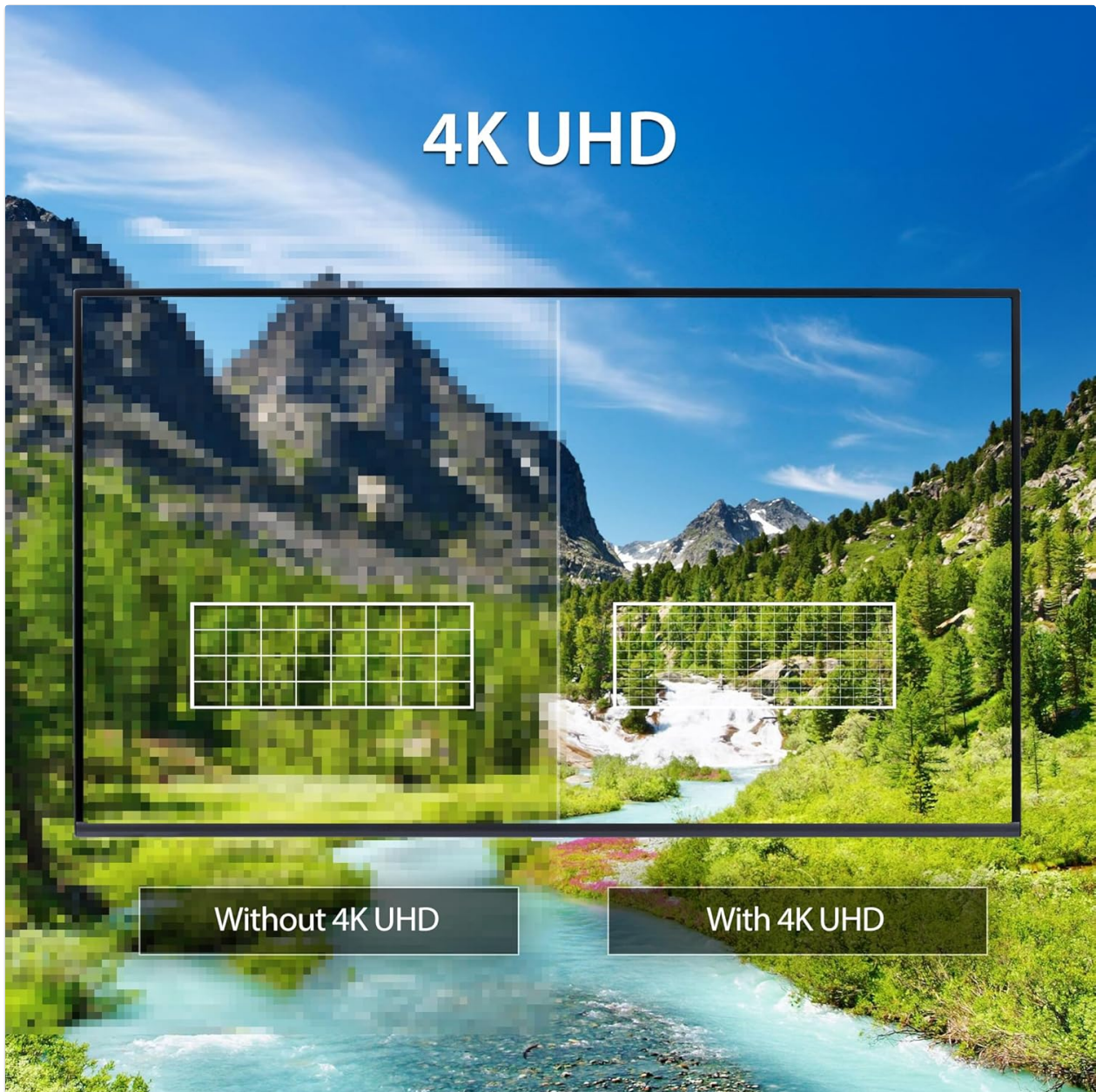


Image: The remote control for the TCL 50V6C, showing dedicated buttons for Google Assistant and popular streaming services.

- **Power Button:** Turns the TV on or off.
- **Navigation Pad:** Used to navigate menus and select options.
- **Google Assistant Button:** Activates voice commands for search and control.

- **Channel Up/Down:** Changes TV channels.
- **Quick Access Buttons:** Dedicated buttons for popular streaming services like Prime Video, Netflix, Hotstar, and Zee5.

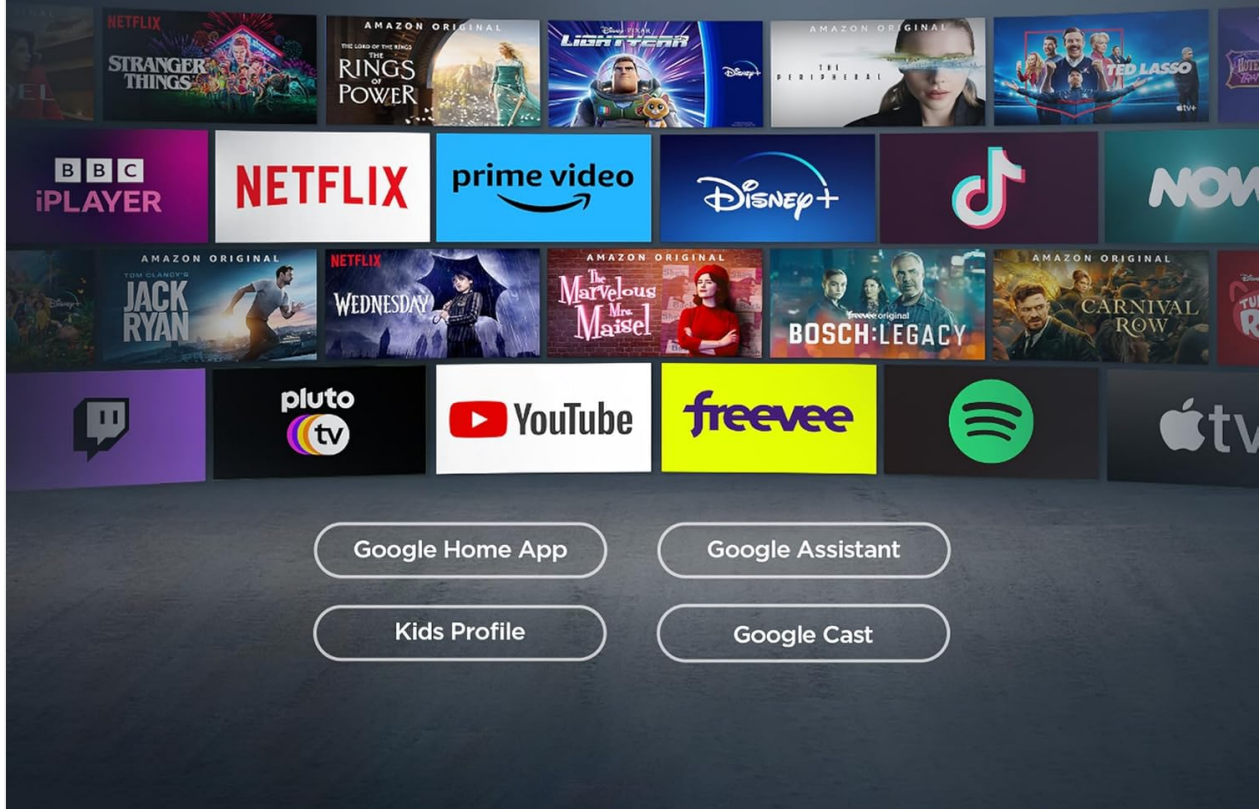


Image: The Google TV home screen interface, showcasing recommended movies, shows, and installed applications.

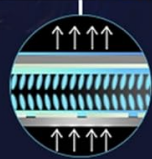

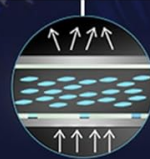

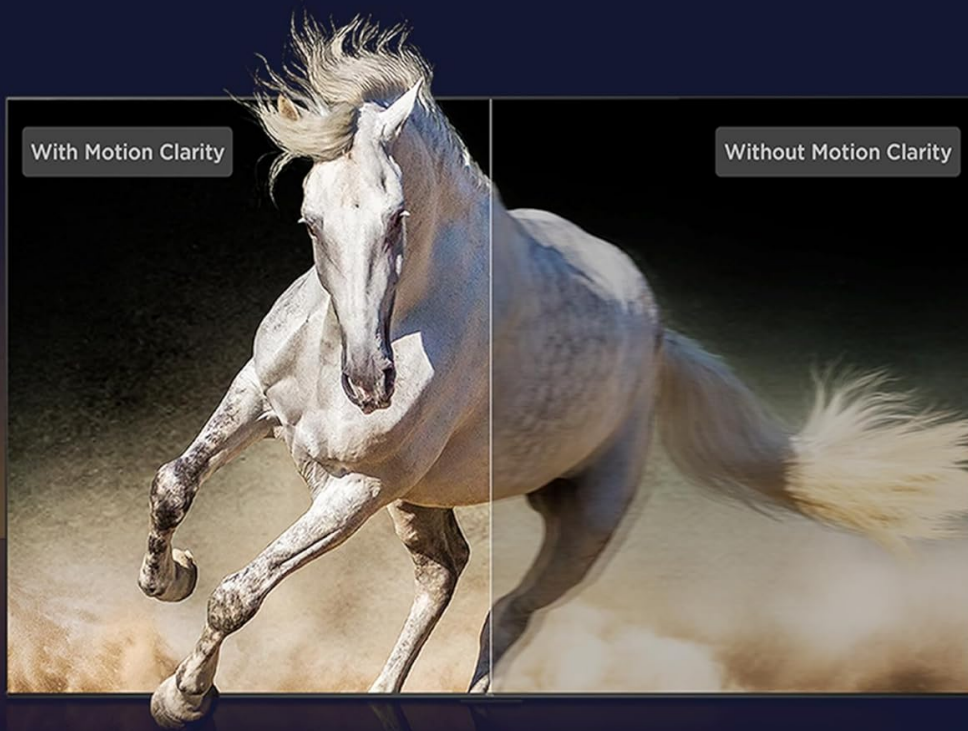


Image: A graphic representation of the AiPQ Processor, emphasizing its role in intelligent image processing.

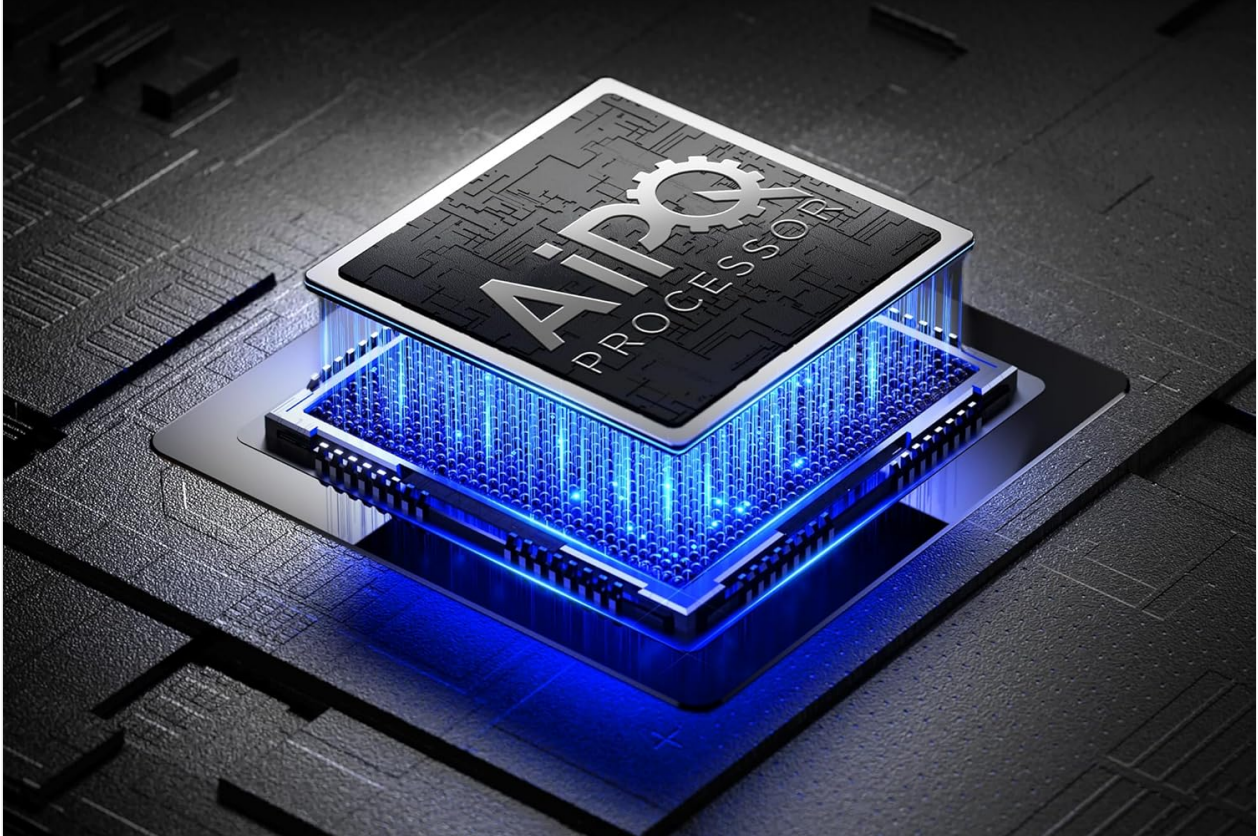


Image: A visual demonstration of MEMC technology, comparing a blurry image without it to a clear image with it during fast motion.

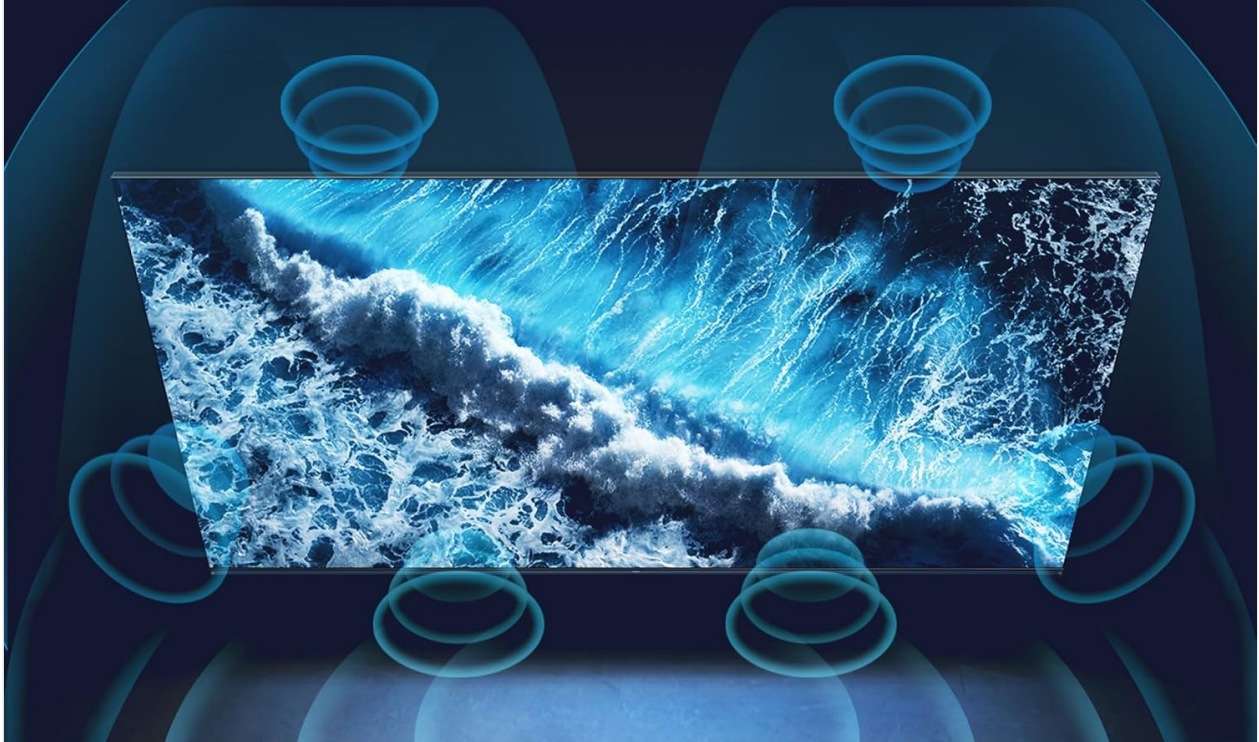


Image: A graphic illustrating the immersive sound experience provided by Dolby Atmos technology.

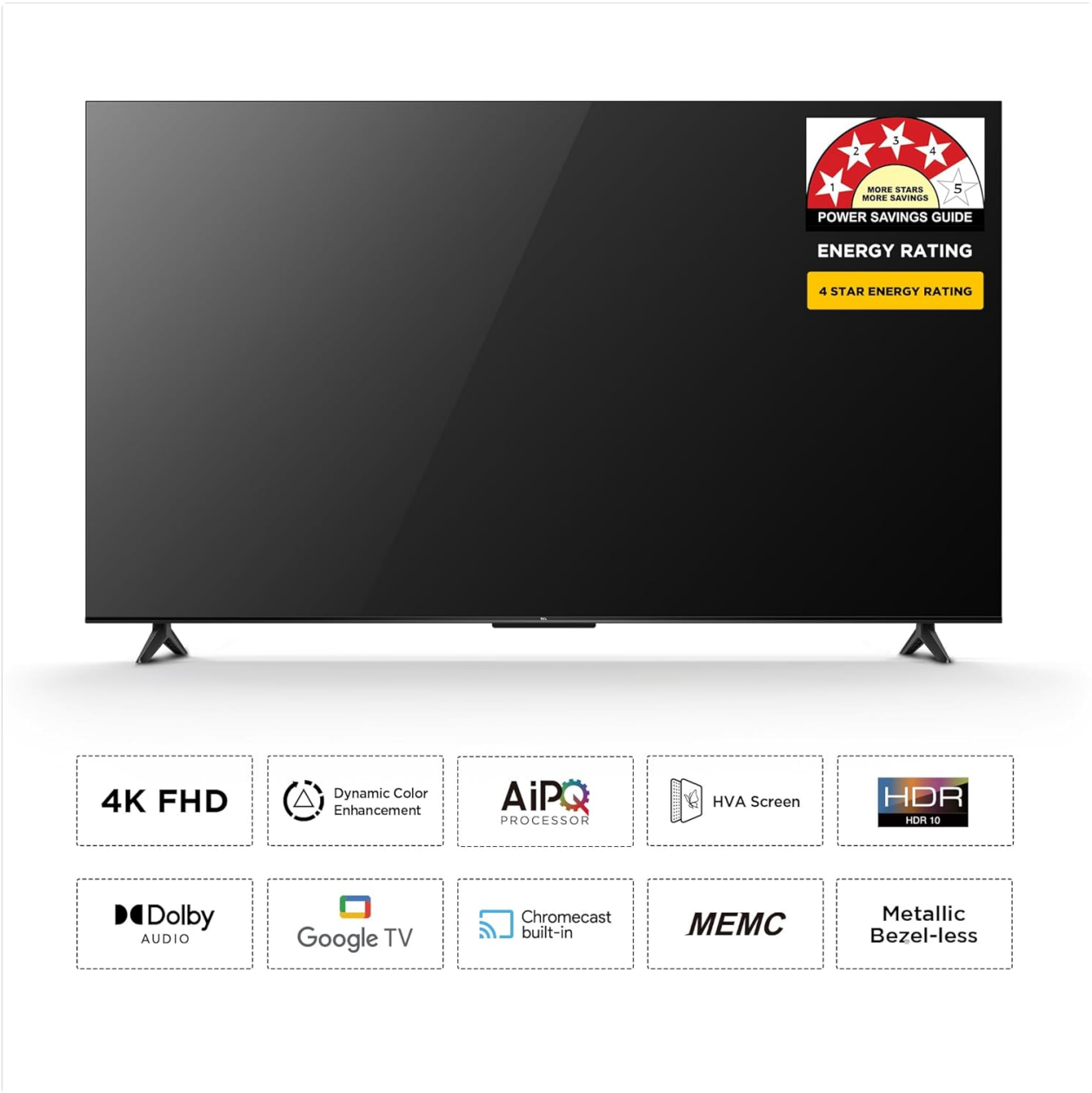


Image: The television unit with an overlay of its key display and smart features.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your TCL 50V6C TV, follow these general maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning the Screen:** Gently wipe the screen with a soft, lint-free cloth. For stubborn marks, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen-cleaning solution specifically designed for electronics. Do not spray liquid directly onto the screen.
- **Cleaning the Casing:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the TV's casing. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure that the ventilation openings on the back of the TV are not blocked to prevent overheating. Maintain adequate space around the TV for proper airflow.
- **Power Cord:** Regularly check the power cord for any damage. If damaged, replace it with an authorized replacement.
- **Environmental Conditions:** Avoid exposing the TV to extreme temperatures, high humidity, or direct sunlight.

For any internal cleaning or repairs, contact qualified service personnel.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This section provides solutions to common issues you might encounter with your TCL 50V6C TV.

No Power

- Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into both the TV and a working electrical outlet.
- Check if the power outlet is functioning by plugging in another device.
- Press the power button on the TV itself, not just the remote, to rule out a remote control issue.

No Picture, But Sound is Present

- Verify that the correct input source is selected (e.g., HDMI 1, AV).
- Check all cable connections between the TV and external devices. Try disconnecting and reconnecting them.
- If using an external device, ensure it is powered on and functioning correctly.

No Sound, But Picture is Present

- Check the volume level on both the TV and any connected external audio devices.
- Ensure the TV is not muted.
- If using external speakers, verify their connections and power.
- Check audio output settings in the TV menu to ensure the correct output is selected (e.g., TV speakers, external audio system).

Remote Control Not Working

- Replace the batteries in the remote control with new AAA batteries.
- Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote control and the TV's IR sensor.
- Point the remote directly at the TV.

Network Connection Issues

- For Wi-Fi, check if your router is powered on and broadcasting. Try restarting the router.
- For wired connection, ensure the Ethernet cable is securely connected to both the TV and the router.
- Go to the TV's network settings and try reconnecting or re-entering Wi-Fi passwords.

If the issue persists after trying these steps, please refer to the Warranty & Support section for further assistance.

Warranty Information

The TCL 50V6C comes with a 2-year warranty provided by the manufacturer for the TV from the date of purchase. The remote control has a 6-month warranty.





