#### 1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

## 2. PRODUCT FEATURES IN DETAIL

## 2.1. 170° Wide Angle Lens

The doorbell camera features a 170° wide-angle lens, providing an expansive view of your doorstep. This wide field of view helps reduce blind spots, ensuring comprehensive coverage for enhanced home security.

Video doorbell camera has 1080p HD Video, 170 wide angle lens which is guarding your home security around the clock




Figure 2: The 170-degree wide-angle lens captures a broad area, enhancing surveillance coverage.

#### 2.2. PIR Motion Detection

Equipped with a highly sensitive PIR (Passive Infrared) motion sensor, the doorbell detects movement in its vicinity. Upon detection, the doorbell instantly wakes up and sends an alert notification to your mobile application, helping you stay informed of any activity at your door.

## **PIR Motion Detection**

Motion has been detected using the video doorbell's sensor, smart technology alerts you via the APP with a mobile notification for easy and convenience, which will reduce false alarm. Make the camera doorbell own the longest use time.




Figure 3: PIR Motion Detection alerts you to activity, pushing notifications directly to your smartphone.

#### 2.3. Information Push & Remote Video Calls

When a visitor presses the doorbell button, the mobile application automatically pushes a message to your phone. This allows you to receive notifications and initiate remote video calls with the visitor, even without opening the door.

## **Information Push**

The visitor presses the doorbell and automatically pushes the message to the mobile phone without opening the door, and the mobile phone can make remote video calls.

## 2.4. Intelligent Voice Control Integration

The doorbell camera is compatible with Amazon Alexa and Google Assistant. When someone presses the doorbell, your smart speaker or display will announce "Someone press the doorbell." You can also command your smart display, such as "Hey Alexa, show me front door," to view a live feed from the doorbell.




Figure 5: Seamless integration with smart home voice assistants for convenient monitoring.

## 2.5. Dual Power Supply Option

This wireless video doorbell offers flexible power options. It can be powered by 12V-24V AC hard-wired connections or by rechargeable batteries. Note that while AC power can maintain operation, it does not charge the battery; battery charging is done via a USB cable. The device also features a low battery alert system that sends a notification to your app when the battery level is low, reminding you to recharge or replace the batteries.

#### 2.6. IP55 Weather Resistant

The doorbell is designed with an IP55 weather resistance rating, ensuring reliable performance and crystal-clear image quality even in challenging weather conditions, including rain and dust.

#### 3. SETUP GUIDE

#### 3.1. Before Installation

- Ensure your home WiFi network is 2.4GHz. The doorbell does not support 5GHz WiFi.
- Charge the doorbell batteries fully using a USB cable before initial use, even if planning to hardwire.
- Download the "Smart Life" or "TuyaSmart" app from Google Play Store or Apple App Store.
- Ensure your mobile device is connected to the 2.4GHz WiFi network you intend to connect the doorbell to.

#### 3.2. App Setup and Device Pairing

- 1. Open the "Smart Life" or "TuyaSmart" app and register/log in to your account.
- 2. Tap the "+" icon in the top right corner to add a device.
- 3. Select "Security & Video Surveillance" and then "Smart Doorbell" or "Video Doorbell".
- 4. Follow the on-screen instructions to put the doorbell into pairing mode (usually by pressing and holding a button until an indicator light flashes).
- 5. Enter your 2.4GHz WiFi network password when prompted.
- 6. Scan the QR code displayed on your phone with the doorbell camera. Hold the phone approximately

15-20 cm (6-8 inches) from the doorbell lens.

- 7. Wait for the doorbell to connect to the network. Once connected, you will hear a confirmation sound, and the device will appear in your app.
- 8. Rename the doorbell for easy identification (e.g., "Front Doorbell").

#### 3.3. Physical Installation

- Choose a suitable mounting location near your front door, ensuring a clear view and good WiFi signal strength.
- If using hardwired power (12V-24V AC), ensure power is off at the breaker before connecting wires. Connect the existing doorbell wires to the terminals on the back of the doorbell camera.
- Mount the doorbell bracket to the wall using the provided screws and anchors.
- · Attach the doorbell unit to the mounted bracket, ensuring it is securely fastened.
- If using battery power, insert the charged batteries into the doorbell unit.
- Turn on the power at the breaker if hardwired.

#### 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

#### 4.1. Live View and Two-Way Audio

- Open the "Smart Life" or "TuyaSmart" app and select your doorbell device.
- Tap on the live view to see real-time video from your doorbell.
- To speak with a visitor, tap the microphone icon in the app. Speak clearly into your phone. Tap again to mute.
- To listen to the visitor, ensure the speaker icon in the app is enabled.

#### 4.2. Responding to Doorbell Presses and Motion Alerts

- When someone presses the doorbell or motion is detected, you will receive a push notification on your smartphone.
- Tap the notification to immediately open the app and view the live feed or recorded event.
- From the live view, you can initiate two-way audio communication.

#### 4.3. Night Vision

The doorbell camera automatically switches to night vision mode in low-light conditions, providing clear black-and-white video footage to ensure continuous monitoring even in complete darkness.

#### 4.4. Video Recording and Playback

- The doorbell supports local storage via a MicroSD card (up to 64GB, not included) and cloud storage (subscription may be required).
- · Recorded events (motion detection, doorbell presses) are stored automatically.
- To view recordings, navigate to the "Playback" or "Cloud Storage" section within the app for your doorbell device.
- Select the date and time to review recorded footage.

#### 5. MAINTENANCE

• Cleaning: Periodically wipe the camera lens and the doorbell's exterior with a soft, damp cloth to

remove dust and smudges. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.

- Battery Management: If using battery power, ensure batteries are charged when the low battery alert is received. For optimal battery life, avoid extreme temperatures.
- **Firmware Updates:** Check the app regularly for firmware updates. Keeping your doorbell's firmware up-to-date ensures optimal performance and security.
- **WiFi Connection:** Ensure your doorbell remains within a strong WiFi signal range. Poor signal can affect performance and battery life.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Doorbell not connecting to WiFi.	Incorrect WiFi password; 5GHz WiFi network; doorbell too far from router; weak signal.	<ul> <li>Double-check WiFi password.</li> <li>Ensure you are connecting to a 2.4GHz network.</li> <li>Move the doorbell closer to the WiFi router during setup.</li> <li>Consider a WiFi extender if signal is consistently weak.</li> </ul>
No push notifications.	App notification settings disabled; phone's notification settings disabled; doorbell offline.	<ul> <li>Check notification settings within the "Smart Life" or "TuyaSmart" app.</li> <li>Verify notification permissions for the app in your phone's system settings.</li> <li>Ensure the doorbell is online and connected to WiFi.</li> </ul>
Poor video quality or lag.	Weak WiFi signal; network congestion.	<ul> <li>Improve WiFi signal strength at the doorbell's location.</li> <li>Reduce other network activity during live view.</li> </ul>
Doorbell turns off after 15 seconds.	Doorbell button held for too long.	Avoid holding the doorbell button for more than 15 seconds. A brief press is sufficient.
