INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the HomeStock Lakeside Living Counter Height Barstool. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new barstool. Please read these instructions carefully before assembly and retain them for future reference.

This barstool features a solid lodge pole pine wood frame, saddle upholstery, and a laser-engraved design on the backrest, offering both durability and a distinctive aesthetic for your home or commercial space.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- **Weight Limit:** Do not exceed the recommended weight limit for this barstool. Consult the product packaging or manufacturer's website for specific weight capacity.
- **Stable Surface:** Always place the barstool on a flat, stable, and level surface to prevent tipping.
- **Children:** Supervise children around the barstool to prevent accidents. Do not allow children to climb or play on the barstool.
- **Assembly:** Ensure all parts are correctly assembled and fasteners are tightened securely before use. Periodically check and re-tighten fasteners.
- **Moving:** When moving the barstool, lift it rather than dragging it to prevent damage to the legs or floor.
- **Flammable Materials:** Keep the barstool away from open flames and heat sources.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The HomeStock Lakeside Living Counter Height Barstool is designed for quick and straightforward assembly. All necessary hardware and clear instructions are included.

- Seat Assembly (1)
- Backrest (1)
- Front Legs (2)
- Back Legs (2)
- Footrests/Stretchers (3)
- Hardware Pack (Bolts, Washers, Allen Wrench)

Assembly Steps

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging. Lay them out on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratching. Verify all parts are present against the parts list.
2. **Attach Backrest to Seat:** Align the backrest with the pre-drilled holes on the seat assembly. Secure using the provided bolts and washers. Do not fully tighten yet.
3. **Attach Legs:** Attach the front and back legs to the seat assembly using the appropriate bolts and washers. Ensure the legs are oriented correctly. Do not fully tighten.
4. **Install Footrests/Stretchers:** Connect the footrests/stretchers between the legs. These provide stability and a place for your feet. Secure with bolts and washers.
5. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are loosely assembled, place the barstool upright on a level surface. Apply gentle downward pressure to ensure all parts are seated correctly, then systematically tighten all bolts using the Allen wrench. Do not overtighten.
6. **Inspect:** Ensure the barstool is stable and all connections are secure before first use.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This barstool is designed for comfortable seating at counter-height surfaces.

- **Proper Seating:** Sit centrally on the seat with your back against the backrest for optimal support.
- **Footrest Use:** Utilize the integrated footrests for added comfort and stability, especially during extended periods of sitting.
- **Movement:** Avoid sudden, forceful movements or leaning excessively to one side, which could compromise stability.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Regular maintenance will help preserve the appearance and longevity of your barstool.

- **Cleaning Wood Frame:** Wipe the solid lodge pole pine wood frame with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, which can damage the wood finish. Dry immediately with a clean cloth.
- **Cleaning Upholstery:** For the saddle upholstery, spot clean with a mild soap and water solution. Test on an inconspicuous area first. Blot dry; do not rub.
- **Fastener Check:** Periodically (every 3-6 months) check all bolts and fasteners to ensure they are

tight. Re-tighten as necessary to maintain stability.

- **Avoid Direct Sunlight:** Prolonged exposure to direct sunlight can cause wood to fade or upholstery to degrade. Position the barstool away from direct sunlight when possible.
- **Humidity Control:** Maintain a consistent humidity level in the room to prevent wood from cracking or warping.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Barstool wobbles	Uneven floor; Loose fasteners; Uneven leg assembly	Move to a level surface. Check and tighten all assembly bolts. If wobbling persists, loosen all bolts slightly, sit on the stool to settle the legs, then re-tighten.
Parts do not align during assembly	Incorrect orientation of parts; Overtightened bolts prematurely	Review assembly steps and diagrams. Ensure parts are oriented correctly. Loosen any overtightened bolts and try again, keeping all bolts loose until final step.
Squeaking noise	Loose joints; Friction between wood parts	Tighten all bolts. If noise continues, disassemble the affected joint, apply a small amount of furniture wax or paraffin to the contact surfaces, and reassemble.
