HH-Tech Bluetooth Smart Tag User Manual

Model: HHTAG

1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The HH-Tech Bluetooth Smart Tag is designed to help you easily locate your belongings using the Google Find My Device network. This compact and durable tag can be attached to keys, bags, wallets, and more, providing peace of mind by allowing you to track your items from your Android device.

Data and Privacy Protected

Only you can access the Tag's location. Your location, history, and information are never stored on the Tag. The device relaying the Tag's location remains anonymous, and all location data is encrypted at every level.

Anti-Tracking

If the Tag moves with you over time after being separated from its owner, you'll receive a notification.

2. SETUP AND PAIRING

2.1 App Installation

The HH-Tech Smart Tag works with the Google Find My Device network. To begin, you need to install the Google Find My Device app on your Android smartphone (Android 9+ required).

1. Open the **Google Play Store** on your Android device.
2. Search for "**Google Find My Device**".
3. Download and install the official app.

2.2 Phone Settings Configuration

Before pairing, ensure your phone's settings are correctly configured:

- Go to your phone's **Settings**.

- Search for "Find My Device" and tap on it.
- Select "Find your offline devices" and ensure "With network in all areas" is enabled.
- Turn on **Bluetooth** in your phone settings.
- Connect to a stable **Wi-Fi** or **cellular data network**.
- Turn on **Location services** on your phone.

2.3 Pairing Your HH-Tag

Follow these steps to pair your HH-Tech Smart Tag with your Android device:

1. Remove the insulating paper from the HH-Tag. The tag will emit a short sound, indicating it is ready for pairing.
2. Bring the Smart Tag close to your phone. A pop-up notification should appear on your screen.
3. Tap "**Connect**" on the pop-up.
4. Read and accept the prompts. Follow the on-screen instructions within the Google Find My Device app to complete the pairing process.

3. OPERATING YOUR HH-TAG

3.1 How the Google Find My Device Network Works

The HH-Tech Smart Tag leverages Google's Find My Device network. When your tag is out of Bluetooth range of your phone, millions of Android devices anonymously and securely detect its location. This information is then updated on your map within the Google Find My Device app, allowing you to track your item even when it's far away. All data is encrypted and anonymous, ensuring your privacy.

3.2 Finding Nearby Items

When your HH-Tag is within Bluetooth range (up to 50 meters), you can use the Google Find My Device app to locate it by playing a sound.

- Open the **Google Find My Device** app.
- Select your HH-Tag from the list of devices.
- Tap "**Play sound**". The tag will emit a loud 75dB melody, helping you pinpoint its exact location.
- You can also use the "**Find nearby**" feature for more precise location guidance.

3.3 Secure Sharing

You can securely share access to your HH-Tag with others, allowing them to help locate your items. This is useful for shared household items or when traveling with companions.

- In the Google Find My Device app, select the HH-Tag you wish to share.
- Look for the **"Share device"** option.
- Follow the on-screen prompts to generate a sharing link or invite another user.




Image: Demonstrating the secure sharing feature of the HH-Tag within the Google Find My app.

3.4 Lost Item Alerts and Anti-Tracking

If an item with your HH-Tag is lost, you can mark it as lost in the app to display contact information to anyone who finds it. Additionally, the system includes anti-tracking features: if an unknown HH-Tag moves with you over time after being separated from its owner, you will receive a notification on your Android device.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Battery Replacement

The HH-Tech Smart Tag is powered by a user-replaceable CR2032 coin cell battery, which typically lasts up to one year. You will receive low-battery alerts through the Google Find My Device app.

To replace the battery:

1. Locate the small groove on the side of the HH-Tag.
2. Use a small, flat tool (or the provided tool if included) to gently pry open the tag.
3. Carefully remove the old CR2032 battery.
4. Insert a new CR2032 battery with the positive (+) side facing up.

5. Align the two halves of the tag and press firmly until it clicks shut.



4.2 Water Resistance

When used with the included water-resistant protector, the HH-Tech Smart Tag can withstand spills, rain, and everyday wear. This makes it suitable for various environments and routines. Ensure the protector is properly fitted for optimal water resistance.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Tag Not Connecting:**

Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your Android device. Verify that Location Services are active and that "Find your offline devices" is set to "With network in all areas" in your Google Find My Device settings. Try removing and reinserting the battery to reset the tag. Ensure the insulating paper has been fully removed.

- **Sound Not Loud Enough or Not Playing:**

Check the battery level of your HH-Tag in the Google Find My Device app. Replace the battery if it's low. Ensure there are no obstructions covering the tag's speaker. The 75dB sound is designed for close-range location.

- **Inaccurate Location:**

The accuracy of the location depends on the density of Android devices in the area. In remote locations, updates may be less frequent. Ensure your phone has a stable internet connection for the most up-to-date location information.

- **Battery Terminal Issue:**

If you experience issues after battery replacement, ensure the battery is correctly seated and the metal contacts are not bent or damaged. Handle with care during battery changes.
