### **PRODUCT OVERVIEW**

- Built-In Digital Picture Frame: Play photos directly from a USB flash drive or SD card (up to 64GB, not included).
- Multifunctionality: Displays time, day of week, and temperature. Supports 12/24 hour format, DST, and snooze function.
- **Memory Function:** Two AAA backup batteries (not included) save settings during power outages, though corded power is required for full operation.

### SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the clock and all accessories from the packaging.

- 2. **Power Connection:** Connect the provided power adapter to the DC IN port on the back of the clock, then plug it into a standard electrical outlet. The clock requires continuous corded power for operation.
- 3. **Backup Batteries (Optional):** For memory function during power outages, insert two AAA batteries (not included) into the battery compartment on the back. These batteries only save settings and do not power the display.
- 4. **Initial Power On:** The clock will automatically power on once connected to power.
- 5. **Initial Settings:** Upon first use, you may be prompted to set the language, time format (12/24 hour), date, and time. Use the navigation buttons (typically on the side or back) to adjust these settings. Refer to the "Operating Instructions" section for detailed navigation.

### **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

### **Navigation and Basic Settings**

The clock is typically controlled using buttons located on the side or back. These buttons allow you to navigate through menus and adjust settings.


- Menu Button: Accesses the main settings menu.
- **Up/Down Buttons:** Navigate through menu options or adjust values.
- Enter/OK Button: Confirm selections or enter sub-menus.
- Back/Exit Button: Return to the previous screen or exit a menu.

### **Setting Time and Date**

- 1. Press the Menu button to enter settings.
- 2. Navigate to "Time Settings" or "Date Settings" and press Enter.
- 3. Use Up/Down buttons to adjust hours, minutes, year, month, and day. Press Enter to move to the next field.
- 4. Select your preferred time format (12-hour or 24-hour) and enable/disable Daylight Saving Time (DST) if applicable.
- 5. Save changes and exit the menu.

### **Managing Alarms and Reminders**

The clock supports 23 pre-set reminders and allows for fully customizable alarms.




The clock can display important reminders such as "Take your morning medication" to assist with daily routines.

- 1. From the main menu, select "Alarm Settings" or "Reminder Settings".
- 2. You can choose from pre-set reminders (e.g., "Time for a shower", "Your family is visiting") or create a new custom reminder.
- 3. For custom reminders, use the on-screen keyboard (as shown in the "Unlimited Flexibility" image) to type your personalized message.
- 4. Set the time, frequency (daily, weekly, specific days), and desired ringtone for each alarm. The clock offers 18 gentle ringtones.






The on-screen keyboard allows for full customization of alarm messages, such as "Mom, I love you!".

- Select from 12 available themes and 9 color options to personalize the clock's appearance.



### **Using the Digital Picture Frame**

The clock can display photos from a USB flash drive or SD card.

- 1. Insert a USB flash drive or SD card (up to 64GB, formatted as FAT32) containing your photos into the corresponding slot on the back of the clock.
- 2. Navigate to the "Photo Frame" or "Media Playback" option in the menu.
- 3. Select the desired folder or start a slideshow.



Transform your clock into a digital photo frame by displaying cherished memories from a USB or SD card.

### MAINTENANCE

• Cleaning: Use a soft, dry cloth to gently wipe the display and the clock's body. Do not use liquid cleaners or abrasive materials, as they may damage the screen or finish.

- Battery Replacement: If the clock loses settings during a power outage, the backup AAA batteries may need to be replaced. Ensure the clock is powered off or unplugged before opening the battery compartment.
- **Storage:** If storing the clock for an extended period, unplug it from power and remove the backup batteries to prevent leakage. Store in a cool, dry place.

### **T**ROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Clock display is blank.	Not connected to power, power outage, or faulty adapter.	Ensure the power adapter is securely plugged into the clock and a working electrical outlet. Check the power outlet with another device.
Settings are lost after power outage.	Backup batteries are dead or not installed.	Install two fresh AAA batteries in the backup battery compartment.  Note that batteries only save settings, not power the display.
Alarm does not sound.	Alarm is disabled, volume is too low, or incorrect time set.	Check alarm settings to ensure it is enabled and the volume is audible. Verify the alarm time is correctly set.
Photos not displaying from USB/SD card.	Incorrect file format, unsupported card type, or card not inserted correctly.	Ensure photos are in a compatible format (e.g., JPEG). Verify the USB drive/SD card is formatted as FAT32 and is inserted fully. Maximum supported capacity is 64GB.


