INTRODUCTION

This specialized component is designed for WT-J16/J26 Pumping Type Humidifiers, serving as a replacement power and atomization control board. It is crucial to read and understand all instructions before attempting installation or use to ensure proper function and safety.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The MH-GY-YTH18 motherboard is a critical replacement part for WT-J16/J26 Pumping Type Humidifiers. It integrates the power

supply and atomization control functions, essential for the humidifier's operation.

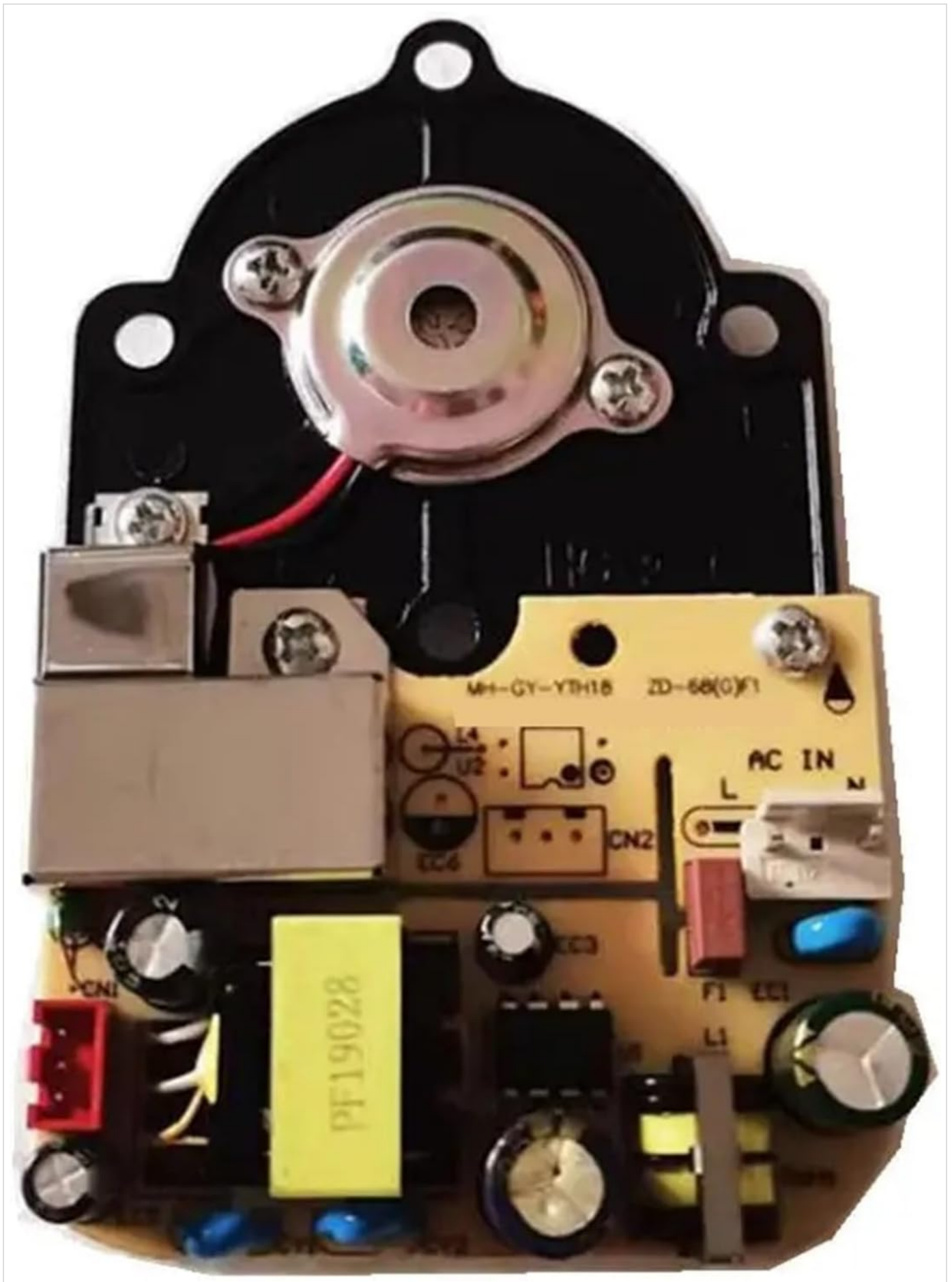


Figure 1: Front view of the MH-GY-YTH18 Humidifier Motherboard. This image displays the primary side of the circuit board, highlighting the AC power input, various capacitors, resistors, and the main control chip. The atomization component is visible at the top, along with several connection points for the humidifier's internal wiring.

INSTALLATION GUIDE

This section outlines the general steps for replacing the humidifier motherboard. Specific disassembly and reassembly procedures may vary depending on your humidifier model (WT-J16/J26). Always refer to your humidifier's original service manual if available.

1. **Power Disconnection:** Ensure the humidifier is unplugged from the wall outlet.
2. **Access Internal Components:** Carefully open the humidifier casing to gain access to the existing motherboard. This may involve removing screws or clips.
3. **Document Connections:** Before disconnecting anything, take clear photos or make diagrams of all wire connections to the old motherboard. Note the color and position of each wire.

8. **Reassemble Humidifier:** Carefully reassemble the humidifier casing, ensuring all screws and clips are properly secured.
9. **Test Functionality:** Plug the humidifier back into a power outlet and test its operation according to its original user manual.

Note: If the humidifier does not function correctly after installation, immediately unplug it and re-check all connections.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

As a replacement component, the MH-GY-YTH18 motherboard does not have standalone operating instructions. Its function is to enable the normal operation of your WT-J16/J26 Pumping Type Humidifier. Once correctly installed, the humidifier should function as described in its original user manual. The motherboard controls the power supply and the atomization process, which generates the mist.

To operate your humidifier, refer to the user manual provided with your specific WT-J16/J26 model for instructions on filling the water tank, setting mist levels, and using any other features.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance of the humidifier and its internal components, including the motherboard, ensures longevity and reliable performance.

- **Keep Dry:** Always ensure the humidifier's internal components, especially the motherboard, remain dry. Avoid water spills or excessive humidity inside the unit.
- **Cleanliness:** Periodically clean the humidifier according to its original manual. While cleaning the motherboard directly is not recommended, keeping the surrounding area free of dust and debris can prevent overheating and short circuits.
- **Avoid Physical Damage:** Protect the humidifier from drops or impacts that could damage the internal circuit board.
- **Power Off During Maintenance:** Always unplug the humidifier before performing any cleaning or maintenance.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If your humidifier experiences issues after replacing the motherboard, consider the following common troubleshooting steps:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Humidifier does not turn on.	Power cord not fully plugged in. Loose connection to the motherboard. Incorrect wiring. Faulty power outlet.	Ensure power cord is securely plugged into both the humidifier and the wall outlet. Unplug the humidifier, open the casing, and re-check all wire connections to the motherboard. Test the power outlet with another device.
Humidifier turns on but no mist is produced.	Water tank is empty or low. Atomization component connection is loose or incorrect. Humidifier settings are incorrect.	Fill the water tank to the appropriate level. Unplug the humidifier, open the casing, and verify the connection to the atomization component on the motherboard. Refer to your humidifier's original manual for correct operating settings.
Unusual noises or smells.	Loose components inside. Electrical issue.	Immediately unplug the humidifier. Do not attempt to operate. Seek professional assistance.

If these steps do not resolve the issue, it is recommended to consult a qualified technician or contact customer support.
