5. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the Shintenchi Kitchen Pantry Storage Cabinet is required. Please refer to the detailed, step-by-step assembly instructions included in your product packaging. It is recommended to have two people for assembly to ensure stability and ease of construction.

Tools Recommended:

- Phillips head screwdriver
- Hammer (for dowels and back panel nails)
- Measuring tape (optional, for placement)
- Level (optional, for ensuring even placement)

Important Assembly Notes:

- Lay out all components on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
- Identify each part using the labels and diagrams in the assembly guide.
- Do not overtighten screws, as this can damage the engineered wood.
- Ensure all cam locks are fully engaged for a secure connection.
- Install the anti-tip device to a wall stud using appropriate hardware to prevent the cabinet from tipping over.

- **Middle Platform/Microwave Stand:** A dedicated space for appliances like a microwave, coffee machine, or toaster. Includes a cable management hole for tidy wiring.
- **Wide Drawer:** Provides concealed storage for utensils, linens, or smaller kitchen gadgets.
- **Bottom Cabinets:** Two enclosed cabinets offer ample space for larger items, cookware, or pantry staples.
- **Door Shelves with Guardrails:** Located on the left side, these shelves are excellent for organizing spices, condiments, or smaller bottles, preventing them from falling.

The internal shelves within the upper glass-door cabinets and the bottom cabinets are adjustable. You can reposition them to accommodate items of various heights. To adjust, remove the shelf pins, place them in the desired holes, and then rest the shelf on the pins.

- **Spills:** Promptly wipe up any spills to prevent staining or moisture damage to the engineered wood.
- **Glass Doors:** Clean glass panels with a standard glass cleaner and a lint-free cloth.
- **Hardware:** Periodically check all screws and fasteners to ensure they are tight. Retighten if necessary.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions:

- **Cabinet is Wobbly:**

Solution: Ensure all cam locks and screws are fully tightened. Verify that the cabinet is placed on a level surface. Adjust leg levelers if present, or place shims under the base if needed. Confirm the anti-tip device is securely installed.

- **Doors Not Closing Properly:**

Solution: Check that hinges are correctly installed and tightened. Adjust hinge screws if necessary to align the doors. Ensure magnetic catches are properly aligned and functioning.

- **Drawer Sticks or Does Not Slide Smoothly:**

Solution: Verify that drawer slides are installed correctly and are free of obstructions. Ensure all screws on the drawer and slides are tight.

- **Missing Parts or Damaged Components:**

Solution: Do not attempt to assemble. Contact customer support immediately with your purchase details and the specific part numbers from the assembly manual.
