# AKATUO Hy300 Smart Portable Android 11 Mini Projector User Manual

Model: Hy300

## 1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The AKATUO Hy300 is a smart portable mini projector featuring Android 11.0, 220 ANSI lumens brightness, 4K/1080P support, dual-band Wi-Fi (5G/2.4G), and Bluetooth 5.0. Its integrated gimbals design allows for a flexible 180-degree projection angle, making it suitable for various viewing environments, including ceiling projection.

## 2. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

### 2.1 Unboxing and Initial Placement

- Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
- Place the projector on a stable, flat surface. Ensure adequate ventilation around the device.
- Connect the power adapter to the projector and then to a power outlet.

### 2.2 Power On and Basic Settings

- Press the power button on the projector or remote control to turn it on.
- Follow the on-screen prompts for initial setup, including language selection and time zone.

### 2.3 Positioning and Angle Adjustment

The integrated gimbals system allows for flexible 180-degree rotation. Adjust the projector's angle to achieve the desired projection surface, such as a wall or ceiling.

## 2.4 Image Adjustment (Auto Keystone Correction)

The projector features 4-point smart electronic display correction and smart electrical keystone correction to ensure a clear, rectangular image even when projected at an angle. This process is typically automatic.

## 3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 3.1 Android 11.0 Interface and Apps

The projector runs on Android 11.0, providing access to a wide range of applications. Navigate the interface using the remote control.

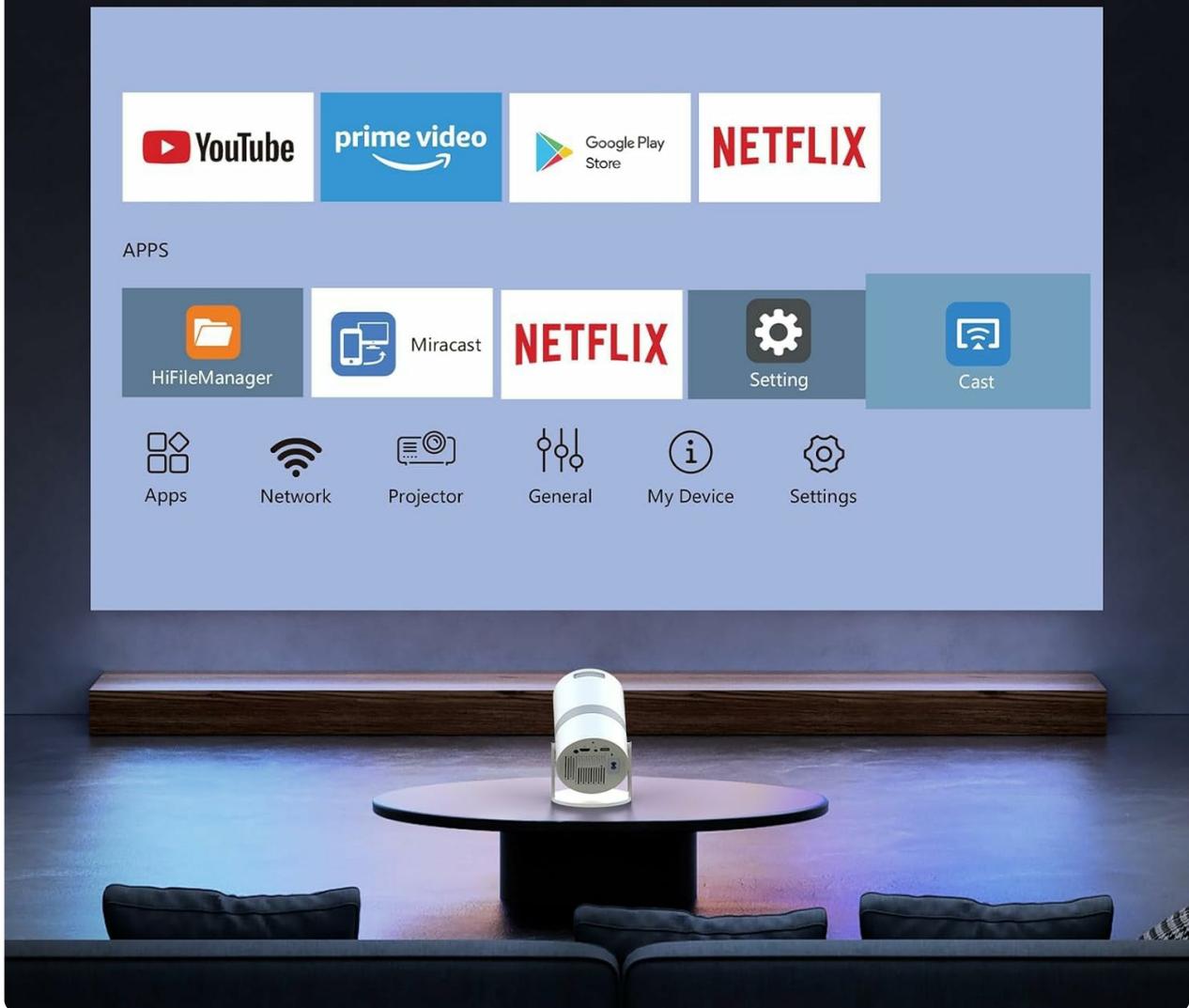


Image 3.1: The Android TV interface displayed on the projector, showing popular streaming applications such as YouTube, Prime Video, Google Play Store, and Netflix.

## 3.2 Network Connection (Wi-Fi)

Connect the projector to your home Wi-Fi network for internet access and streaming. The device supports both 5G and 2.4G Wi-Fi bands for a stable and fast connection.

- Go to **Settings > Network & Internet**.
- Select your Wi-Fi network and enter the password.

### 3.3 Connecting External Devices

The projector offers multiple connectivity options for external devices:

- **HDMI Interface:** Connect laptops, PCs, TV sticks, TV boxes, gaming consoles (PS), and Blu-ray players.
- **USB Interface:** Connect USB drives for media playback.
- **Audio Interface:** Connect external headphones or earphones.

## 3.4 Bluetooth Connection

Pair Bluetooth devices like external speakers or headphones for enhanced audio.

- Go to **Settings > Connected Devices > Pair new device**.
- Select your Bluetooth device from the list to pair.

## 3.5 Screen Mirroring (Miracast/Cast)

Wirelessly mirror content from compatible smartphones or tablets using Miracast or Cast functions. Refer to your device's instructions for initiating screen mirroring.

# 4. MAINTENANCE

## 4.1 Cleaning the Lens

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth specifically designed for optical lenses.

- Gently wipe the lens in a circular motion to remove dust or smudges.
- Avoid using abrasive cleaners or excessive force.

## 4.2 Cleaning the Exterior

- Wipe the projector's exterior with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use liquid cleaners directly on the device.

## 4.3 Storage

- Store the projector in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- If storing for an extended period, place it back in its original packaging or a protective case.

The LED light source has a life expectancy of up to 60,000 hours, requiring minimal maintenance.

# 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

## 5.1 No Power

- Ensure the power adapter is securely connected to the projector and a working power outlet.
- Check if the power outlet is functional by plugging in another device.

## 5.2 No Image or Blurry Image

- Verify that the projector is powered on and the lens cap (if any) is removed.
- Check the input source if an external device is connected (e.g., HDMI 1, HDMI 2).
- Allow the automatic keystone correction to adjust the image. If manual focus is available, adjust it until the image is clear.
- Ensure the projection surface is flat and clean.

## 5.3 No Sound

- Increase the volume on the projector and the connected source device.
- Check if external speakers or headphones are connected via Bluetooth or the audio jack. Disconnect them to use the built-in speakers, or ensure they are properly connected and powered on.
- Verify that the audio output settings on the projector are correct.

## 5.4 Wi-Fi or Bluetooth Connection Issues

- Ensure the Wi-Fi router or Bluetooth device is within range and powered on.
  - Restart the projector and the network device/Bluetooth accessory.
  - Re-enter the Wi-Fi password to ensure it is correct.
  - For Bluetooth, unpair and re-pair the device.
