1. INTRODUCTION AND OVERVIEW

Its integrated trellis supports vertical growth, maximizing your planting area.

Crafted from durable fir wood and treated with a water-based coating, this garden bed is built for longevity and features an efficient drainage system to promote healthy plant growth. Please read this manual thoroughly before assembly and use to ensure proper setup and care.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Read and understand all instructions before assembling and using the product.
- Ensure all screws and connections are securely tightened before placing soil or plants into the planter boxes.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 110 lbs per tier to prevent structural damage.
- Place the garden bed on a level and stable surface to prevent tipping.
- Keep the product away from open flames, excessive heat sources, or corrosive chemicals.
- Supervise children and pets around the garden bed to prevent accidents.
- Wear appropriate safety gear (e.g., gloves) during assembly to avoid splinters or minor injuries.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Please verify that all components listed below are present in your package before beginning assembly. If any parts are missing or damaged, please contact customer service.

- 2 x Raised Garden Bed with Trellis units
- 2 x Twisting Rope (pre-cut to 14" sections)
- 1 x Instruction Manual (this document)
- Assembly Hardware (screws, nuts, etc. - quantity may vary)

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps carefully to assemble your raised garden bed. It is recommended to have two people for easier assembly.

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging and lay them out on a clean, flat surface. Check against the package contents list.
2. **Assemble Planter Boxes:** Connect the side panels and bottom panels of each planter box using the provided screws. Ensure all connections are tight.
3. **Attach Legs:** Securely attach the supporting legs to the base of each planter box.
4. **Connect Trellis:** Attach the trellis sections to the rear of the upper planter box. Ensure the trellis is oriented correctly.
5. **Stack Tiers:** Carefully place the upper planter box onto the lower planter box, aligning the designated connection points. Secure with screws as indicated in the detailed assembly diagram (refer to the video for visual guidance).
6. **Secure with Rope:** Use the twisting rope to further secure the trellis frame, as shown in the 'More Exquisite Details' image. Cut the rope into 14-inch sections as needed.
7. **Final Check:** Verify that all screws are tightened and the structure is stable before proceeding to use.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

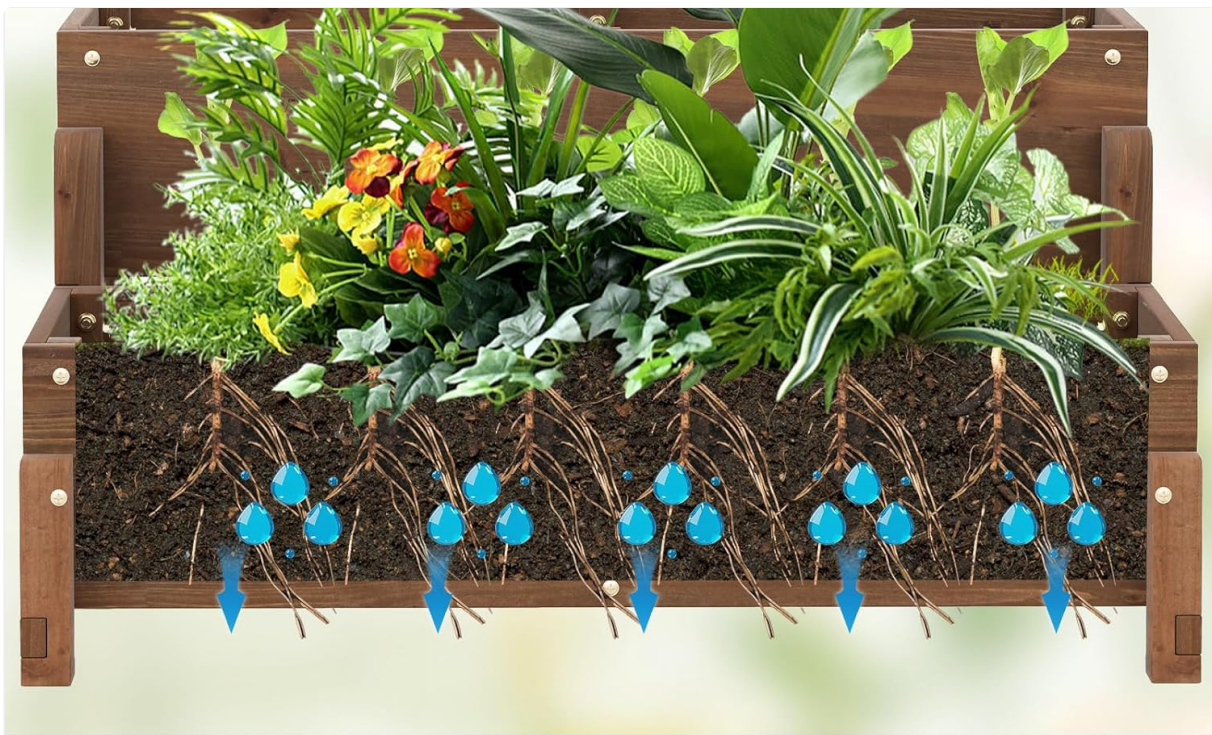
Once assembled, your raised garden bed is ready for planting.

- Choose Location:** Select an outdoor location that receives adequate sunlight for your chosen plants and is on a level surface.
- Fill with Soil:** Fill the planter boxes with appropriate potting mix or garden soil. Ensure not to overfill, leaving some space from the top edge.
- Planting:** Plant your desired seeds, seedlings, or mature plants in the soil. The two tiers allow for diverse planting arrangements.
- Utilize Trellis:** For climbing plants such as cucumbers, beans, or flowering vines, gently guide their tendrils onto the trellis as they grow. The trellis provides vertical support.

5. **Watering:** Water your plants regularly. The integrated drainage holes and gaps between the bottom plates will allow excess water to escape, preventing root rot and promoting healthy growth.

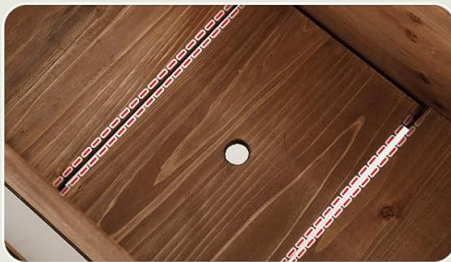


Image 5.1: The garden bed showcasing its capacity for various plant types, including climbing plants on the trellis.

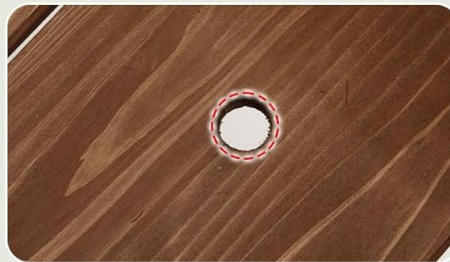

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will help prolong the life and appearance of your garden bed.

- **Cleaning:** Periodically wipe down the wooden surfaces with a damp cloth to remove dirt and debris. Avoid harsh chemicals that could damage the wood or coating.
- **Drainage Check:** Ensure the drainage holes at the bottom of the planter boxes remain clear of soil or root blockages. Clear any obstructions as needed.
- **Wood Protection:** The fir wood is treated with a water-based coating. To maintain its natural appearance and extend its lifespan, consider re-applying a suitable outdoor wood sealant or water-based coating annually, especially if the product is exposed to harsh weather conditions.
- **Hardware Inspection:** Periodically check all screws and connections for tightness. Re-tighten if necessary to maintain structural integrity.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Water pooling in planter boxes	Blocked drainage holes or gaps.	Check and clear any obstructions from the drainage holes and gaps between the bottom plates.
Garden bed feels unstable or wobbly	Loose screws or uneven ground.	Ensure all assembly screws are tightly secured. Move the garden bed to a level surface.
Wood discoloration or signs of wear	Exposure to weather elements over time.	Clean the wood and apply an outdoor-grade wood sealant or water-based protective coating.
Plants not climbing trellis effectively	Lack of guidance or unsuitable plant type.	Gently guide plant tendrils onto the trellis. Ensure you are growing suitable climbing plant varieties.
