1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the SUNTAGE 24-inch Modern MDF Bathroom Vanity with Sink. This wall-mounted floating vanity is designed to enhance your bathroom with its minimalist aesthetics, practical storage, and durable construction. This manual provides essential information for safe installation, operation, and maintenance of your new vanity.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always ensure all components are securely fastened during installation to prevent accidents.
- When installing the resin basin, it is recommended to use glass sealant and allow it to cure for 24 hours before use. Professional installation for this step is advised to ensure proper sealing and longevity.
- Exercise caution when operating drawers. While equipped with silent slide rails designed to prevent pinching, always supervise children around moving parts.
- The MDF material is treated for moisture resistance, but avoid prolonged exposure to standing water to maintain product integrity.
- Do not overload drawers beyond their intended capacity.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Your SUNTAGE Bathroom Vanity package includes the following:

- Vanity Cabinet (MDF)
- Resin Sink Basin
- Installation Hardware (screws, brackets, etc.)
- Instruction Manual

Note: The following items are **NOT INCLUDED** and must be purchased separately:

- Faucet
- Drain Assembly
- Mirror

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

This vanity is designed for wall-mounted installation. Partial assembly is required. Follow these general steps for installation. Refer to the detailed assembly instructions provided in the box for specific diagrams and hardware usage.

1. **Preparation:** Ensure the installation area on the wall is structurally sound and capable of supporting the vanity's weight. Identify water supply and drain lines.
2. **Assemble Cabinet:** Follow the step-by-step instructions to assemble the MDF cabinet. All parts are clearly marked, and pre-drilled holes facilitate the process.
3. **Mount Cabinet to Wall:** Securely attach the assembled cabinet to the wall using the provided mounting hardware. Ensure it is level and firmly anchored.
4. **Install Resin Basin:** Place the resin sink basin onto the cabinet. Apply glass sealant around the edges where the basin meets the cabinet and wall to create a watertight seal. Allow the sealant to cure for a minimum of 24 hours before exposing it to water.
5. **Connect Plumbing:** Install your chosen faucet and drain assembly (not included). Connect the water supply lines and drain pipe according to local plumbing codes.
6. **Final Checks:** Once all connections are made and sealant is cured, slowly turn on the water supply and check for any leaks.

It is highly recommended that plumbing and basin sealing be performed by a qualified professional to ensure proper installation and prevent water damage.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The SUNTAGE vanity features two spacious drawers designed for smooth and quiet operation.

- **Drawer Operation:** The drawers are equipped with high-quality silent slide rails. To open, gently pull the black handles. To close, push the drawers inward; they will automatically slow down as they approach the closed position, reducing noise and preventing slamming.
- **Storage:** Utilize the two drawers for organizing various bathroom essentials such as skincare products, toiletries, towels, soaps, shampoo, and toilet tissue.

6. MAINTENANCE

Proper care will ensure the longevity and appearance of your SUNTAGE vanity.

- **Cleaning the Surface:** The vanity's surface is easy to clean. Simply wipe it with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners, harsh chemicals, or scouring pads, as these can damage the finish.
- **Resin Sink Care:** Clean the resin sink with mild soap and water. For stubborn stains, a non-abrasive liquid cleaner can be used. Rinse thoroughly after cleaning.
- **Moisture Management:** Although the MDF material is moisture-resistant, promptly wipe away any standing water or spills from the vanity surface to prevent potential damage over time.
- **Drawer Rails:** The silent slide rails are designed for low maintenance. If operation becomes less smooth, ensure no debris is obstructing the rails. Do not apply oil or grease unless specifically recommended by the manufacturer.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your vanity.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Drawers not closing smoothly	Obstruction in the slide rails; drawer overloaded; misaligned rails.	Check for and remove any debris from the rails. Reduce drawer load. Ensure rails are properly aligned and secured.
Water leaks from sink or plumbing connections	Improperly sealed basin; loose plumbing connections; damaged seals.	Ensure basin sealant is fully cured and intact. Tighten all plumbing connections. Inspect and replace any damaged washers or seals. If issues persist, consult a professional plumber.
Vanity appears unstable on wall	Improper wall anchoring; insufficient wall support.	Verify that the vanity is securely anchored to wall studs or appropriate wall anchors. Ensure the wall structure can support the weight. Re-install if necessary, potentially with professional assistance.
