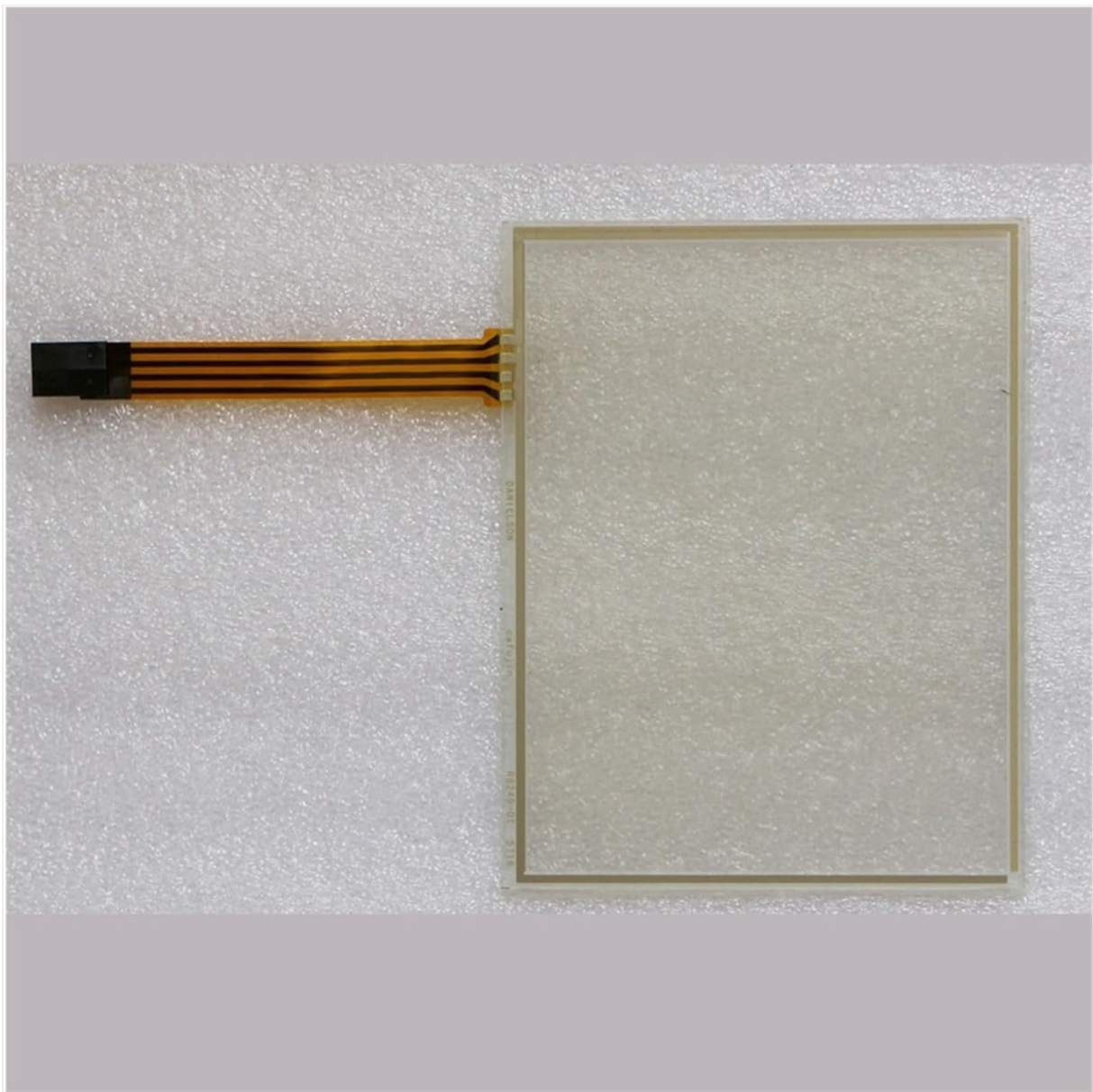
## Introduction

This manual provides instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of the PXNQMTJM ETOP05-0045 Touchpad. This touchpad is compatible with eTOP03, eTOP05, eTOP10, and eTOP11 models, featuring a resistive screen suitable for 7-10 inch displays. ## Setup and Installation

## Operating Instructions

- **Ghost Touches/Erratic Behavior:**
  - This can sometimes be caused by static electricity or a faulty connection. Try restarting the device.
  - Ensure the screen is clean and dry.
  - If the problem continues, the touchpad may be defective.
